Athens 1924-

As usual the journal begins late and has to be caught up as best it can.

Oct. 6. Arrived "SS Bulgaria" at Piraeus 6 a.m.

As soon afterwards B. appeared in a rowboat & patiently waited until we got off with baggage. Nothing opened in custom house. Came up in the Ford & put all other things in carior - Salomaki for trunk room, a rare mess. Fine reception here. Began to get settled. Mr Fairlie for tea. Call from Miss Winsor & Miss Allen (Boston). School dinner on roof for 16, lovely night.

7. Explored the gardens & saw the birds. Saw School

H. for N. trip. Went with B to Am Ex for funds, emerald, unpacking - Miss W. to tea.

B, L & I explored Gennadeion, ending on roof. Eve. spent getting B's announcement lists in order.

8. Most of day unpacking - spent 5.30 for shampoo. Caught in rain. Dinner for Mrs Sears, Mr Choate, Miss Sicilianou, Thompsons, Robinson. Mrs S. has given a new Ford.

9. Catching up whatever do has a great simi-

- larity although it hasn't been studied or monotonous. Gradually getting clothes in order. Dined at OTB. with Mrs. Sears and went by moonlight to Aerop. - wonderfully beautiful.
10. Went to tea in Annex with Mrs. Thompson - she took us over the house. Eve. spent typing ann. lists, School applications, etc.
11. Went shopping with Mrs. T. in search of clothes hangers - then spent most of the time cleaning salonaki & trucks & making it habitable. Took it easy in eve. & read 4 T. lit. suppl.
12. Everyone very sleepy so the morning began late. Spent most of the day writing letters. Miss Morris (special?) arrived in a.m.
13. Shopping again in prep. for our proposed trip to Corinth - also to send supplies to 7 people by Miss M. Decided we could help clear the decks before Mr. F. went to C. While we were at tea Mrs. Hartley called, also Mrs. T. In eve. actually finished on basis of AmSch. mailing list.
14. Took noon train to Corinth, fine jour-

ney-weather unusually cold & very windy. Errands in New C. buying dishes, lamp etc. for the house. Got there about 5. Had tea again at Geo. H's, as there was nothing for our fire - TauteMarika to help - very beautiful at C. The house nice & clean & we got a lot in order before bed time.

15. Up early, lousy day - Sorted notebooks, plans, papers etc. - got them practically all done before the arrival of Mr. F. Lunched in house. L & I went to Mrs. T's see visitors while the others had a nap - left after tea, but as train was very late didn't reach A. till about 11, got to bed about 2.

16. Very domestic in a.m. pressing clothes etc. Cleaned up his desk, also lost salon. papers. Tea at Mrs. T's who had several Gt. Am. people for us to meet. Laughlin, Denby, 2 Kaliphats, Tyles, Eukleides, Demara, Schen, Lorandos, Allen, Miller, Cox. Very nice party. Eve. Lito & I looked over material for dis. report & made a beginning, sorting it out.

17. Was typing part of report when D Cox aug.  
quited lunch at Phaleron - after we had been  
inoculated by Dr. L. we went & had a fine  
time out of doors at the Bar Busey, a little  
restaurant looking over the water - <sup>PK's sisters called.</sup> -  
Did not get back until late, but spent rest  
of time, typing my condensations of T. P.  
which I had written in London.

18. Continued the report & got hold of the  
old Shirley typed copy, a good part of  
which we read. Felt a little lousy  
after inoculation so read Ganusha the  
Magnificent for a bit. Peggy Hill  
came to tea but on the whole it was  
a quiet day without much news.

19. Spent morning clearing up B's bedroom,  
changing his bookcase etc. Wrote letters, then  
B. returned from Corinth & while L &

Cox made calls we had tea on balcony.

20. Odds & ends. Late in p.m. went calling  
with B. & got a lot made as many  
were out. L & I began Old Spring-

21. Wet day - Decided to hang curtains when  
Mr. F. came along & I spent an hour or so  
discussing Count Brude; then we got dinner,  
room curtains & thin ones in saloon up. Mrs  
Langlin called early, & Major Cox after tea -  
we took him to library.

22. Worked on Old Spring - L & I called on Mrs  
Hensley - the northern trippers returned -  
Tea on balcony. Called at Cos. - then attorney  
worked over ~~A~~ article on Corinth with B.

23. Cleaned out the clothes cupboard, a  
family symposium, much was packed.  
Wrote M. Went to the Euclides at teah.  
& took Mrs T. & DCox with us - very in-  
teresting family, mother, 3 daus & 1 husband,  
several other callers there - Dinner laugh-  
lins, Mr Allen, Miss Carter, Mr F, DC - Then  
made B finish the Corinth ~~A~~.

24. Suddenly decided to go to Nemea & Ph.  
with B - Robinson. Fine drive. Lunch on  
Cliff under pines, beyond Megara - Stopped at Co.  
taxi house for a few supplies - Reached N. in-

fore dark & had a look at excavations, part of gymnasium, bath, old walls under Boys' church, church to temple, temple crypt; saw how the brook has been diverted etc. Late tea, talk with P. while B. went to buy some about trench, after dinner made beds & cots - turned in early.

25. Up at 6.30, speedy breakfast & off to Philippi. Both Ph. & T are beautiful valleys, the vines all yellow, russet, burnt & red - Ph. more imposing because of head mts. near village St. Kos. Some distance from acrop - Sat in Ford & sorted & marked plants, then to trenches, which B decided to leave open. Very hot. Went carefully over all those below slope, then up to Rachiotissa, part "Palati", fountain etc. Fine ways on top. Rain began just when lunch arrived, so we took shelter by church. Very wet for 1/2 hrs. or so, but finally cleared & we got Mr F. who was in a field below. Roads very wet but we eventually drove all the way to Athens, as train was late.

[Invited to dine at Daugherty's]

26. Miss Thomas arr. & B went to see her at hotel. Went to concert at Olympia, 10.45. Letters in p.m. Miss T. & Mrs Strachey to tea at 4.30, out on balcony. Others: Palli, Fitzgerald, Baltz, Hall. Finished H. letter in eve.

