

Rain came on at 4 P.M. and after
several ineffectual efforts to begin work
again, stopped at 5:45 with everybody
out. I drained board. Got the Set, oil
and a private brush for the workmen & slab
in. Had an awful night in our poor tent
had to get up in the night and move
beds about. Gardner quite wet.
Took down the dining tent, knowing
with one of the worst colds of my life I ex-
pected to get mortally sick.

At 7 A.M. it would be time to
strip.

I was working near the tiles
with 40 men and just beginning to make
fine progress when the rain started.

The men were mighty pleased when I
told them that I would pay a whole day's
wage, "so que se apaga el viento."

But some one beat on him and the Effor got after him. I had to dismiss him and the case is pending before the authorities. An awful night of wind and rain in which I thought the last would go down between with my sore throat and inflamed eyes of the night before still worse, and made twice to the emergency of a fire which started right at my first failures baffled stone how had this disastrous result. The temporary epistles Pendagish was the only man on hand

, the effort not having arrived.



** 4 P.M. I saw that the stone lying up against the N wall of the room S. of room with the *Ochotonaria* inscr. was a stela. I saw the little moulding at the edge. I then got Panagioti to dig about it, and found that the top had the form of a stela exactly. It lay hukley bottom up.

We then turned it over and found it a perfectly preserved inscr. of $\frac{49}{50}$ lines and a name ΙΑΣΩΝ made out within a wreath

This is in letters about .075 high and is ^{an honorary} a deer & to Elpinikos, son of Nikomachos, who was chosen Gymnasionikos. This not earlier than 2^d cent BC.
A has broken base.

When we had turned it up, I went for Peabody, who came followed by Hermann and Mrs. Peabody and Lucy.

Sunday June 7

Climbed Olympus with Gordon Hermann & Peabody up at 3:30. By 4 reached the top at 8:30. Then down to the one higher pointed peak still farther east. Harry, so, got no distinct view. But near view was superb. Parnassos, with heavy load of snow was particularly fine. Down again to the sea at 12:30. Bath and home to dinner at 1:30.

Gordon pretty tired. He was scared by a snake and afterwards by a horse.

Monday June 3 Factory

Went to Oropos with Lucy & the Peabodys
Leaving Hermonae with 21 men from
Schenck & Clark's. On the return had
a fair breeze and landed in Eritrea at
10:15 just one hour & 5 minutes after
leaving the Saba Cordon.

Hermonae took three photographs
one of bats and two general views of the
"gymnasium" for so we now begin to call
the whole float. He also found a Doric
capital is a big piece of one in the sand
i.e. poor building. Good workmanship.


