





Hunting for Tholo Tombs.

Where stones showed on surface west of ancient olive tree due touch across stones and mounted almost due N.E.S. 4 m. long.

Stones seem to be without order and partly on surface. With stones, none of which is cut, are quantities of tiles mostly undatable, some modern, pot sherds of coarse nondescript ware (at depth of 30 cm. one piece green glaze). At some depth came the massive mortar which the men say is for grinding coffee.




Beneath stones softish earth for some way. At depth of 80 m. more shreds begin to appear with some bones.

largest piece of bone (anterior or leg 10 cm long) found next to slab "A" at 1 x - at same level crushed and not with angular shape (i.e. steroids) found in corner at 2.







Trenches 7 + 8 finished. In 8 about 50 cm below the surface a cigarette box found. other signs of more or less recent digging. Earth very much disturbed. Between 7 + 8 a connecting trench between 7 + 8. All due to depth. nothing found. Tiles etc.

Tr. 12 is by series of stones in open field, stones laid bare dug to 60 cm. - nothing found.

Sep. 28th Trenches 9, 10, 11, 12, 13