27. Went to Brit. Hotel to see New Heurley's Macedonian pottery. Then took Mr F. & went over it with him - 2<sup>d</sup> installation by Dr. Lazaros. Mr F. to lunch. He went to town for errands, L & I shopped, back for tea. Terrible chills until bed time. Fire in Salonaki - he tucked me up in bed early.

28. Felt rather weak - got up about 12 - Miss T & Mrs S came to lunch & we discussed hotel plans afterwards & then showed her the students' quarters. Mr T to tea. Dinner Kiosmopoullos(2), Kyle(2), Morris, Broe, Bronner, Logan.

29. Slight rain - Southern trip started about 6. O.S. went to see Mr F. Miss T here doing plans with W.S. Linen for leg. came & we opened it. Wrote Trot.

30. Spent most of morning tidying the library (B,L,I) as it was in a sad mess, then L & I did Carl's coop till lunch time. Answered a lot of letters, then went to tea with the Halls. Apartment - around corner from legation - Laughlin, Dickenson, Mrs Brown (from Const.). Had rain - got a canappa from legation. More letters in evening.

31. Spent a.m. tidying more things in trunk room. More letters. Lib & I did a few errands, had a walk to Zappion and got some towels & other linens done by refugees. Back late to tea on balcony. Brown & Gordon called for me. Letters in a.m. But went to Committee at noon. Went out in the garden to see how things were going. Dorothy stayed to lunch and took some of the linens to be mended. L & I went to Aerop. and read Hollands first - Greek article on the spat, fine sunset. Tea on balcony. Telegram about 7 that McC has been hurt, so we sent for Dr L. to go to her - after dinner L & I went to see her. Eve. read "Hans" in NYT

3. Gossiped with Mr T & Mr F, then shifted books to clear out Grashewin - one of his cases. Letters all p.m. Mr F read aloud to us his historical sketch of Corinth - during tea time. Then we returned to letters. L & I read part of Miss Stawell's paper on Minoan script. B got back about 10 pm Corinth, having secured the land.

3. Went in a.m. to Museum - took a general turn around, ending with room with Thessalian things. After lunch finished Miss Stawell, then had early tea intending to make calls. Before tea the tykes came but did not stay long. Afterwards the Kermans. As we were starting to town they took us - went to Mrs Miller (mt) - legation. For dinner had Mr Gordon from Am Ex.

4. Letters in a.m. Then we to say au revoir to Miss T, who found her shoulder had been broken & whose bunnies were black & blue. Back late to lunch which was still further delayed by B. finishing report to Caps. Many copies of NYT arrived & had read them until tea time.

DC took more linen for hemming. At tea Mrs F came, after going over part of C in ~~not~~ with me - Mr. Wigram here for tea. After it, I had begun Holland's II Eucth. which we finished after dinner, & then I hunted up in library a few references taken from AJA "Arch. News".

J. Started soon after 7 to visit Mrs Goldmann's dig at Euthresis. Had Buck with Facili, L, B, Rob & I. Beautiful day, fine drive via Eleusinae. Avoided clouds on mt. & the sun came out soon on Boeotian side. Stopped at Thebes for errands, then to Eremokastro where we tried to drive to Ent. by field road, but soon had to walk  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hrs. across country, ploughed fields, vineyards etc. Warm welcome while they were at lunch. Burns, Hansen, de Jonghs. Spent a couple of hours at dig, mostly Mycenaean, some (little) L-H. Great difficulty in identifying walls. Much interesting stuff, but needs a great deal of interpretation. Left about 4, walk  $1\frac{1}{4}$  stopping at Thespiae lion

on few old blocks, to high road - Nearest village to Euthresis (now called Leuctra, is Parapompeia) Thebes about 7, dinner (good). Fine moonlight drive back, here about 11. Mail. Hot tub.

G. Wrote H in morning. After lunch some O.S. then left many cards on way to tea at Mrs Pashatis' where we had a very nice time. Bridge in eve.

I. Began Koch's article on TC's in Rom. Mitt. 30 (1945) After lunch was in ladies R-wt with Gcox where furniture arrived about 4 o'clock, 2 lorries - All put in front garden & garage. John ran the uncrating, much damage - Miss Demetropoulou came & we had tea & after she left we got the uncrated temporary set up. Mrs T. called. Very noisy by dinner time -

S. Up early, saw about boxes of pictures. After breakfast did china boxes in garage, sorted out - canisters etc. Hard work all day - B. went to Corinth with T. at noon. News for chocolates before dinner but didn't really need exercise. Read myself sleepy on to. in eve -

g. Shifting garments in chests & drawers, took

larger one now. Michael working on bookcase. Chilly afternoon. Fire & tea in graphtheon. Mr Baltz came. In eve did some Koch, but not much of it.

10. Mr T. came in and told us about Cr Renaud. Marked & sorted plans of W Hotel, grounds etc. Left early with Dr Cox for Miss Euclidis's workshop, then she joined us & we dined at GBS. Afterwards L & I did errands, ending at En-gastrion where we looked at certain stuff back for tea. Tired & lame after all unpacking, glad to have quiet eve. before Graphtheon fire.

11. Made out inventory for insurance, wrote B. & long letter to Trab. Early eve & went to hairdress. Called at GBS to enquire for Mr Baltz. Dined with Thompsons, family + H Gold man.

12. Went to Am Ex, Henderson, Buick (ask abt. new camera), Police where long wait to get Es license - entertained by "hatless man". Left at 3 for Amb school at Phaleron & ran into their day at home so had tea and met all the teachers. Zane. Georganta called. After dinner sat around fire. Rob gave us

large box of sweets. Got things ready to send B.

13. Long letter to N. in a.m. About noon went to Police again (still postponed) then made appt. with M.D. for medical exam. Insurance man came 3.30 and we went carefully over items & expect to have satisfactory settlement. Tea at Annex, Sills, Case, Jacquot, Empedocles, Endouriates, DC, Goods. W brought us home - "Pd. Trip" returned. C here in time for dinner, also Broe. Men arr. by train about 10.

