

Oct 26. Fine, cold. Off before 10 with S to do a few errands. Left T at Emily's. Did Adm'r, over, Boots etc, back before 11. Papers with tea. Wrote to Morris & tied up book to send. Wrote H.
 10.5.
 Nice Trio, Celtic, Birth, Goossens, songs by F Hartfield. Bridge Mrs Rudge's, also Jo, Mrs Wardrop, Moore, L Harris, nice time, down 7d.
 Early supper, heard Henschel read his poem. Mozart Serenade for wind later, J Stokmaar, Brahms etc. E to music club. Did at puzzle began Thistler. Ace of Spades.

27. Fine cold. Election day, all household out early. Tr S to R later. S did taxi for electors with car. Did some pressing for T myself. Bridge at Jo's p.m. Also Mrs Rudge, Solomonson, Fawcett, Waugh, nice game, lost 1/2. Mac & Bernard in during tea. Back about 7. Returns off - on during eve. Stayed up till 2, M up till 4 when they closed down. Landslide for Govt -

28. Less cold, drizzle. Cleared to fine p.m. cool but sunny. Everyone out before 10. Read

papers, then cleared out tons of old letters etc. Took long time, finished them before tea in dining room. Wrote a few notes. But Gary Mrs F. did 15 holes, very cold. S came for us 4.30. Magesson in big majority, a large crowd waiting for announcement. Cable L, re voyage. Back for welcome tea. M + S to cinema, 6 pm news had late & best of results, Cons. sweep, only 50 vs. Concert, Wm, Coriolan, Dutchman & Ruth & N Bauer, Sibel. I sym (the last slow movement) Meph. waltz. All very sleepy in car & went up at end concert.

29. Fine, cold. Parcel Sup. has key-quadr broken, so wrote, repacked other things - spent most of day in kitchen. to pack & tying up shoes, parcels, hats etc. At 6 if not. Fixed squirrel traps with hooks. Much to see in papers, huge sweep, very small off. about 50. More prep. after lunch, good after but takes endless time.

After tea finished The Pontics - began Monk Hamburg 5/11 7.30. Leicester concert - Figaro, New World, Ital. sisters in duets, Ray, Cimarron etc, charming. All rather sleepy, ready for Budget - did some ST.

30. Cloudy. Car still at Hilton's so did not go to R. but spent a.m. on more odds & ends & packed most of trunk. Got a lift from R. after lunch & had lesson with Beau. in place of T. Had to walk back to Belton bus, home for tea. Had a good nap in Hamburg afterwards. E went to rehearsal. BBC Ros 21/4, European Anna Hansen, Dr. Hens (height), Pilgrims Magenheir (strains) Mlescent, Step. 1 day. Chamber Music, Eng. Ensemble Fairie Quartet C minor & Scherzo & flat - M Brunskill Mahler Pfitzer songs.

31. Fine. 5. I went with M about 10 with yellow drops. Afterwards with T & Ethel

To R. for rewards, Bank, Dow, etc then to Leon. & to Bobbys for molesterie coat $\frac{10}{12}$ got back hat - T a beige one, cayenne, back for lunch. PM more packing till after 4, Hampt. To cinema new Regal, M, S, Alice & I to Celin in Millionaire fine, followed by roller randerville. Dinner about £. 4s, E Wallace, Bok - cho, R - ful (Ground) Massenet (ed), Hesperus (Hannish), Tann. Read a couple of stories in Jackell Grid.

Nov 1. Fine - Golf R, Bernau & I. That not allowed, Mrs F off to see Annaed. Good game, playing mostly not too bad. Home 1.15. A off after lunch. Back, T & I start for Tony. but has no luck, all blind clues. Jo came about 4 - we played bridge till 7, stopping for tea. Mrs F in with box of sweets to say goodbye. Another by Tony. but no success. Letters

cheques etc. during concert - Leon I, Moz & Conc. (F Goodson) Diners, Unfin. Up about 10.45 for more packing till about 2.

2. Fine, gorgeous day - up early for last things. S, M, T to station to see me off most comfortably, no cars. To Knysley R5, left luggage & to Seepidge $\frac{3}{4}$ glass my grand(mia), hair, telephone Jers who has flu. To Est by 1.15, met K & H Fraser for nice lunch. HF & I walked as far as Bond Brook & I went Liberty for slippers, then Burners for Gals & Knysley, bus to Tunstington & C Coast for an hour, tea舞ces also tra - son (German + Russian). Take to Knys, met K at 7, to Diner frang, to Wattes from Vienna, back 11.30, walk in - vited back, met Effie - Bed c. 1.

3. Unpleasant but soon cleared to beautiful - sunny - up 6.30, off at 8.

T came to see me off, very early, no crowd, sat and talked a long time. The weird T to send Blue Guides. Crossing rough but pleasant & sunny. Nice little steward saw to luggage etc. Arrived in Bonn, nothing opened. Car & comp, a big one, more space because of different plan. At lunch met Mr Polte so we had all meals together - he left at Genoa for Piave. Read papers, Puzzles also, puzzles etc. Dark before we left Paris. Talked a lot. Slept well. good bed -

4. Fine, misty in valley then brilliant day, never rain finer. Customs at Turin no trouble, contr. took receipt & keys. Breakfast with P, left about 10. Had lovely day, had W-End Bonn most of the time, but lots to see - lunch with old Eng. lady who lives in Rom in winter. Gorgeous sunset. Arr-

7.50, good hotel, no delay. Fine welcome, have room over M's. Right in to dinner. No one here I know well except Miss Hanes but several I have met. Came up early and unpacked. Early to bed.

