


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October 28, 1935 - June 13, 1936

Oct. 28. Greyish, milder. Didn't get much done except odds & ends - passing, suit etc. Began L - Off by 2<sup>3/4</sup> bus, stopped Faulkner & Oake & to Mrs Hopewell, also Mrs Templer & later Miss Ivens before tea. Got bus at Cent Hotel 6<sup>30</sup> through to Binton. Early supper - back to Dickens com. Wrote more L in eve 8-9 until T came back. Read more practice. Has it by Haydn  
- Brahms (B667) <sup>G64</sup>

29. Sunny! hazy, rather mild. Cleared up a lot in date in a.m. More to L & sun by R early. While T practised, I had great hoicing out in room. Wrote Majorie, K, Fraser, J. H. T., Patrick before lunch. Read Tel after, copied Twp. cut newspapers, heard gram & today Sym, some Carmen etc. To tea 4.15 Mrs Lovett to see Queenie & her sister Mrs Leving who now are in Rugby. New neighbours (Miss Cost.) There also a young man, Mr L - dan. Stayed a long time. Foundations: Early

madrigals Peter R got car back from Coventry. Finished poacher. Went to Brang's for coffee. saw pictures of their trip. Did Obs. anagrams before after supper  
30. Fine but greyish. I went to Ryburgh & after look at papers had a go at Jane off & on all the morning. Bridge pm Gregours, also at my table Brown, Mrs G, Maule; & at T. Irene, Samuelson, Brang. Lost 2 now, total loss c. 3<sup>£</sup>. All back together in bus. Eve T. V music rehearsal, heard some choruses - D'Anangi in Tardini.

31. Dark & dismal, some rain. Went to Jakt, odds & ends. Began L. Rat come Jane. Cook gram. Chanson Poeme (measured) Early supper. Music Club at Ch. House small hall, R took us both ways. Quartet Haydn G64, Noz. Trout 2 Scarlatti Arias with IV, fine. Rushed

back for news. but all is upset with elec. horn speeches.

Nov 1. Wet day, but did clear p.m. Went to R. posted 3 pack. books, Parrin (L's clock & parts) wool, dairy wool went & back on 10. Ethel here. Heard end practice. Papers - tea, jam Bridge p.m. Hesker's, weather still overtaken by the Brang. Our table: Haigh, Sam, Slade; T. Maule, Hesker, Hopewell. Stayed till late after party ended & had game the next day. Saw boy. Won back part of losses. Eve some transit music, songs - cho. for which we didn't care much. Wrote K, began 141  
2. Cloudy, warmer. Went fairly early with Chrys. Then to get a second Tunes. Cleared out - clipped many papers. R - out for golf p.m. Trout in first - cold. Not so bad as it was pretty muddy. Did 12 holes. Back for tea, got JL N with Piet's Agora pot. T - I did Tunes, 141

Moreilly Spring.

2. Fine morning, rain before night. all off also Barbara. To & I played, 2 down but both fairly decent. Back in good time. Tony was "Snagroping" which we never expected to get but did. Read ST, Ob, wrote B, H, 2 Tony. Some L + M Crumich before breakfast.

4. Unsettled but not bad. Off to London 9:30 very comfortable. Coffee at flat then to G & Co. for good interview with Romano, visa + furniture. Sat time to do anything at table. Met K Able for lunch. Left about 3 back ST & I + Paul M to Am Ex - Quickly done about freight + ordering tickets. Presented into Cont. Handbook (railway). Back to flat for tea + puzzles + supper. Eve to "Espionage" most amusing show chirpy on train on exp. with Malone very funny.

5. Fine. Out in good time to Dorothy in Bradford for hat + while they were getting it went along Baker St etc. Supper for apartment. Back to flat. Walk to 8 Hanover for lunch with Dr Cullis + afterwards coffee in S.C.R. with a cheerful crowd. Nice chat, left early, went Shaftesbury, Regent etc. looking at dresses. Tea at 7, Celia Shubbeau there. Left early for Burlington House, Nellenic meeting. Sat with Joan Evans, Talbot-Rice excellent on Evan. info. on Cleo + Cap Byz. Remarks, Sykes, GF Hill + Sir A. whom I saw. Back for supper at no 4, to Marie Tempest, S Thordyke + Attwatters in "Short Story" rather Mrs Tragerish, wonderful acting - a delicious show.