14. Translated certain pages of Juleich's letter on Hadrian's aqueduct for Mrs Case. In library with many interruptions. Mrs Lytle called (intro. by P Reynolds, New Haven). After lunch L & I dug out some winter things. Bus arrived, so Jorgys. all sound. Mr & Mrs Sills for tea, also Brothers House from Salonika, H Broe - went to doctor's but back before tea was over. Screen for dinner, cold night - sat long over fire in dining room. Then typed in graphtheon -

15. Athanasi turned up so we had more things to send B. Finished typing, then

- examined curtains in blank room & got couch arranged in Ladies' Room for Miss Morris.  
 So cold & blowy we didn't go to Höppfels, but real papers before fire, then Peg Hill, F. Kellogg & Miss Higbie came for tea, - Denby dropped in. Mr Farler came to dinner & we played bridge, 6 rounds, until nearly one -  
 16. A wonderfully beautiful day and we spent a good part of the morning on the roof selecting rugs, a most pleasing performance. Drove to Tahti and beyond along a splendid road to the fountain, with magnificent views over Atica and the sea - Back in time to be taken by Thompsons & Sills to Tephissa & then Delta's where there were many delightful people. She is most charming herself. Letters in eve -  
 17. Wet again. With Marika's assistance we did some rearrangement in salonakie, moving Bi's bookcase to s.w. corner. After I made calls, leaving cards & back to tea. Mr F. here and we had bridge till dinner.

- B. returned with Rob on evening train - we all sat around talking a long while.  
 18. Late breakfast, then saw DL about embroidery & then in library trying to find pop. pth. in Hadrian's time, without success. Letter to G. in p.m. & when I went below found flood in salonakie from steam pipes. Damage mopped up. Went to tea. Eve mostly planning out campaign of work & trips etc.  
 19. Got Br-C started for motor permit, then we went over pictures trying what would do in each room. After lunch went to Acrop. & while Br-C took pictures we went to the small museum where there are many arch. tcs. Back for tea, F. Mr Woodward came in & stayed till dinner time. Says AT&T has Tephissa at Stensington. Finished his letter, Rundstrom.  
 20. Up early putting pegs & shelves into the bookcase, (20x24 with stuffing). Br-C off for C. on noon train, left in bed during a.m. with cold. After lunch got books placed, a big job & was pretty lame afterwards. L - I busy with Hill tea, which were were having in Grath. when Mr Mrs House came.

Rather fatigued in eve & glad to crawl in.

21. Still pretty stiff but went to picture frames, for concert tickets & to Miss Endleides where we borrowed a sample curtain. After lunch took DC & Brice a drive to Raphissa as it was a brilliant day. Stopped to see D's design for the <sup>sills called b.c.</sup> Saloni curtains, home for tea. Dressed & went to call on Mrs Taylor (out). Real fireloves story etc.

22. Put away summer clothes a.m. Went to Dr. Dörpfeld at 3, Buelli gate, approaches, Vitell. He was most cordial & has not changed much. Stopped for chores on my back to tea. Br's train late & he walked up. He & I went to dinner at Negropin, in honor of Adm. Andrews of Am Fleet, (Flagship "Pittsburgh") 19 guests [See School Day]

23. Went to rehearsal of Odeon Symphony Orchestra, Sibelius Symph, Brahms viol. conc., Europa, Lepnello, Mussorgsky "Pictures from an exhibition." After lunch found Michael & Co setting up desk, readjusted papers from other desk. Thompsons for tea. Talked a long time about Stearn's house. Wrote M.

After dinner L & I packed presents for DD to take & made list; also selected films to have printed for Xmas. Began letter to H.

24. Ordered curtains for salonaki from Proodos.

Saw Marromatis to hasten him on repairs.

Finished H letter after lunch. Gave Br & C early tea & then went to Mine von Schan's. Very charming. In eve very sleepy & read a lot of old diaries.

25. Most of morning went to straightening out the desk, cleaning a lot of old letters etc. In pm took Marika to Akirion's and we got household supplies, towels, aprons, dresses etc. Then I got 2 hats. After tea the two Holyoke girls from Phaleron called. Many letters rec'd. Br & C did calls.

26. Errands in a.m. Called for hats, went to Ergasterion and took home material to measure for curtains. Bought grey gauge <sup>300</sup> scarf, saw modiste about blue velvet then ordered cards for Xmas at Pallas - t. Wrote M. Then Mrs Helen's tea for School. In eve went to Phaleron to reception by Miss. of Marine for Am. Fleet. Very wet. Large party, much dancing & supper. Back about 2.

27. Thanksgiving Day. Breakfasted late, then L & I went back to Eng. and to P+C for place cards. H Hansen for lunch as she was to sail in p.m. & miss the dinner. Made out seating plan, wrote place cards & helped get table ready before we went to tea at Legation. Here we stayed until about 7, then had final look over things before dinner for 23 at 8.30. Yellow chrys. very fine - Music afterwards, party kept up till about 1, bed about 3.

28. Wrote letters & saw CHB & KNE pp for Cor. with T. After lunch L & I got the photos ready to mount for Xmas cards, she cut & pasted, & we made our list. Took all p.m. & one except when Bentah & Peggy came to tea, & Charles Athenaeum called (both B+C out).

29. Shopped in am. Books, frames, stationery. Rather chilly so did not go to Aerop. but spent until tea time doing Xmas cards. Shopped for 1/2 hr. to read papers, but returned to cards & letters in eve, having written notes on the backs of a great many -

30. Spent most of the day writing letters, had tea early and then B, L & I went to tea with the Deltas. In a.m. read students' reports while B. was having breakfast. Miss Burr in in the planning trip & borrowing books.

Dec. 1. Letters in am. until we all rushed to Aerop. to take Exec. pictures by correct sun. Lunch very late - Went out to see about placing new gates. F + T for tea, then filed B's letters. More letters.

2. Letters, then to dressmaker for fitting - F to tea. Then L & I hung pictures while B. was out. Return to tea in eve.

3. Very wet. Worked on K and periodicals got from library for reference - Tea at Miss Goldman's also de Jongh, very cold - Eve had bridge with R. for fourth.