5. Beautiful brilliant day. Wrote M in bed. Out c 9.30, canoza to PO & visited M, also Cantagalli. To Stern. for curtains, to Gallenga & got model bed satin evening dress. Bus to Pal Colonna & Ven. - to Pal Colom no to see gallery & family portraits, good view outside from windows. Had not been in it for years. Out at 12.30, taxi back. Out c 2.30 on CD but got carried to Colos. so had to walk back to see more sarcophagi near Big Fox, clouds of dust from pulling down houses by Big Fox & Ven Mon. Walked past Capr along new Taip. street to Marcello & along river to P Garibaldi for 3, to Acad. Got up early & strolled about, met Mrs Sternus.

Tea at 4 with WB in his office. Tram down hill, to Min Edue. A session of Inter. Inst Med Studies, Count Constantini, Min Edue, Boethius on Adua (brief, in Ital), Foerham J on Minutino with good pictures. Saw him & Elsa afterwards, also Mrs Strong. Other speakers Maiuri, Giglioli. Walk WB to Ponte, home by CS about 7.15. Came up early - met Ashenden. 6. Cloudy & in route. Up in good time EF to Babuino & got cig cases for T at Gambinini, also ordered paper race - he will post. Got Venet. purse for afternoon. Back via P di S. steps, Pinco, & Borgo, Veneto to Cornicch for ticket - Naples - Park, to Gallenga for fitting. Am ex again, paper, Condotti, Corso, Jessie, Pal Grotani, P Gaith & CS back for lunch - but soon after 2 by CD to Colos., Palatine, anch

Coast, up hill past S Giorgio P. to Anch Dr & P Navone, Villa Clemontana at last, lovely place & views - Back via Claudia & CS arr. soon after 4. A brief pause incl. note of thanks to Mrs Gray for tea cloth & napkins sent from Florence nà Miss Martin - Tea WB with various anch, mid Stevens, Russian , Germ. from Count Galli, Oyles, Berlanga, Luglio, et al. 30³, Mrs B drove me to Miss Ceccio's having Luglio en route. Nice call, told all about races. Scrambled back for dinner. Give next Times, wrote up clearly. Blue G, Sp. arr. at lunch, posted by T. in response to wire. 7. Wet. Showery. Letter from T re cig cases so went to Gambini, shower. Decided to return for umbrella but it lit up, so went nà Pdi S, Frattina Corso, Pren, more hard showers. Back!!

- got umbrella, lucid interval to V Nag
 - got necklace for maid, 10 cedar &
 remount - Times, deluge, short visit
 to Terme but very dark. Lots of small
 things after lunch, wrote that, waiting,
 at 4 Giuseppe Mrs Woodruff's chauffeur
 came & we started on way at Corriu
 re box from Cantagalli, then to tea at
 Aspasia, lovely house, gorgeous things.
 Both seem pretty well. On return
 stopped Flora but Eng. out, then to
 Mrs Strong 6- after 7. One call from
 Miss Martin - upstairs before 10 & read
 D. Fine, a.m. Showers later. Washing
 before breakfast. Late borrowed
 tools - opened wooden case with
 Cantag. things, cleared it up, began
 letter to M. but about 11:30 to
 P Ven, Campid, back ally, SM
 Cosmedin, riverside to P Garib,
 3, Ram, up early, walk in garden.

Lunch Villa Amelia, also V B's, bright
 (librarian), Reinhart (arch) Mrs Has-
 bronck (formerly in R. US Naval Att.).
 Delightful time - Back c 3:30, finished
 letter - did a little packing. Rain
 let up. Tea V B's also Wrights (Smith)
 Mrs Woodruff, Mrs Kohlart - Back
 about 7. After dinner via Miss
 Jackson Miss Eaton about twice,
 then off & packing till 11:30, then
 wrote to Mrs Hallam - Bed time -
 Nat.
 9. Up early after short night. Tremendous
 thunderstorm about 4 a.m. Let up. Breakfast, got
 off at 9, fine send off by family. Train to
 v Formia, rain then. Gotham met me, all
 small things in car. Picked up lunch basket
 at V. Monti Scavini & drove several miles to
 Minturno dig. Rain over. Good lunch in
 dig house, stal. ass't. There but had his.
 Afterwards to pottery shed, lots of red, all
 white w. blk lining, under, good shapes -

fabric, Rom. sculpt, inscriptions (esp. of unusual comp.) out to dig. Theatre (not cleared in int. yet, flower parts 2 temples, Ap. way, other road. Many old foundations, big blocks under temples, puzzle to disentangle. Circ. wall, well n. Don col. at bottom. Back to room n. Arch to (late mostly) No chiefly in T. Giulia, some fine big cornices & whole tiles - connect sun. (No flat + convex in one). Back for train at 3. Bright sun, lovely ride to Naples. At Merg. Cr. met me soon after 5. Fine welcome hotel Mulinari, porter, red roths. Had so on front. Fine back & rest. Went to garden under alterations, so up early after good dinner. Head nautical away. Fell asleep over book, so to bed. Read Maid in Waiting.

10. Rain in night but cleared fine. Coffee at 8 - walk ^{10¹} m at same time off about 9 to "Saturnia". (No need to

go to office). L on upper deck, quickly on board. Room 144 fine double w. bath - verandah, lots of room. Went ashore - to S.L. a moment for address tortoiseshell place. Got comb, brush, clothes brush, mirror for ^{50c} brief wedding present, - L got new cig case. Back soon after 11, sailed 11:30. Piss + Scamp + Miss Edwards on board. Remained a gossip on deck. Lunch Purser (Empoldi's) table, L, P. J. Every thing most excellent - comfortable. Lovely views Sorrento pen. unpacked a little, but chiefly L + I tied up bundles of her books till tea time. Cinema afterwards, rubbing King + Corsair show on to Wallace. Cocktails in lounge, nice dinner, turned in early to add. fine comfortable bed.