6. Fine, sunny morning. Began L. One - about 10, left car Achille, then to Buck P with crowd + saw part of wedding

procession & afterwards royal fam.  
on balcony - huge mob, back wall green  
Pork. Lunch at bistro under tree.  
Back to flat; out c 3 - saw procession  
en route to St P, open carriage w. t.  
and positions, police - guards escort.  
Finisterre L. Early tea. Sun Time Book  
Exhibit. Dorset Hall. Fine show, huge  
crowd - Heard Agate, S Thorndike in  
chair. Great squash. It - s but each  
other in crowd but met at Queen's  
Hall. 313c (Harty) Don J, Chopin I  
exquisitely played by Josef Hoffmann,  
Moz. Var. - Finale (Dvorak), Walton  
Symphony, very mod but interesting.  
Not bite of supper in interval. Twists  
ankle, not too bad. Did Tel. curson.  
7. Greyish, mild fog. R. out for errands  
- I stayed in - rested feet. Took  
arr. 11.15; coffee & out soon. Begun

to rain. Taxi to Leic. Sq. Th. for "Moscow  
Nights" fine film, Baur, Olivier, P. Dudley  
Ward. To Corner H. for late lunch. Pouring  
K. To see me on bus - I lent T umbrella.  
Out at "Tatler" for 1/2 hr. Then flat. Mrs G  
made tea. Taxi Weston - lots of  
wom. R. met me. Quiet - we went  
papers etc.

8. Misty, then clear. Wrote L, Effie before  
breakfast. Spent a.m. indoors, papers, pres-  
sing, Jane. After lunch R & I called for  
Marc, Den to Plaza hoping to see Stoats on  
screen, news changed, wedding pictures -  
G Fields "Look up & Laugh" very funny. Met  
Rita on return bus, late tea. Took back  
at 7. We did Tel., not RTM & Delius  
(fassettine)

9. Wet, clearing. Wrote K, Mabel G, Hughes - S.  
before breakfast. T. off for poppy day  
boxes. Tawny chirp. To church. Papers -

- Jane rest of a.m. All out golf in p.m. & did 9 holes. Clouded quite decent but muddy. Back good time for tea. T & I did Times puzzle + an Everyman. Eve read Dickens.
10. Fine, some clouds. Wrote Riste, B, 4 race, Bradford, 15, did all sorts of nashy etc. R to church parade so T & I did some Toyp. in morning. Out after lunch to golf, did 9 holes, dark early, good game, rather muddy - Back about 4<sup>30</sup>. After tea got the rest of Toyp, read papers, also in eve. Stratton IV did Quintets Dorset - Poullen, Dick in Schub, Schum etc. incl. Forelle. Eve had Verdi selections + BBC + William F min. sym Elgar I.
11. Armistice Day. Misty at first, then cleared. Up 5<sup>30</sup> and T, R, I left 6<sup>15</sup> for Wroth Silsbee. Stopped on way at

Dun Cow + saw Simpson, took train with us. Good crowd there and so at breakfast. Sat between Mr & Mrs Frost. Tom responded for visitors. Old crowd, Bussy, Eadon, Quas. etc. new. Comic songs by Tom + another. New landlord = Moon. Breakfast, health to old - new dukes, 4 rums. Back soon after 9. Parker consulted morning, but paper, went off, read Jane etc. Pm bridge at Boothroyds. Picked up by Walford + "Wales". Others there were Mrs B, Mrs W, Mrs half + J., Mrs M, Nettle, Brown, Tom. Barbara took T's place when I left early to see Hoskyn about R. Must start holiday Friday - Cardiff back. P out at Legion dinner. Did ex. + others, finished Dickens. Of course it was Cenotaph service we had from 10.30 on. Very impressive.