4. Back to letters again in a.m. Finally got K done & later in eve addressed envelopes.

5. Spent most of the day in library looking up references from K, i.e. Olympia, Regina etc also got deep in "Ep. on Thurmon." L brought

broke the cards we had made at P+C, so we put them into envelopes ready to post. Trip from O. got back about 10.30.

6. Finally got blue <sup>all but facing</sup> ~~decorum~~ needed & worked on Ed., having in J. West. in a.m. P.m. went to Dörp. on Athene Brauron, older parts. -  
Peggy - Olaf & Gordon came to tea, also M.M., but Bentah never turned up. Dined with Seltas in Tephissia, fine moonlight drive. Thompsons, Photiades, Mallis heredes family.

7. Finished Ed. 1903, also some Schede, slow work. letters p.m. & after tea the 4 of us made many calls. Eve finished H's letter, then L & I wrote invitations for Tuesday.

8. Up reasonably early. Went to Museum with Carl to his pottery course, got as far as Thessalian A. Then he & I looked over the large coll. of geom pots from Mycenae. After lunch wrote up notes that had been scribbled in my Mrs. Myc. Catal. Cold & blowy & was glad to stay in by the fire. Felt for tea

9. Finished mending blue ~~decorum~~. Spent large part of a.m. in family symposium placing hall mirror though the actual work was chiefly Therman's. Had second fitting & got the cards from P+C to send to Europe. Busy with prep. for day at home. Great success, about 30; ending with WS playing - <sup>Read's</sup> ~~much~~

10. Lecture on early sculpture by Lih at 10.30, then in library looking up period references. After lunch read some Picard & helped rearrange books. After tea looked through Sat. Rev. Lih measured for hanging the Venetian mirror - molar M.

11. Letters in a.m. & long one to Edith. Tea at Mrs. Thompson's, then a few calls. Eve "forgot what did".

12. L & I went to Nat. Mus. & did Therman & archaic sculpture. Had fitting, stopped at Proodos but curtains were not ready. L, C & I spent most of p.m. measuring another place for mirror & shifting pictures. B & I went to tea at Allegas. Fred got stuck, walked home. Eve read Carl alone to L & B, then did some Mrs. H.B.

13. B & Stillwell to Cos. at 6.40. Start a.m. in library, on Therman & other t.c's, continued after

lunch as rather cold for Acropolis. Went to Committee meeting for dance for Infant N. & tea at Mrs Petocochino. Made out list, then TB. Eve did cards for England & Italy.

14. Mon 7 a.m. went for letters to M & T, then to H. Drove out on Dionysos road to village of very rough, but weather fine & beautiful lights on mountains. Found B. here on our return. Read a lot in Mrs TB until bedtime.

15. Went to Mrs. with him for her archaic lecture, then had hat fixed. After lunch got Ven. mirror hung thanks to WST's "Harry". Went to tea & had some discussion of Cor. Then addressed envelopes for Miss Cook and I hope finished English cards & letters. TB in eve.

16. Mrs. to Carl's pottery course (Thurs.) then got Br F and went over Hymn. inscribed pots & back late for lunch. Saw T about addresses etc. Day at home, about 35. Bridge in eve.

17. Mrs. for B's epigraphy. L & I came home

about 10:30 to dress for lunch at Rangabe-Giro's. Very pleasant man from For. Office made the eight. Went to Mr Allen's first lecture in Theatre & also saw so-called Odeion of Pericles. F & T for tea. Romios called on B. Wrote H. between tea & dinner. After dinner Miss Burr came to borrow a book & then I went carefully over Robinson's paper with him, until 12, then we four talked over B's interview with R.

18. Am in library on all sorts of things. At 6 went to German School celebration & 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Buschor spoke on Archaic Acrop. - D.D. made dry remarks. Other schools well represented. Took TB with us, after having had him to tea.

19. Did some mending before late breakfast. Most of day on TB & in eve unearthed my old paper on Arch tos to see what summary it has. Besides TB went through a lot of kids' Cor. notes, much to arrange, but prospects good.

20. Library in am & also spent more time than need be on Schede. Early tea. Committee at 5:30 & Miss Cook's. Back before 7, L & C out shopping & I read Romios's letter & look at Ash. plan-Bridge eve.

21. Went concert of Od. Hill. which had some interesting Gk things by Barbagli, composer called out and presented with a lamb. After lunch went to an progress on Gen. To tea at Detai - a fine day for out of doors. Letters in eve.
22. Mrs. with L. for 10.30 lecture - P.m. did all I intend to in Schede then went shopping for Christmas things. Very wearying, glad to get back for tea. Dinner with Thompsons, Anna's household, Dallas, Laughlins.
23. Cards in Mrs. 10.15-12.15, finished needle & began cycl. Small but select number at day at home, on acct. of Christmas. Afterwards C, L, & I did a couple of errands & sent off cables.
24. Started soon after 9 for mistletoe on Parnes. First day of the season. Out via Patissia - Mendidi, and a couple of miles beyond that the carriage gave out, so did much extra climbing - L & I sat under pines for much while men went higher - had to walk into M., then got a car back here by 6.30 to tea & into. Others arr. in relays, but all property including the greens was bought. Started about 11 to trim tree (Cobronee) b.p. corn & string it, wrap presents, tree very pretty.
25. Fine Christmas - Breakfast in morning, then opened the books from last. At 11 had all School, Army, children etc. to tea for the jokers, Student for lunch. Pki sister & bro. called. Then hung curtains in saloni & helped arrange tables. After tea arr. seating & painted place cards. 20 for dinner, music afterwards.
26. Still very stiff so did not go to any lectures but began again on D.S. Tea at home Arauadinos & afterwards at Miss Kalo-pothakes. Dance at Caprice for Infant Welfare, which we cut.
27. Got to work on D.S. for part of a.m., some of p.m. & all eve 9.15-2.45. C & I went to Corinth on noon train. Nnf talked about illustrations for little C. book. L & I went to Acropolis about 3.30 and dia party Mrs. - partly outside, back for tea.

28. Had long sleep, then made up & then we took DC and NNF to Patisseria to lunch at Park Rev. & afterwards to Tatoi as far as the palace & back by Patisseria. Letters till dinner. After dinner finished breakfast.