11. Fine. No hurry about getting up, L got things packed. Up on deck about 11. Lunch 1/2, Patatas about 1. 30. Capt. Cr. not on this (on "rule"). Usual music

about landing, too much Murphy - Stevens.
On tender until 2, first anchor last to
finish customs, but has seats. Ghisl.
sent old Stevens who helped but we got
Sarres - did well, no duty on things -
few opened. Barrel + case go to Pur.
as customs closed at 5, we just got
through. Majestic to 5, out for copper - a
few macaroons etc. Wrote lots about
train. Dinner about 7.30. Bed early.
7. Gorgeous day, perfect, after shower in
night. Up before 6, early tea, left 6²⁰, good
comp. on train, luggage all o.k. Off
7.05 most beautiful trip imaginable
Mauritius bright, fields full of vines,
everything enhancing. Read M in W.
Restau. on at Kyl. so all 4 together
- afterwards L, P + I played 3 hand
bridge till past 11. I won
most of their cash i.e. 68dr! Ann + Met
by Mr. John, quickly home. Marica

Er, Anna, Sophie. All looked beautiful +
spotless. Very green in hall very fine -
Garden full of chrys. Began unpacking
before tea, after which went into garden,
then getting dark. Sent off with tele-
grams M - Ma, - for Obs. Unpacking till 7
Then did mail + afterwards the papers
etc. that had accrued. ATA, JTB etc.

13. Fine. Good sleep, up about 7.15. Long talk
w. John during breakfast. Unpacked trunk
10.30 to Vassili till about 2, Amly to see
state of finances - ask abt. hotels, back 1.30.
More putting in order till 3, to Ruth. To
Mrs K to thank for lovely chrys. To Da-
vis to leave seeds etc. A recording from
cold but would have kept us except for
other imminent visitors. Left Mr. How-
land's package at Adraides. Back to
tea. Went to concert Belgian Quartet
+ Piano, May & mis, Fauni C Mis, Brahms
no 1. op 25, splendid artists, lovely concert.

Back about 9 for dinner - tried a little Torg. after, but got sleepy.

14. Fine - up in good time. Busy clearing out desk & papers. Unpacked parcels of books, stationery etc. Out at 11 to bank for money for bills. Then Phil. with old hats. Will remake blue & make a bek. w. acquette, also several for L. To Orij with present, books fine. After lunch cleared several shelves in C's bookcase & shifted some from hall .. put new ones there. Neat but not arranged. Out 4 to Negrep. & found all at home + 7 cats including new white one. Tea there & much talk. Back about 5, wireless man came & 6th got new battery afterwards. Out 6 to see DK, also Mrs Ghini, Maria, Kalop cousin, SLW & Mr & Mrs Babblet, known Uncle Jim. Back soon after 7. Did a little

Torg. in eve but rather sleepy. Not much luck w. wireless, much interference.

15. Fine - up in good time - wrote M till time for concert. First Sym = Bart. Bude, Double concerto (Lykoudes - Wetzl), Tarn. Paris version, Salomé Flor. Schniet (new). In intermission to Eucl. box, all there but T. Much talk, also saw Razous. Scatter for rest of concert. After lunch wrote B. Call from John & Timo in garden. Rear Timo, to tea at Legation, just ourselves. Mr Skinner and has a splendid long talk. Just back when Mr Thompsons called. Mr Porter here for dinner -

16. Fine, gorgeous weather all the time. Wrote H, JL & etc. At 6 Picpus for barrel & box, so walked to Orijas about 11:30 - tried on new dresses I bought. Washed gloves after lunch, read papers - Out to Amely (or Hooker) 1:0, then cards

18 Miles & tea with Max Hunker - a very long talk about college affairs. Library here for short time. Stopped to find Ralph but he was out. Resumed Tng. but progressed very little. Back Mass from Vienna, not as good as at Gloucester.

17. Fine. Devoted a good part of a.m. to putting up curtains, 10 pairs in all. Transferred library ones to bed room. Unpacked glasses. Started to change white seat but found one screw bent in transis. Off early after lunch - took seat to Simpkin at Helleniko, then golf. Did two rounds, fair to middling. Hidens matting above bunters. Only out. Back about 5:30 after second run to Helleniko. Wrote some notes re dinner Thurs. Late tea. Papers after. Had long try at Tng. but very slow at it.

18 Fine. Wrote M-L bought material for maids' dresses while I finished. Put up transoms in library - behind piano. Went to try 2 dresses - L did other transoms. Returned via Amherst P.O. Golf p.m. Started about 2, but lots of people so began at 10 4. Went around twice but - did pretty badly on the whole. Back late for tea, fortunately M-Hunker did not come. Dressed after. Some good music from Budn before dinner & then later in eve. Read Thunes controversy in DJA, also some reviews in JTS.

19. Slightly cloudy, cleared fine. Letters, later to Philippe until lunch time. After lunch read Ho & some journals. M-Hunker came while we were at tea. Late all to Miller's (Kamptor also here). Mrs M still very crippled with neuritis after shingles. Her book at new women's book club on lower floor. Dinner here, 2 daisies, Ralph,

2 Darbishires, 2 Thompsons, Priscilla,
Hill, Mr Potter.

20. Fine, colder, very windy. Went a.m. to
golf, balls blown all around so scores
were none too fine, 57+57. Gorgeous day
except for violent wind. Back in time
for lunch & started papers when Miss
Stone called. Good talk till she went
w. L who was off for errands. Quick
change, L back 4.15 & out to tea with
Marg. Childrens party, Mrs Keay, Jane,
Mrs Balfour, 2 Dicks, Mrs Howell, Lavinia,
Tinker, Anna, 3 Dick. children - joyous.
Great success. Later Horner & Comrie
came in. Escorted Lavinia home in
state. Back about 7 & worked on
Troy - finally got it, very amusing.
Finished Reftin article in JWS.

21. Fine but much colder. Did books etc.
& L went out for errands. Arranged a
lot of envelopes for calls, until 6 o'clock

gave out. Cleared out old papers, went over
JRS, JTS etc before tea. Afterwards did a
tremendous round of calls till 8.15. To
GB for dinner with Mr Potter, new place
very nice, stayed long time.