12. Fine. Off for London, train comfortable but late more than 1/2 hr. So stayed

wrote to Hill after 12. Got new umbrella<sup>①</sup> at Pound's. Met Peter & Effie at Cei. at 1, also Cecil & Sibyl Sanderson & all had an excellent lunch - cheery time. Went to Ambex & drew cheques, paid tickets - £<sup>200</sup><sub>34</sub>. freight, then back to flat for early tea. BSA meeting at 5, saw Dilys, Blakeway & fiancee, Austin Jenkins, Evans, Clare who sat with me, Miss Lorimer, talk afterwards with her. G.F. Hill in chair - Blakeway on tombs at 11 hrs. much good material well interpreted but a dull lecture. Back 6.45, supper in. To "Call It a Day" very amusing. Fay Compton Brown gave in chief part. Crossword on return.

13. Rain in night, but cleared. Stayed in till 11 am. about 11. All has coffee - then T + I to Bourne + H. looking for chick Amy Blatt. All gone, walk to Nudle-

noman, has none, then to Hague where they tel - found out. Taxi to Willingham House, Drindley Scott with whom Major & Mrs. Ro are staying. Beautiful house, old furniture, Chinese, porcelain, terrace-garden, big col. will heads, reupt. plants etc. Delightful party, others: 2 Murray whom we had met at Sir H.H.S. private view last year. So good to see Mr. S again. He looks very handsome though he says not well. Delic. lunch, much talk, turn in garden. Left before 3 - up Sloane St. T to J.ations for wool & I finally after long wait - for 73 by underground to Regent's Park - down to RIBA, look through a delightful vol. of Cockrell but got nothing about Ruth. To Q Hall & got ticket for 24<sup>5</sup>, back for tea. Form, K, T - Mrs. (formerly Weston) + had a nice time. Brief rest before dressing

for Huguenot dinner at Russell.  
A most pleasant affair, in lounge for  
removals, then 2 long tables, had  
on one side - pleasant people next -  
across - Fine dinner. Adjourned for  
coffee & returned to find chairs set up  
for lecture - Leo Brit. on Effect of A  
vits nomination, a splendid speech  
in best acad + parl. style. Saw him  
before + after - Back about 11, T pack  
& I saw her into taxi for Euston. Got  
ton to meet her. Nearly fell asleep  
over puzzle, so to bed. No rain all day.

14. Election Day. Wet - underfoot, but dry.  
Off 9.30 to Seeps. for hair at 10. Left  
to Whitehall Th. for tickets, then to  
Waterloo + Old Vic. for more - Back  
at 12, cleaned up + off to lunch at  
H. S. Nice time, first meeting - the  
girls - cocktails, then at lunch

Sir H - off in studio afterwards. Saw  
lots of books, things, some S. France, a  
few Greek, also book by son. Took parcel  
for Bengt. Stayed on 19 from N.P.C. to  
Sadler's Wells, 30s ticket, back to flat  
before 4, Mr. G gave me tea. Back on 5<sup>th</sup>  
had begun to drizzle, wet on way + in  
Rugby. R met me + I had time to  
change before supper when we had nice  
pheasant. Eric heard part of Gerontius  
desmond, Nash, Faust. but had to get out  
now + too much election yet.

15. Cloudy - very windy. Made up diary.  
Had rain by breakfast. T + R got off for  
Salcombe about 10, well loaded. Spent long  
time clearing out newspapers. Wrote J.A.K.,  
Macau, Fraser, Risk. Took 2.30 bus, left shores  
Albion, went to P.O. to Alderson for bridge. Had  
clouds somewhat. Others + open air. Temple  
met him, stayed late, last 3 now, came

out even. Back about 7. Eve had "Eden End",  
Stars on kitchener, BBC (Sargent) Back  
Faust. Fug. C minor, CF Sym.