29. Acrop. Mus. for lib at 10.30, poros sculptures. Stopped at hairdresser's & grocer's. After lunch L + I did D.S., tea at Mrs. Allen's (birthday) hair done - late for dinner. B + C returned from C. about 7.30.

30. Mrs. with C., Cycladic, he came for us & we left the pictures of upper hall on ~~book~~<sup>book</sup> on Sat. at Ms, gas flowers. After lunch worked on Ann. Report which Cappo was in a hurry for. Day at home, about 32, long session. Eve, more report with B's assistance.

31. L + I got report typed in a.m. - revised it after lunch - passed it over to B. Went to Mr. Allen in theatre 3-4.30, back for tea, NNF here talking of possibility of getting printing done in Italy. Read papers after tea. Diaries in me.

Patras Feb 18.

Jan 1, 1925.

Started new year well by cutting a  $\pi\gamma\tau\alpha$  with the students, and drinking healths. L + I did D.S. in the a.m. <sup>in p.m.</sup> & drove on Bourlaqmeni road out across to the sea and back past Bourla and Thalassos. The men made some calls & then we all went to the Perogians' 3. Odds & ends in a.m. & went to Kornidourioti workshop & ordered curtains for saloni. After lunch L + I returned to D.S. until tea time. Then, when Dr. I called afterwards I read the Kaiser's book in Capha (for the pictures) partly before, partly after dinner - 3. A.m. got to work again on Cor. t.c.'s and it was a long job sorting notes - checking up the illustrations etc. but have got the preliminary part pretty well over. Slept at it most of the day except for brief turn in garden. Lights all out from about 6-10. L + I finished our work on D.S. & then I read The White Monkey.

4. B. off for C. on 6.40. Hoped to get a great many letters done, but didn't succeed. Went to Ser.

after lunch, very crowded, but did some Mus. - then around to SE end where there are heaps of arch. frag. behind small museum. Wrote more & then got so interested in W.M. that I finished it before bed time.

2. Lib in Aer. Mus.: archaic, chiefly Room 5 (Moseph.) A few errands. PM. had out book case in living room & scrapped a lot. After tea walked past barracks to Mrs Goold's. Eve, finished letter to H., then B.C.R. came back from C. - Phleus.

6. Epiphany so no Mus. class. Spent most of day on t.c.s., cross references and suchlike dull but necessary work. L-d out in garden for a little while in p.m. Not so many as usual to do at home, 14. Had 3 rubbles for NMF before dinner. Eve read French report on Nemea & early to bed.

7. Rose started earlier rising this morn, so as to get morn's work. Did t.c.s all day except for walk to P.P. and Dilicous before tea. Eve chiefly WB and took, Camp. TC

8. At last a large mail arrived. Epig. in Watkins, Brea decree, Leontini, Stile Nelleport. Sat a look at papers until went up to Library to have B. explain roof construction & Prop. Tea at Legation, eve a musicale at von Schoens' (R. Schmidt)
9. Went to C. in Mus. Cyclades, Syria, Naxos etc. TC after lunch until time for tea at Goolds. Eve got B. started on O.S. (Intro. <sup>intd</sup> 37-47)
10. Lib on "Tantos" - TC in p.m. L-I had our tea but the others came in late, so we talked a bit. Eve did OS with B. again (pp. 4-14) -
11. Chiefly letters, trying (unsuccessfully) to clear up Xmas list. Helped L make out Sch. diary.
12. Am. went to Bi's epig. class, chiefly tribute & treasure lists. PM Mr Allen in library on Theatre at Priene. Eve read Xanthoudides Tombs of the Messenians which C. gave me for Xmas.
13. Am. with C in Museum, chiefly Thyatopei - So I lunched at Ital. Legation, to meet Mrs. Bi's mother Mrs G.H. Meyer + Millers, Goolds, Andreades. 32 for day at home. Eve did OS with B (14-24) until 11, then read L's translation of Picard's

Report of work at School in 1924.

14. Large mail arrived & took good part of a.m. luncheon of Directors, Picard, Waller, Woodward & Döppeld (as Bus. away) to talk over agora plans, went over maps etc. After tea B. made calls, before that read some in Paus. I. Dined at Jaquith's & found bridge game going on our return.
15. Nearly all on OS cleaning up & putting in revisions. Looked over <sup>CIX 11-30.</sup> ~~Aja~~. Read some Tragor & TET after tea & later with L. Eve did OS with B (24-36).

16. Up in good time, most p.a.m. in library comparing texts, Oly etc. lunch at TB with Miss Cate & L, errands & back through Pal. Gardens. Read C's Phoen report before tea. F. Made up dearies. (OS <sup>47-57</sup> ~~36-47~~)

17. Lib in Mrs. Engst. Döppeld on theatre in p.m. & then all went to tea with de Jaeg - saw his very close cancellures - OS 57-79.
18. Letters & in p.m. went to Kimonai's exhibition & found it ended, so had a drive

by Patria & around via Kephissia.

19. B's epig. in a.m. Building acts. furniture of Aleib. etc. Theatre course in library, Miss Carter on Suppl. - Pers. - her discussion of how to stage them. Tol's birthday, so had surprise cake after class. Orgy of OS in eve, finished.
20. C on 24, saw in apothete another Meg type simia like ours. Dressmaker here, did some good rendering, very quiet. Not large crowd at tea on acct. of Gym. Concert. B. went in eve to musicale (<sup>Xoloniinis</sup> violin recital) at legation, very silent, had a good time.
21. Heavy mail, much pleased to get delayed letters. Tidied up OS so B could take it to Cor. L. & went to Ergasterion & ordered some interim curtains for salomaki. B has his class in library & we went to it, Greek st. inscription (Chandler) [that was Tues. before the tea].
22. after tea. p.m. in library doing ref. on t.
22. Decided to devote rest of the week to getting correspondence in order, but pain in arm grew much worse, so had Dr. Lauder - he

filled me up with same stuff as Geo T. had given me. Then stayed part, at least of the day in bed for about a week. Neuritis in l. shoulder & arm. C off to Cor. at noon.