22. ^{Very} pink - up in good time to write M.
Lovely Pop concert, Ruth Vienna Dancer,
Handel Viola Concerto (Faidant), Lynn Var (Maas)
Stalagm. A few papers after lunch &
at 2.30 Mr Potter came & we went to Dam
& back to Tabor - back to tea. Greyish
& chilly out. Got end of Augustum con-
cert wch Bach, Adagio - All, 2 Sym. Eve very
fireworks - saw Pontifex lion & Thorndyke.
Bad in reference but got Brahms Quint.
from Rome.

23 Greyish, windy. Finished It's letter. Got
out MHS & poked around a little, many
interruptions & not much progress.
& out for errands. After lunch did acts.
Out 3.30 or so to Baych, M out but saw

Homer & Norow. Thanksgiving. To Phil. To Am Cs ^{4.30} book club committee, Brstrom, Gauls Hill. Chose new com. Late tea, sorted cards & left them till about 7.45. Streets in terrible state. Buda concert Bartok sick, GMin, Br. B flat concert (Rubinstein) fine. Red Times - did some puzzles.

24. Fine, still, sunny, cool, cloudy later & chill puts on caliper in after noon. Wrote B Hooten. Did some addit. & revisions to MS with Evans III pp and on during day. Call from Mrs Kalligas before tea. To tea Puffy Taylor, Amer. party incl., 2 Teays, Curran, Blattberg, Fisher, Gausman, Price, Wright et al. Played contract with L, Mrs Lorando & Mr Teay, till 7.30. Got men's cards from Denava & in eve got rest of envelopes ready to clean. Began Am Beauty (Gutenberg).

25. Light rain. Wrote M. Got some work

in on Tinos. L out about 1/2 for errands. More time in pm till 3.30, quick change early tea & to Pier. to meet "Excelsior" at S. Great climb up & down ladder. All glad to see us, 3 nice cabins, Miss M, Mrs Scandrett, Mrs Jenkins. Bought them all along after quick packing. Here about 6, got them sorted, made cocktails, much talk. 7.30 AutC car for Rem & they dinner dances & went to Aer. as it cleared somewhat. L & I dines Melas-Schleemann & had lovely time. Also & his other wife, Mano, Tyrone. Back 11.30, visitors c/2 - monograph.

26. Unsettled, sun in front, no rain. Social breakfast, here southern Ambit, photos etc - latter took Mrs Skypos photo & then I took Mrs Javours. Mrs. Warm welcome here, saw Bill & Faro. Visitors met Perillas. Back for lunch but left about 3 & took them

around via Stad, Zeeuws, Aer, Thes & to Daphne & then to Pisaars. Luggage & screens by Dion. car. Saw everyone & everything on board. Left some cards in Phal. late cup of tea, brief "pause" w. papers - work. Nice Th. dinner with M, H - R & a good old gossip afterwards.

27. Fine. Spent most a.m. on Knobs, dairy Ebastroen, Hall, etc. using chiefly PM III & typed some new parts. Went late a.m. for a few errands. Times after lunch - more PM while I wrote Uncle Bacon & the Crew. Fine out so started 3.45 - with cards & back c 5.30. Nearly all rec. Pay & kept. Quick tea. Concert Walter Lehmann, fine. Schubert, Frauenliebe, 2 Fin., 2 Mend., 3 St & several encores - Splendid artist, his house. Saw lots of people. Eve had fine time w. Tug. & got it.

28. Greyish. Typed a little on PM, while I finished Uncle B. Out II to Orij w.

blk eve dresses, blue velvet. Met Mrs Baefour & children there. After lunch more PM. Lent Mrs S. my blue velvet jacket to copy. Out 3.45 - more cards, lost in room. Hmblch. To Pay & kept. Rushed back for 5.30 ahead of Mrs Fisher - Gade (nurse) who came to eat tea. From then till bed time did Xmas list for cards. PM cleaned slicer mostly, to trim off some. Got all USA ones on joints - list - addressed, till about 11.30

29. Grey, drizzle. Cable to CSE for birthday. Wrote M. Fine concert Oberon ov, Aria, Fantasies of Rome, Fidelio Aria, Schub II Sym, Solrist Lehmann. Took Mrs Peho to & from. After lunch was Ohr & Times, wrote H, packed off cards, tea, put in a few cards out & to party St Lovendos, big crowd but plenty of room saw lots of people. Back about 8.15. Eve heard a Haydn Sym, Brahms 3 Concl (A Rehning) Mahler I from Prag, later some from NY (Tuscanini) Cz-Ridept, Pictures of Rome -

Got cards put in - all USA envelopes filled, also 4x3 cards. At 4- 5/11 ready.

Dec. 20. Cloudy, hard rain in night. Slept late. Spent most of the day doing the USA Christmas cards, with notes & letters in some. Long job, got on well with it. Left a few more cards 4/5-5. Lunched a.m. for errands.

Bought BE Cenc., & part of Quist: in exc.

Rear Coles' racing Cenc.

Dec 1. Horrid day, wet, windy, hard gales. Late sleep trying to shake off cold. Out 11 to buy for old bet. evening dresses, blue velvet, blue cloth. Return via Pris. After lunch paper, then stuck on all the rest of the stamps, wrote many notes for inside, several real letters. Miss Stone came tea & stayed for a good gossip. More letters, eve was 3L.N. ate stamp. Respighi concerto from Rome.

2. Cleaning, cold. Late again. Wrote M, got all other cards posted. More letters incl. long one to ECT. Both her books ready for post. To tea at Miss Mills's, saw a lot of people. Bought P. Demet. back to 4th. Left last cards. In at 7 & read Evans until bed time. Had Mrs D Sym, Divorce Violin Cenc. from Stuttgart & L'Ape's midi.