16. A perfect day, bright sun, quiet, cold.  
Outc 10 to village, posted 2 book parcels, Bth,  
ordered taxi from Harold, flowers here in  
return, yellow chrys., took them, went all  
around garden, lovely out. Took 2.25 to R.  
Faulkner's bill, another book package,  
Parsons L's pearls + bill, Over, shoes from  
Allen + other odds + ends 3.20 bus out.  
Took camera + coins to winter bags, across  
fields for tea at 4. Other Mrs W. & Bill  
came too, nice quiet time, bags packed  
with things. Mrs W. gave me a lift to  
Long Barns - In about 6.15, light BBC rec.  
since it, Eve at 8 went to Rayleigh for  
bridge, nice 4, tea about 10. Several  
nubbles, lost about 2<sup>2</sup> good time.

17. Wet, horrid day - did scraps of clay out.

Much friend at non-arrival of papers, but  
I put in a busy time and wrote to T.K.,  
B. Too wet for kite so I took letters to P.O  
about 2.15 found papers on doorstep. Back  
for lots of music off + on, Rich III, eve.  
Casals conducting Preludes, Final, Triad,  
Pastorale. Sardana (Garuda) Br II. Did  
Troy. Off + on + got all but one corner -  
would have.

18. Unsettled but not so bad. Took 9.30 bus  
walked to LNER + to Oxford 10.13-12.21, very  
wet in fields, flooded to lakes all around  
Banbury + back country. Both Macaws at  
station, both fine. Lovely time, sun out  
on arrival, views from balcony. Delightful  
time, much talk. Master drove me  
to Oxford. Left umbrella. Was at Ban, 1/2  
hr, tea, open platform. One hr. at Oxord -  
ford, luckily had Bellona. Dry at Rayleigh  
- caught 7.10 bus. Heard Martin Brown

on drama, mix. Miles-Bart, Criller &  
Moz Bpt, R. Brighton Ob. or strings, R. Biggs  
Summer Landscape, party in perspective  
but think it Whitbread n.g.

19. Fair, sun out for a time. Got Priddy to  
help move trunk to T's room. Packed  
a lot, wrote T, J.B.K.T., Winnie C, also  
Rimmer & Evans. Then had to address.  
Took 2<sup>½</sup> bus, dashed to Allen's with  
books, to Midland, Paris with L's clock,  
Mrs Hardop - Also Mrs Woodward,  
Miss Curack; Greg, Miller, Temple, Taylor  
lost 1/11 then got 6d. Bad card, Jolly  
tea, great scramble at end, had to get  
6<sup>30</sup> bus at CentHotel. Rain, re-  
placed this Slade again and agreed  
not to go to West Dine - till eve.  
Nice time by fire. BBC Midland,  
Schub. Or. in Emin, Sym & Mich. Haydn,  
Mother Goose. Play "Boomerang But"

pretty poor. 150 Rosamunde, 2 Min -  
Sch Brahms, Holstel, Nids & Root,  
Debussy, Petite Suite. Real China  
Cliffes - did my. Forgot to say I got  
Tang on them - posted them.  
20. Dull grey, wet, showering. Went to Leam.  
9<sup>30</sup> to LMS, 9.55 train. Walk High Pump  
R. Gardens to Bodley's for his gloves, all  
gone, got a new too good pair - another  
at Woodnall's, potter in BStores, Borth  
Pump R. for coffee, back Rugby 10.40.  
Police Station, got 1.15 bus. More  
packing, mole master (umbrella am. in  
a.m.) t. Brown Cone: M flute, Dore (F),  
Sala in Schum 'elle cone, Eulen.  
Stopped in middle of it to go to train with  
Wagh-Mauli. Meeklyjohn. Then more  
to pack and wrote in eve to Macay, Ambleside  
F.C., Son, & Grace. Endless to do.  
21. Wet like day, packing all the time &

left out c. 11, flowers, rugly, house, over  
back to Jos before lunch. Charming house,  
she - sunny blue. More letters & pack.  
Did some passing a.m. Took long time -  
went up about 6. to dress & all lights  
went out. Late dinner with candles, light on  
in 1 hr. or so. Hester & I in Cotton's taxi to  
Grand for Mrs Thomson's party. Nice cozy  
sitting room, 3 tables: Alderson, Asturias,  
Templer, Everett, Woodworth, some more I  
forget & some strangers. Supper in middle.  
Good time tho' lost 7/6. Hester stayed to  
a dance & got back c. 11.30, still very wet.  
Car practically all packed but 1 car & bag.  
22. Fair but grey. Up early 8.15 - breakfast,  
over to say goodbye Haughey, Howard & 40;  
Percy helped, 9.30 train slightly late but  
made up, no excess. Called to 4 - left many  
things with Mrs G, took trunk & shoe box  
& Victoria. Went to Th. for ticket, back to