23. Very lazy day, read The Little French Girl.

24. Isabel Thompson did a.m. of pot-depth. pack Lysis - everyone very sad about it. B did all errands & preparations, I could not move, but managed to write a few notes for Mrs. T. Harriet & Moore Gates came by "Adriatic" - were here for tea, on way to Const. Read some Smoky Sappho he sent for Christmas.

25. Services in Eng. Ch. at 9. All back before lunch time, I spent quiet day - B made calls.

26. Nothing special

27. C.W.B.'s birthday & we all gave him some Cycl. idols & daggers. Felt better but could not comfortably dress for tea, so others went.

28. B off to Cor. early - Days much alike, enlivened by frequent calls from F, light literature, & have read Newtley's Maced. report. L & I just starting for garden when Miss

Murphy from Const Coll. came, brought some coins - I showed her around -

29. Wrote long letter to Trot before lunch, garden p.m. weather lovely. Got out old diaries & letters - had much amusement reading them.

30. Much better, out both a.m. & p.m. Finished Cable from H., Duton wrote book.

Mabel's Pianey, papers, tidied desk, etc.

Eve B. got back & we all went to reception of the Pres., but on account of wife of Patriarch from Const. it was an affair of mourning - was in Ep's palace & all had been arranged for a very sparkling affair, but everyone was very sad.

31. Large mail. L & I did laundry. Spent much time in garden. Tea at Mrs. Hall's, lovely party. Showed a lot of her pictures which were beautiful. Home late, quiet - we -

Feb 1. Another lovely day, much of it out of doors. Wrote enormous letter to H. Not took hours. Read a lot out of the old letters in eve.

2. Letters, garden. Crew dull & windy p.m. Went to tea at Coe von Berkan's; <sup>RS</sup> Candlemas party - Dinner for Mr. Mrs. Stillwell, Laughlin, Case, May,

3. Letters a.m. Tea pm. 22 here. Talked in eve chiefly about prospects of AFG & Co.
4. Spent most of a.m. writing to Aunt C, mixed in with getting Satoraki curtains done by the modista. Met at 4 p.m. AFG com'd 2 Thompsons Mrs. Demara + Geo M) went 5:30 to Austrian School nice musicale piano + violin Pollak + Basay - Bad day, took NMF instead of B. Eve = paper, odds + ends
5. Am. writing letters for Staples, M. St. L., Mrs. J. R. Maxwell. Most of pm + eve went to looking over carbon copy of my book. C to Co. p.m.
6. Got deep in R-Melior, till much time on it. And went to tea at Mrs. Van Wyck's. Eve mostly till references etc., Villa Giulia.
7. Lit on tiled Balustrade, lunch on Aerop. Garden early p.m., tea Mrs. Pasquali's. Eve partly on R-Melior.
8. Finished Melior (after a fashion). Wrote H.
9. Spent much of a.m. with Mrs. V.B. about Gt. Ts and King. 3 Thompsons for lunch as farewell to Mrs. T. Library in p.m. got JTBs on Mingan (1914, 1915) preparing for Thobes. Tea at von Schoen's, then to Entleides where we talked and ate until nearly 8, interesting time. C back from Co. in eve + we got all the Phoen news while he has his dinner. Afterwards read the papers.
10. Most of a.m. in library after finishing <sup>Hamill.</sup> Odds + ends until time for tea, 21 here. Wrote long letter to Mrs. V.B.
11. Hairdresser at 10.30, then I + C drove to Phaleron + early the sea, had coffee + pistache nuts. In spite of having decided to wait for H's letter, I got started on revising litig - Tea at Entleides. Saw Jelladagounis again - litig in eve.
12. Spent nearly all day + eve on litig, checked up with MacI., edited sentences etc. Call in am. from Mrs. Boughton, Miss Murphy, Miss Morris from Baltimore, showed them around. Disconnected here. But in graduate short time in p.m.
13. Went to Thobes for the day, C, L + I in company with D. Burr, saw her hotsheds + went to museum, where saw exhibits from Nalae wing, affinis? anyhow very important for me. Got back about 10 after a fine day -

14. Lib in museum, 4<sup>th</sup> cent. Then to Ghislman about parents, found he was Cook's "Mikali". Began letter to Trot (finished Sun.). After lunch rearranged salons, as sofa - easy chair had departed, also some things in salons. Met Mrs Roy. Maxwell in Acropolis at 5, with her this Spring, & brought them back for tea. Afterwards went to Presidency for tea - Bridge in eve with D.N.F.

15. Letters. Calls in p.m. Then went very late to Rep. to tea with Mrs Dragomiris. Spent eve getting ready for next's audience.

16. L & I started in car to Cor. at 8 o'clock. Stopped at Elisis to see new statue & the res. Reached C. about 12.30, left things in house - lunch in Geo's. garden, then worked hard on res. in p.m. (good tables & good room) until about 4.30 when got wire from B. that parents due Thurs. & that C's mother has died so drove back to Ath. eve. about 9.

17. Took noon express to C. Met by Geo Kosmop "worked res till nearly dark (lots of them)

Saw Shear's house, then called on Leslie. Dined at Geo's mit de Jong. Slept in exc. house.

18. Breakfast to's at 8, packed up. Geo. took us to train, fine journey to Patras, arr. 3.30<sup>(9)</sup> met by Ghislman's Dimitri. Went to Angkor. Got permit for boat, went to Ven. castle & sat for a bit, then were invited to cassata etc. at tourist ship, sat on her for sunset. Bed early.

19. Called at 5 for 6 o'clock steamer, which really came in before 7. Sat long in little boat before getting on. Lovely ship. Parents fine, delightful voyage. Met by Mr Angelopoulos. No trouble with customs. Slept for hours - ares etc. Hung to lunch. Took 3.30 for Olympia & motored in bad rain over muddy road from Pyrgos to Oly. - Hodder & Stewart & 2 strangers to party. Much fun. Reached O. at 7.

20. Spent whole a.m. in Altis, heavenly day, everything beautiful. L & I did res in mrs. after lunch (in notebook) then show paints the mrs. - Hermes. After tea L & I climbed hill of Demara - Pungles in eve.