3. Fair. ^{old} Began T, went to Orij, then Pris & ordered nightgrown case for Miss M. Orgy of letters in pm. Sunny am but bad & cold later. Call about 4 from Mrs Mason. Stayed indoors comparably wrote lots of letters by hand & on typewriter, incl. Em, May, McD, HMF, WVI. Read Dr Punch & part of Tragedy at 72 Trees

4. Grey again, drizzle. Cleaned later. Spent am mostly on trees, 2 side. Also general look over. Paper & come more in pm. Call from Mrs Cullen out to Blacklers ^{Snow on mt.} for tea, back about 6.30. Letters from T & EDW3. Cut out all the

Steinsons we could collect our player with Tong. in eve. Chopin from Bukan.

5. Fine, sunny quiet. Mon Kres. very slow going, a.m. L managed to salvage some chrys. from garden. Lunch 1.30 Audrum, now daughter, vis. Mrs S who was ill, Payne, Karo, Ralph, Gade. Most successful party. Broke up by 3.30. Lovely day so ran down to part Voula before tea.

Rained badly broken up after Telephada. Simple tea here. Out c6 to Dorios, good long stay, much talk Skendre, Cumb, Ghini, Danglis, Aristea, Macca, Nitav. et al. Back about 8. Eve read part Karo's TA reprint - he bought, + some Schadé's Aeropl (Eng). Rather feeble Titus Vienna.

6. Fine. Wrote M before concert. Maupé Lataloui (now grown up) Weber Concert stuck, Schum III (EF) Chabrier Bourée Fauré. Lovely day but industriously

wrote H, then went over more time typed pages about NDA. 9 A.M. b/w tea. Out c6 to Perogloris for Xp. 10.30. Family party there, Tatavar, Zalt etc. Detkar. in Rome, big. in mourning. Saw Julia - Annette. To Miller for long call, much Czern., politics etc. Eve read Schade. Much trouble getting Figaro wh. was on many stations.

Back 4.30 - HV came so she + I started b/w L was dressed, then all had tea. Out 6.15 to Vassili for much needed session. Had oil + mass. - good mass. Back 8.10 Had Buda Sch Bb, Schmidt var. on Hung Theme, Jubilate (Guiglilmetti), Casella - Italia afterwards Moz. Dieter Mat. for wind inst. Finish her Turlestres. Mon Tong.

8. Grey. Settled down to more time, incl. new discov. Call about 1/2 from M Satiria & much gossip. Dull after noon so did Malia till after 4, dressed, early tea. To Bk Club at Cos. Chose new committee, ff it. H Mary came here until time to go Atchley's party after 6. Very nice time there, not too crowded, plenty to talk to. Back via Van Wyck & Rego Pk. where we made short call - home 8:00. Eve read parts of Karo's report.

9. Dapple. Let up. Wrote M. off soon after 11 to Orsi & back by 12.45. Papers. After lunch typed Malia parts & began 1/2 Gd manus Eutrisis till time to dress. Call from Lansdale about 4. 15. Fine! clearing up? Got more cards + notes ready. To Ory while L got flowers. Back 12:30. Lunch 1:30 Millers, Peter, Mack. Wardlaw rarely good time. Later had a go at CF + Beach ID Conc. Call from Eriphyle + before

She left Mrs Vlachop. came to call. Quick change
- HK here for tea. Miss Stone in later. HK

 20. Tog to clear. Wrote M. To Sym. Core

 tea wrote H. Out c 3 to Daphne,
 shiny but not while there so has
 good light on mosaics. Took Pris &
 her also to tea, & the waiter.
 Spent most eve making cuttings
 from old Mes & reading first of Satirion
 articles on Byz Rem. in Cypress. Hand
 going but good. Carmen from Frankfurt.
 Earlier had L Lehmann in Lieder.
 21. Fine! Made the most of a beautiful

day to go to Sunium. Wrote B first. Off
 c 11.15 & took TN, lovely drive, beautiful
 there, sunny & not too windy. Lunch beside
 wall of Temple. No lunches allowed now.
 Did not go to house. Left 2.30, stopped at
 Marko to see old church St Paraskevi & her
 retaria & masticha. Back 4.45, L Mrs S to
 Pris, H & I here, all for tea. L-J to Basil 6.30
 till after 8. Eve read TS, 2d Byz article.
 22 Fine. A comedy of errors most p.m. with
 chasing around. Started Mrs S for lyceum.
 & went to Olym, then L-J shopped for
 jewels - ways in Stad. St. ending at Tonilli.
 After lunch H & I got Jamie & we all went
 to the dam. Cloudy at times & cold with
 sharp wind. Mrs S & I went down to see
 Ath Thas. All here for tea, after L Mrs S
 had gone chasing HST. Mrs Hensley came
 in during tea. Upstairs about 7 - read Byz II
 Pris here for dinner & contract, home
 up rather late.

23. Fine. Wrote M. Took Mrs S to Aerop - did all but N side and old Ath. Lovely, - sunny but sharp n wind. Saw Kipp. Balanovs. Closed at 12 so walked nearly to Theater where L & Ath met us. Flower man had for Xmas greens. After lunch cleared out old newspapers, near Times. Mrs S to Vasili so L & I did presents, including a fireplace for Mrs S & began some verses. Borodilovsky Chopin recital, back late. Eve wrote verses & auto cards. Haydn & Gau from Wien.

24. Fine. Out for errands, Amby, Oryg & went to Ath. to get Mrs S to Piss, flower man - lunch GB with Thompsons. Then out to Stavro in sun. Pm. typed verses, tied up parcels, earthen pot run past Vonda. Back for tea. Presents etc till dinner. Took Mrs S to Aerop by moonlight while L, Marita & Er trimmed the tree.