flat, unpacked a little, had a vermouth -  
Lunch latish Cam. to Hell Sc 4/11 3.30 -  
Saw Barnet - subscriber 2.2.0 for PSSA.  
7.30 to Ad. Rd. tea Rink. 4 in bed, 2 missed,  
K very fumble but snit all right in mind  
not day - Keisha carrying on nobly. To  
Essex for light supper & ill. papers till 7.30.  
To W. Th. "Timon of Athens" play -  
very badly acted. Ernest Milton worst type of  
red-stagey. Settys - costumes ridiculous,  
but gear to go for here will never be another.  
Back c. 11.30 & 5 am. from Oxford about 2  
miles earlier. Tax only, too late for fare.  
23. Fine, no umbrella all day. Didn't worry  
about getting up. Went 11 to Stenarts - met  
Winnie C. for coffee & much gossip. Met K  
12.30 Brasserie for lunch - went to House  
for supplies. Back to flat for a little -  
then to Books at Wells - met Mrs Bell  
here - Ronsal 5th very good, all well

done, orig. Morris' version - very long.  
Got out Kingsway to see Stoe house of 39  
steps, huge gables, back for early supper-  
tea. nice time. Out c 8 - to Poly to 39 steps  
better even than first time - Also nice  
film on Ceylon. Back soon after 11. Read  
papers in bed.

24. Fine, sun out. Lather for Sunday, wash  
up, - letters. Coat white done, poster to  
L & T. Got papers on way to A Hall-  
Bucham, Bath TR, Piattiq. Drouot,  
Fair Hair Prett, Rom. Carnival. Back  
late, to Conway Hall, S. Place concert,  
London Trio, Drouot, solo by each, also  
says retarma, too long. Left before  
end taking hats off to supper.  
Not much eve left after they went,  
but sat Ob & St & began Torg.

25. Fine. Began H, cleaned up, out to hilli-  
cal funeral procession, got on curb.

opp. North. Sat on parapet so we saw  
it all well. To Lyons for provisions, back  
to get ready. T & T and Mary Patrick  
to lunch. nice party. Later to Esse  
where had H Fraser & Evans to tea.  
Supper in flat - w "Anthony & Anna",  
not as good as might be. Sat in bed &  
did Torg. till all hours.

26. Fine. Coat wash. Wined L, copied Torg.  
Went to lecture near Pic O to see pro-  
cession. Met to Mrs Griffith Esse for  
lunch. Later finished H, wrote B,  
Postons. Walk to Surf. for net etc, to  
see Mrs Renner. Early supper, Old  
pic "Three Sisters" excellent. A fine  
crowd.

27. Fine, brilliant day - Up 6<sup>50</sup>, off at 8  
to tick. to register luggage. To crowd,  
long sunshine almost to Paris  
Then dull & drizzle. L met me at

station. On to Bedford, nice room.  
Out to tea at Peny. Back for bath & change, dozed in & took it easy in eve. Good sleep.

28. Showed long sleep, up late - to Melina with Li Hung, to Louvre. Many improvements but soups are closed. Lots of int. jewellery etc & gold sauce boat (very shape) long time in early races. Back to lunch & pack. Chate L & K. Sent cheque Bsd. in Li's letter. Very tired, tea upstairs. Left c 6<sup>30</sup> for Simplon. Good double 8/9. Got wine & cake in station & had picnic supper, things from La - Left 7.40. Reading Belles.

29. Fine, cold at Domod. No house passports, enquire everywhere about money. Fine snow mts. Late coffee in compt. Milan c 10, fine across to Venice -

Triste ending with gorgeous sunset. Began cloudy night. Left Triste about dark.