21. Had last hour in museum - All left by motor at 10. Took 12.25-train, picnic lunch, arr. about 5.30. Met Ang. to dine.
22. Called at 5.30, others at 7. Rain on journey - B. came to train at Cor. but had to return. Cleared off, lunch in dinin. Arts. 3.15, met by C. & John. Drove to P. Palais, visitors. All had tea here. Wrote H. in eve in answer to her long letter about Brook. B. came in eve.
23. Took M. to hairdresser's - while she & I stayed, Father & I sat in Pat. gardens & I worked hard on carbon copy, making sheets of revisions for H. At home until 1.30 am except when we had tea (all) here.
24. Very wet day, did work until 1.30 but got 7 ch. into mail for H. Tried to get the next ch. done before tea. Weather a bit better but still wet, 24 here. Dance at Grivas in eve.
25. Anniversary - Cable Dub. wants maps. Errands in am, sent many cables for D. Bur

also to H. to await revisions. Party for lunch, also HNF's birthday. Then went to Acrop. where C. took a lot of pictures - we stayed most p.m. On return Mr. & Mrs. Fletcher Dobyns came, intro. by Mr. Oakley - we kept them for tea & to see sunset from terrace. very late to Jap. legation for tea. L-C went to legation for dinner back Sat. 2.

26. Went to PP for parents & out for errands. They had cable Uncle W. died 24<sup>th</sup> L-C on foot back late for lunch. B. off to Cat. 12 with S. Hall. Cleared up B's papers after lunch, long job. Tea (all) at Mrs. Hall's - various cables here.

27. DC here in a.m. & we talked about maps for book which she will make. Then tried to get Mrs. Hall to go to "Rat." with her. P.M. L-C & went to Cos. about income tax, then to Christman Fruehhaus about boat to Italy. Parents here for tea but Caldwells never turned up though we stayed home from Oropos trip. Read papers in eve -

28. 1st last museum lecture (first mon.) We

All went & were nearly swamped by tourists. Called at P.P. on Sir Alfred's lady's admission now (into A.B.W.) and they came to tea, but meanwhile I had started index. Dinner for Stewart, Johns, Straus.

March 1. Opened Xmas boxes (arr. Sat.) with much delight. Par. here a.m. & for tea-lutes. Much time on lists - addressing 7 cards for Open Meeting (Wed.). Large tea party, Mabel, Miss Miller, Mrs Hardy, HNF, Mr Deane - 6 of us. No calls made - Dined at P.Pal. with Mrs. Case.

2. Began preliminary work on index. L.C. called on Negroponotes, all + there + Mrs Petoe & Mrs Sotir. Dined GB with Mr & Mrs Helen.

3. Errands a.m. Arthur Ball, Edna, A.j., Harrison this Cockshaw called after lunch (from "Mauritania") & we showed them around. Mr Fisher called with letter from Mr Oakley but did not stay to tea. 42 here. Index

4. Spent a.m. on maps with DC who is drawing two of them, but in places etc.

Index. Open Meeting 6 p.m. HNF, Nemea Phillips. Large crowd here. Checking up maps etc. etc. etc.

5. I gave me maps before she, Alice, Helen & began left for Presevo. B went to Cor. at noon - family to tea. Dined at P.Pal with Monds, Woodmar, Chesham, Andriades, Diomedes & a Gk couple and extra man.

6. Lib & I went to Pal. Hotel for Mabel & bought her here to spend a.m. Shears arrived p.m. - came up for tea, also Thompson, HNF & Deane. Index etc & then B & C returned & told news.

7. Scraps - index a.m. Dismoors effects but delayed. Tea at home Schlissmann's - Dinner for Shears, HNF, Deane, Bonner, Duell & C.

8. Went to Stadium & captured Mr & Mrs Hadley, took them to Mrs Little's, then back for lunch - Showed them all around, took them to Mrs. afterwards to meet R. Sotiriades who was guide. Came SS "Patric." Gorgeous day - Duell showed B.C.L.F. one his paintings of Tomb of Trickito (more useful) - a lot of sketches. Mrs de Jong called, Mrs W.B.

14. Br-C arr. about 9 having left Car. in Ford about 5. Went to Psaradellis (3 of us) then to P. Pal. about Ha's rooms. Wine said L. better. Br arranged to go to Aida on gov't torpedo boat - HMF going too. Call from Mrs TB. Tea at de Jong's. Bridge in eve. C, L, M, I.

15. Br-F left Piraeus 9.30 on "Thetis". Ma went to Odéon concert, very good, Bush II, Rach II, Chauvet. L-C to meet Ma who arr. Adriatic. She was here on our return, Eliza ill in hotel. Unpacking - except p.m. For tea, Dismoor, WB, Nye, Ernest & family - letters in eve.

16. C left for 8.40 - L & I went to Mrs. found Mrs WB in workroom, heaps of Co. tes. Lida's - my old ones. Got Mitro - another bag to take down - put boxes, & dry washer there p.m. <sup>Nader</sup> Stopped at P.P. to see about moving upstairs. L & I went to tea with Mrs Lambos her 2 daug., less wanted, the Millers. Has a boy

talk with Anne L. about her husband's work. Found Ma & kept her for dinner.

17. Very wet so did not go Mrs. Portela here, did blue cotton work, finished blue "Elie F." <sup>"Nader", nunes</sup> tea, so here. HBræ made fourth for bridge in eve.

18. walked to Mrs. & spent eve with Mrs WB, then walked back & up Hermes on errands - P. did old visit in p.m. Mother, I went to tea at Mrs Dragounis, both daughters here & a large party & nice time. On return had wine & ham. Logan failing rapidly - Telephone from legation just before she had died - HMF were out 5:20. Great shock, as improvement had been indicated in telegrams of last couple of days. L & I went to legation in eve. Welsh & Ayerlie here later. Where to find B. by wireless?