25. Fine. Merry Christmas. Up for break-

fast about 9 for all three opened lots of lovely presents. From L & Ath mostly books. Off to Russian church at 10, service but no music so went soon to Eng Ch. Big crowd there. Took Mrs Miller home, then Holly & Forsythia to Negr. Found J & A home - had an auto with them. Home 12.30, change, write visitors here for lunch & Katie's pudding. Out c 3.30 for lovely drive to top of Detelina pass, gorgeous violet all the way in form Kipp. Back for tea. H. T Euclides in for a call after. Finished last poem, wrote place cards at 2, things to tree. Dinner & Steinnes, 2 Teap, 2 Plats, 2 Danists, Ralph - 3 of us. Table lovely with new green glass much admired. Particularly good dinner, lots of fun with jokes & verses after. Tried tops on floor, all much talk till about 11.45 or so. Great success.

26. Fine. Went on a fine picnic up Paines, L, Mrs S & I. Glorious day & no wind. Lots

of snow on upper Paines, also distant mts., cut, etc. Lunch in sunny place on hillside. Collected pine cones. Back soon after 3 for an hour, up to camp for sunset, lovely. Met Al & Wm & Mrs Wright. Back for tea, early change. Had a start at Tony from copy, as had one Obs yet. It sticks. We played 3 handed bridge.

27. Fine. Started long letter to M, done by installments. Fine concert Coelli Cone Oroso, Buett I, Rachm. & nice plays by M Papajianian, Gmin Pulaw - Fugue orch by Meto. After lunch finished M, out c 3.30 to Marathon, lovely day, was mostly good, horrible after 5. Back for 5.30 tea found more cards & notes, Obs etc. Played Tony till dinner - wrote it in eve. Nice Gravats Butt, Brahms - A little more T. before bed time.
28. Cloudy. Showers off & on, muddy.

Started on thank notes. Off about 11 to Mus. & did Myc & Petr. rooms with Mrs S till L came for us. Met Kao, Barnett, & Thompson. PM took resident permits to get new ones, arr 3.30, not open till 4. Went to Piss, Turk Legat, Po etc. & home in disgust. Both + Costa got them. Bassett here for tea, Sam looks very well. Papers afterwards, three handed in eve. Battery recharging.

29. Very windy, cloudy. Lots of rain later. Wrote thank notes, stayed in all day. L & Fisher to Turk Leg. as house - till a.m. & part p.m. writing. More cards came & books from C. Read JLN after tea & an accum. of papers no time for before. Piss here for dinner. contract.

30. Pouring. Cleared late & was fine p.m. Wrote M. Spent much time telephoning. Out 11.30 to Ambyx & got messenger to go with us to Bank of Greece to have money, permits on passports. Flatgriech, mats

There but quickly done. Back to Tombly for money, to florist, S Nomill, chocolates, Tassili etc. Ours 3, took Mrs S to Top Winds, - vicinity, look at Tombly, This, & to Philo for sunset, very fine, blue not mauve.

Late tea, papers, did up children's presents earlier. To Cecil for dinner with Teays & Christensen. Back early as Mr T rather ready, Mrs R in top form. Began Diary of Prov. lady.

31. Cloudy & unsettled. Started early writing CRM - finished during a.m. Wrote down thanks for Cor. aut. Out before 12 for errands, Del, Oruij, Katie, Horando, Minerva, PO, Tassili with presents. Got fine greens from a peasant. Better weather p.m. All, incl. Pis & Scamps, went to Shata for tea with Mr & M in Hill's cottage. Very good time, road OK except for short muddy place. Back 6.30 - had a few minutes "pause". Did more Torg. Dinner 2 Thompsons, 2 Laars-

dales, 2 Bassatts, Ralph, Pis & us. Saw New Year in with Rita & Macro daphne. Mrs S got the coin. Bridge: Mrs S, P, R, Laars rest of us took it. Bassatt left early. Bed soon after I was a little Diana of PL.

Jan 1, 1932. Fine. Up rather late. Many Xc. Tolls during morning. Wrote T. Out 12.15 - with greens for each, lunch Minerva with the Waiters, brief call Major. L & I spent all p.m. & most eve doing news items, I typing, also finished Kau's AA as needed. Finally had go at Torg.

2. Fine - Jib boat. Took Mrs S to Cenn. bank - was closed. Mud fearful. Around by lower gate to BSA Hostel, saw Hensley. Stopped to learn JLN here then spent rest a.m. in Bysg Mrs. a fascinating place. Mrs Teays here to lunch, then back, then bridge. Mr T came & we kept him to play & eat more play. Left about 7.15. L & I finished news items before dinner. Torg in eve. Finish D Phab.

3. Fine. Wrote M, began H. Concert CF Reduplication, Psyche, Tausman Triptych, Bocc. Cello Concerto (Tournonkli), Soc. Appart. After lunch finished H, wrote some notes, began Effie. Call from Miss Yours, then Thompsons re house, leak, furniture. To Davises for tea + then to PK family until about 8. Eve fished out books for Cyp, cut out Byz articles, cleaned & sorted papers etc. Rom comic incl Bath VIII.
4. Fine. Finished Effie. Out c 10 to Ambly, for money + tickets (boat 24 hrs late). Back for Mrs S + to B Pass Control, then B Cos, left her passport, to Cennad. Shown around by Lowe + Nitso, saw Bronner + Miss Edn. Took Mrs S at 3 to B Cos, left for Pir. before 4. Adeia, saw her on "Ploti", but as sailed at 7 we came back. Quick tea here, + 1 mi for a moment. To Legation for an hour good talk, just S. ourselves. To Vasili. A peaceful eve, mostly Troy. Rosenthal

Chopin E Min from Vienna, Meist. later from Buda. Begun Return I daurant. 5 Fine. Devoted most of a.m. to packing, a slow job needing much adjustment. Did accounts, rent fees etc. Out c. 3 to Maurice + Sotiriades. Lion Hunter shifting books, went all over new house with M + Rox. Children + dog there too. To Davises' with message, to Ambly, Delic + back to ha. Out 6.45 to Minerva to see Miss Eaton + his Jack son, just arrived. Half hour to come at Troy before dinner, also cleaned up newspapers. Wrote M eve. Also poem for Taro's birthday. 6. Fine. Tel. Lloyd who said sailing 12. Got last things done, off in time to see end of Epiph. celebration at Piraeus, many flags + decorat. Rowboat to Città di Bassi, excellent boat, like liner but smaller. Had 7 + 8 on upper deck, connecting. Did not get away till 6 on acct. cargo, but could not leave, as hour uncertain. Spent most

time reading S Spray Skaggsmith) - Only 3 other pass: young Brit engineer for Cyprus, Dutch-Brit-Couple for Egypt. Fine weather, good meals, service etc.

