

Antigonos, fab.

2nd BC, 1st half

Coupled on same handle with
eponym Hieron, ep. Kratidas.

Cf Bleckmann 1907 p.33, Agora
SS 4018, etc.

Bleckmann 1907: 220-180, because of 2 examples in Pergamon (with eponyms Kratidas and Hieron).

Agora context: best from Hellenistic fill
in Θ and K.

Internal evidence: angular handles, carelessly made stamps. Broken barred alpha

Note that coupling connects the name with
the Villanova deposit of Annuario IV-V.