19. At breakfast 3 wires from B from Patras, coming by train p.m. Others on Tasso. Sent cables, messages etc. I went to Brit. Sch. to lunch, only Rayhines, Payne, H & J. Took parents to tea with Millers. B here on our return. While at dinner, Mrs & Shear & Still-

well arrived driven by Geo. Kinsman. Then C & Burr after B&H had gone to see Mr Allen. Tucked them all in.

20. B. spent most of day running to & from Picass to meet "Tasso" which finally came 9 p.m. after many delays. Many friends & then addressed notices for all "Open Meeting" list. Mrs Allen & various students & Mr Dinsmore helped. Saw Mr Wigram about music & after tea the others went for grey cloths. The P.M. came & I saw him, much moved. HNF and CAR here about 10 & got them some supper, & we sat in Uncle H's study B back very late.

21. Evangelia & Hys. took down with flu so we helped keep house, & afterwards we all made a blanket of flowers on notice Johnb had found for us. 15 for lunch - went early to the church. Services at 3, huge mob & all important dpts. & good represented. Afterwards to chapel in company. Loads of flowers, very beautiful.

Back for early tea. Visited F with some bridge till dinner. Talk with DB afterwards, then less S. down here. Early to bed.

22. Up in good time to see R Macaulay Bigelow who has letter from ENTH. She - Julia Henning took DB to Maye. Mrs S. ff in Geo. Kins. car soon after q. Tried to rest by reading newspapers etc. L & C out for lunch - long letter to H, finally finished about 12. For tea Mrs WB, HNF, after dinner Helen made a fourth.

23. Went to Hartness, met Mrs WB & dad Co. Hes, left early, had rain. Got a little rest after lunch. Cleaned up. Tea at Mrs Allen's, family & family. Thank notes for flowers in eve.

24. Took father to Chidman's (not ready) errands, called at dentist's for M. PM all went to G's for steam tickets, then L & I returned some calls after taking M. to Shoe St., Tower & Winds etc. After tea called at Repropones. Bed early.

25. Call soon after breakfast from 2 Haw. men who stay S long time. Helen took them ff. Dr. Mrs. Jas Filner + Howlands for lunch. Drove to golf links in pm before tea. HNF for

- dinner - bridge. Kendall Smiths arr. & left here.
26. Went to Sunium for the day, 3 parents, Eliza & I, in one of Dion's Cadillacs. Beautiful drive, lovely day, gorgeous on point. Forgot what a fine trip it was. Photos of a few nice t's in little shed for Mrs WB. Back for tea - then Mrs Herman Hall (Marjorie) & Mrs Conway Evans called, hunting Adorides.
27. Helped M. pack, then to Police, then a few purchases for Portula. For tea Anne-Schliemann, Mrs Bigelow, J. Hennig. Went to lecture of Mr Miller on Early Nat Athens at Arch. Soc. Dinner eve, 7 family, 2 Smiths 2 Dinsmoors, Bone, Duell, Rob. after lunch two parents were gone.
28. Geo M. to see abt. translations of telegrams & letters. Odds & ends. Early lunch. Saw Pa' into ff at Pir. on "Lamartine" for Naples. Back about 3.30. Saw Mrs WB in library, then for tea - Family seems very small. Left papers in eve.

March 29. Mar Eliza moved in - I spent a long time in SNF's office - after tea L & I made a few calls. Letters in eve & early to bed for next day's start.

30. Off soon after 8 in Dion's Cadillac. Picked up Mrs VB, stopped at Daphni. Lovely day & beautiful drive, Cov. about 1/2 - found Mrs K. Smith in Geras garden - 10 for lunch - Mrs WB & I in apothecary until time to leave for Myc. at 3.30. Arr. 5 & went right to citadel, stoned them around, sat on top, then L & I climbed all around the walls. Heavenly views & wild flowers. Night at Fair Helen - & having good luck.

31. C - DB left 6.15 & I saw glorious sunrise colors. Early Hefts. Then across field road, got almost to Her. Went on top while Thanasi made breakfast for diggers. Then went to tomb, have found 13, 10 promising. Downs f 10. (Cleobis) has been dug & we had a dramatic opening of door, but top had come in & it will take long to dig. L & I crawled into 11 (Biton) small one, opened from above. There were 5 & 7, could see it was hollow tho' small

hole in top of door, but C. had to clear the drums first, so it must wait. Parked around a bit, then went for short visit to Trivoli, left at 12, Cov. about 2, lunch Co., apoth., then to Shear inc. beyond theatre where they are laying track to dump. All had tea with Mrs S. Little house very nice - left soon after 5, dark before arr. home at 7, splendid drive.

April 1. All spent a good part of a.m. at hair dresser's, did a few errands. Mr Whittlemore here for lunch. Began letter to Sutton as H. could not read galley - Tea at Mrs Miller's (Hambois, Zongen, Campbell, Cov 13) then to large party at school at Phaleon, brought Mrs Paschali, Mrs Allen, Miss Carter back with us. Wrote in eve to Dad.

2. Was copying letter to J. when van B's came & we got news of Remaas. Tried to connect w. Cov before Rom. left for Delphi. L + I took Eliza to Ang. to meet Mrs V.B., then to Ghislain, left notes for Bentons + Wigram.

Eve went to musical of Montalbani at P. Pal. Very good song recital Italy Andrade.

3. Index in a.m. Mr Speyer other Gordon Leith + Thompsons here to luncheon. Index. The Maurice Bentons + Father Wigram for tea. Webster had on reports for NC in eve till after 1, condensing monthly reports.
4. Reports a.m. Luncheon at Italian School, also Brambillas + a Ital-Am. girl + one of the Regat. Secretaries. Up to Es. after for a few moments. Tea at home Stavansakis, errands. L + I did report in eve -
5. Bff to Cov. with Horlant, Speyer etc. for day while L + I did report, except when I took Ma to Gk dances in honor of Swiss teachers, lovely show. Eve rep.
6. Got report nearly done in spite of many interruptions, Remits, Atwood, Dr Julia Portula etc. Went p.m. to Polytechnic Hosp. to inspect it - chances for Training School, with Mrs Langton, Horlant, Cannells - others = Churchill + Metcalfe.

7. Long letter to H. in a.m. about book - forgot what did the rest of the time.