7. Fine in am. Stiff breeze by time got to Rhodes so went around behind new quarter and got no idea of the town except the hotel. Not long enough stop to go ashore, very disappointing. Got postcards & some item pp, also 2 copies Guide. Dark before we fought our way around point, terribly rough, vile night.

8. Still fearfully rough & slow progress, sun at intervals but mostly grey & mountainous. 3 survivors. Spent horrid day reading papers, Shadows etc.

9. Fine early, off Larnaca by about 8. Decided to get off here as uncertain about stop at Famagusta. Took in motor boat; no trouble customs or acc nice young Brit fellow who had come

on board re passports. He got us a car-hire, country, lots of trees. Had gone about 7 miles when we met Bill & changed cars, fine drive 54 miles, partly along sea then inland. Reached N about 12 or 1230 - came to George Hotel where we are settled, very comfortable & pleasant, transformed private house. Went to 1 Diagras & found much nicer house than expected. Looks like better type Kephis. Bungalow but solidly built, 4 rooms on s, 3 on r - broad hall all through house. R = sitting room, central & chief workshop, hall - 1 room filled with shelves of pottery. Smoky fireplace but can work. Back to hotel for lunch, then down for a few errands incl blankets & kapot. Geo-chamfer, Tryphon - Christ - pots, Nic - chart - Lazarus Mos Guards, odd jobs in spare time on carpenter work etc. Got into to pottery till late tea 7402

Enormous amount of material, would take heaven knows how long to do all.
Back for dinner - eve before fire.

10. Fine. Poked around for a while - then off for a drive across country to Leonidarevouno where there was part of a castle w. some ancient blocks & columns & fine view around the country. Clouds here & there. Returned to Nik & over to village with little narrow road & many trees - up to Kefhalouisi then on other side down to see where real site was. Back late for lunch then over to Museum for an hour or more. Saw Dikacov's latest finds & then around in general, escorted by Gw're phylakos. Tremendous lot of pottery of all periods, also sculptures - very interesting ones from St-Denis. Back to house before 4 - worked some & played at

matching frogs before after tea. Eve sat by fire esp. talking to Ion Bank. Not as cold as previous night.

11. Heavy clouds, showers, "bright int." Late in reaching house on acc. rain, but worked till about 11.45. To PO, then Ion Bank with his better friend, then lots of errands & back about 12.45. Return to work soon after lunch, doing 403 especially. Cable from Eleazar Lida died - blessed above. Stayed at house till after 7. Got a lot done. Eve wrote it in front of fire.

12. Fine. Spent a.m. busily on pottery, intermission at 11 for coffee. Got the fire much improved by zinc sheet, hardly any smoke. After lunch got 2 table cloths from woman at door, beauties. At 1 had from 3-7.30 except for tea. Got 250 in inventory & tons of steeds. Eve was to write M

but Miss Stees has her brother here so did not get started till nearly 11, but then wrote.

13. Fine. Packed, out on verandah till time to start for Lapiithos. Off before 11, nice drive over. Plain itself dull, funny small mounds like slag, then through fine mt. pass. Excellent road, narrow but tarred. N side of mts. very fine, blue sea, snow mts in Cilicia opposite. Tyrenia, castle, nice little town. Seaside Hotel, excellent, very comfortable & clean, good food. Room on sea. Large salon below w. open fire. Good lunch & off to Lapi. Sun goes early there, most picturesque attractive village on side mt. Fertile, much greener on r. side. Good houses, well built-picturesque. To pub. near. Here tombs are cut through rock, which has many queer cuttings in it. Tombs = usual domos, or Spanish vestibule w. tomb on short side. Often several chambers of

domos, cupboards. Door small, often like a cave hole, tombs very low, not much over 1m. Sometimes run into each other. Extraordinary they hold so much. Next to geom. (nearest, but by sea). Entrances much like BA domos, but often tomb looks like big fireplace, low & broad niche w. entrance. In BA occas. frame around door, some steps, mostly steps - few, - forerunner Doric triglyph in one. Scr. burial. From Geom to house (Hell. or Rom) with cis. turn pits. To L. house for tea, marvellous cake! Back to hotel for night, many Brits here but mostly went to dance & left us the pie-sea lady (mit-dan) stayed home. Earlier got postcards & stat. from Nora Scott Miss Dennis. Spent comfortable eve with detective story.

14. Fine but windy. Errand in town, then Geo sent a car for us & we went back to R house & helped DC measure for her plan tile lunch time. Lovely place but cutting wind. Most glorious lunch w. partridges,

to other house to call on mother & several daughters, charming people, hor glyko. Then up to other Geom. com. near boy's sch. on one of the rock terraces. Hotel & girls' sch. on a higher one, reminds you of Sorrento. Some good tombs there. Had gorgeous view from high up. Lambusa off to r. f. geom. com. near sea. Down to Pub. again, off about 4.20 got things at hotel & drove back to R. Here by 6 & went for water sticks, then hotel. Seemed very cold, but good fires. Sat by one w/ me, talker & singer, Mrs. Reece, nat. her Sketch & finished foolish book.

15. Fine, clouds at times, began badly but cleared. To house about 9. Geo litened up & we went to town to Hadjikyriakou & ordered grill for fireplace, then to market & got dress material, bags, dish towels. House before 10, tried improvements in fire, good olive wood - Much war-

mer & better though still somewhat smoky. Worked all day on pots - frags from 406. Did inventory nice DC. At it all day except intervals for lunch & tea. Board back for dinner. Current fire in eve.

16. Fine, milder, good sun. Worked hard all day, 406, 409, lots of things. At it steadily, only stopping for lunch & tea. Call from Dikaios. Dance at hotel, so had fire in bedroom. Wrote M.

17. Fine. Off in good time for trip to Vouni. DC stayed home. Across through bare & dry country w/ a few villages, past Perist. - on bare - stone hill. Stopped at - for oranges on by twisting road past Soli to nearest point for V. Pulled up under tree. Took lunch & climbed to top. Very imperscr., wonderful position & view across Morphou Bay & to Cil. mts snowy mts. Hills & hills piled together towards Troodos. 2 principal areas on top of palace w/ great knifelike 4x3

court w. sunken area + deep well, + large fiddle-shaped idol + head at center + curv. below. Great broad flight of about 8-10 steps where we sat for lunch. General effect rather like Phoen. Dated XI cent. Corridors + rooms, magazines w. hollows for pithoi, many wells, cisterns etc, complex heating system. Paving mostly terracotta, many flights of stairs + terraces. Mostly large stone + ortho. blocks + mud walls to indicate ground structure - framing, but perh. walls not left high enough. Pottery frags. make early II as likely as XI. Archaic stat. in Sarden. Later to 21 on other side hill, rem. early temple (not too clear) much rock near surface, lots of other walls, puccini - prob. Fine veins in every direction. Later drove to rear Soli to very confused tree of Iesis-Aph(?) hard to decipher. Then

to Rom Theatre, carved cut-in rock, facing gone, great parod. on one side, stairs, large stage buildings, prob. n. 3 doors to arch + passage from under stage. Then around bay to Moshpon, large village + back for latish tea at Geo. upstairs by fire. Eve got sleepy over stay, early bed. 18. Fine but still cold. Spent all day hard at it - on pots as usual. Slow but steady. Eve played bridge, J. J. is L + B.

19. Fine, cold. Decided to work in sun on rhombah. L + I made lists of fronts + their contents all morning. B went to Tigr. to see about Lambousa permit. Back to pots in pm. Fire behaving better. Eve sat talking about fire, + Rees, Blackall, + 4 of us.

20. Fine, cold. J. Cox dictated summary of results - later I typed it out. Took ages, so nearly 1/2 when I started on pots. After lunch L rear + I typed several of

The tomb lists for our home. Dressed as decently as possible to go with the du Plat Taylors. Nice warm house outside town a couple of miles. Pleasant time - Sat. in Mrs. Mrs' home before. Back to write letters before dinner. Wrote Mr. Green. After dinner wrote H. Fine fire very comfortable.

21. Slightly cloudy, still cold. Grey and day windy. No sun for verandah. Typed a little on typewriter but spent most of day at pottery. B went off after tea to L. to see about filling in tomb before imminent rain. Eve sat around fire & talked mostly w. Mrs R. & B, read a little Police at Funeral afterwards. Others at Tomboy dance.

22. Poured and blew like mad in the night. Wet day, managed to get to room 1 Diag. in carriages. Put in hard day at pottery. Rain stopped at intervals. Put up B's curtains. Rain let up & we

walked back to hotel. Moon came out in eve. Wrote long letter to Marjorie - huge pile of mail came pm, many Xmas cards all forwarded from others. Talked to Miss STG after others had left.

23. Wet again though less violent. Let up & walked to ETCC & sent NLT to mother - wire to A.R. to tell them we should not be back. To post stamps, began to rain so took carriage back to 1 Diag & joined L & D on pots. All day at it. B came back from L. Bridge in eve L & D too. B & D.

24. Fine. Decided before it cleared that we'd work all day & get on with things. Any way Gao hurt hand cranking car and was at Larnaca, sent wire. Plugged along at it steadily. Eve tried to read but too much conversation until lateish.

25. Unsettled, B & D could not tell about weather for L - anyway G did not come early & then car misbehaved so they did

not get away until about 1/2, but meanwhile we had done more inventory. Left back early and got all done by about 7. Finished prehist = L 438 total 903 pots in inventory, innumerable no. not access. + some thrown out. Celebrated mildly with a remount + a gift to Christo. Gave sat by fire, finished Policia at Funeral, excellent.

Gothic, fine doorway, whit-campanile, abbots

quarters on W side all gone. Views - site magnificent. To K + left coast at sea side + went around sea to look at castles, fine round tower to W + smaller to E along sea wall, fine surf, splendid view towards Tarparas. Low clouds covered Cilicia, did not see it at all. Clouded over during lunch, which we enjoyed. Off soon after 2 for Lap. + to house where B + D were just finishing lunch. Saw paraf. stellet. in apertures. Did not stay long but collected SC + took her pp. O + G to stay another day. 5. Fine, breezy. Started on geom. pots and kept at it hard all day until 4 when we changed & went to tea at the Sideris. He is chief cit. of Kypr, she handsome & charming, don't care at this time. Dick came in during tea. Bought him back as far as hotel. Changed shoes & back to work 6 - nearly 8. Got a lot done. Eve around fire, Ben packed.

6. Fine, then cloudy. Sent 2 Rovs by bus to Limassol. At house for a.m. work till after 11, then to Mrs. Dick gave us 2 fresh. 1/2 sp. bowls. Saw corn coll. Gunther now deposited in Museum. 16. Grey but not wet. Thankful to reach Pn. about 8.30. At home soon after 9. Posted letter to B for Wm d. Stopped at Maihi's. Clear to get home, everything fine. Unpacked & sent nearly everything to cleaners & wash. Grand tubs. Heaps of letters, cards etc. Put in at lunch time looks fine - General clearing out - looking over & tidying up - Maihi at 6.