30. Greyish & sun alternating. Did not come to life till after Belgrade. Dull & muddy down Morava but fine colors of tree & shrubs, mts. Nothing special to record, very comfortable all the way. Early dinner before Salonika. Dark there, no scenes such as Aly Temple etc.

Dec 1. Fine, lovely sunny morning, snow on Melica, Parn. etc. Up about Amphitheatre, gorgeous scenery. Papers at breakfast, demeuses cabinet. Am. a little late, c 11. Met by John Cook, A.R. John Cook ex. Very rough but polite customs man, all o.k. Very easy previous day at Chengheli. Home about 11<sup>30</sup> all fine - no rain.

Eugenio. Got partly unpacked before lunch. Much mail but little of importance, looked it over after lunch, more unpacking - tubs. Home lonely in garden after lunch. Tea by ourselves but TV in for much talk after, then Jamie. Got end Augusteo with Death & Trans. Lonely Brahms from Hobart in eve. AcaS, & Tone (who?), IS you which I followed with score. Beds fine.

2. Cloudy, mild. Long sleep - up late. Then a horrible time with acts. Out to Hobart & Philippe & Henderson. Ph. fine about doing hats quickly. Most of p.m. unpacking & contingencies. Very tired, raced us up. Dinner - to Olympia, Hubermann in Treb, Delius, Beeth. Had to sit in front row, but less bad than expected. Huge crowd. Saw lots we knew. Out late - to Psycho

dinner with daises, Ralph, & Jeanette. It's nice. Much talk, back c 11.45.

3. Greyish, mild, windy. Wrote TH, K. Did not go out at all in am. so much to do in house. Read a lot about - Olympia in Hesperia. After tea to typist, then Regs, then Vanili. More by eve.

4. Perfect day. Didn't get started till late but went to Hobart where we met Ladd, & Ado, Architect & then to Acropolis. Hitci Temple down but bastion seems untouched. Perfect up there. Met Xenoph. Bl. then to Kelop. to saw Dr & Dr M.

After lunch began Amst C, then out crowds - to Elmois, road crammed for H Barbara. Walk B after tea. Eve to Oid. Rex at Nat. Good in general but not too impressive. Did too old & fat.

5. Fine, some clouds. Began letter Amst C.

HT in wire note but we kept her. Costa took appl. for permits de séjour. Finished ECT began May 1. Piano tuner here. Addressed envelopes to Xmas cards after lunch. Out c 5<sup>30</sup> to P Taylor's to tea, also Mary, Mac V, Morton, Gauss, Taylor, Alrich, Gould, Firth & many more. Much to eat. Back before 5. Eve did err. again till about 11.45 - add. all USA - put in cards. Still lots to write in way of notes.

6. Fine. Good art in Troia about archaic Ital. metope from Hera T. Mon Xmas prep. L - I out c 11 to Druij with many things. Glad to see us, new rooms very nice. To Pris, Hdp etc, Alex for Xmas supplies. Worked on cards after lunch till 3<sup>30</sup> met at 4 Regr. at Palla for Ricossa in Romance. Not as good as other, tho' he was, too Germanic, but clever duplication

Negr. back here for tea, found Mrs Stevens here. Much talk. Broke up soon after & read papers till dinner. Eve put stamps (3 each) on about 200 envelopes. Respighi from Florence, Sinfonietta, Q. of Shubra.

7. Fine. Had an orgy of cards and letters most of the day. Sent off about 200 by John and more in pm by Ath, Hdp etc in some, nato in some. Also letters to CBS, MFN, Jen, Waite, GMH. Stopped in middle of day when Beck called to take us to lunch at Glyphada, his new house. Picked up 2 at OTB, Norton Fellow & Mem. of Finan. Com. Has a very good time, all interested in music & good talkers, very late beginning. Charming house, delicious lunch, fine party. Not home till 4<sup>30</sup>. Bet. tea & dinner did Tony - got it. Letters in eve.

8. Fine. Up earlier. Wrote T while L went to flower market, also Malayan. To concert, all St Isaac, Hercules, Omph, Phœton, Piano Conc (Yvonne Léfeuvre, very good) Macabre, March Bourguign. Has been big benefit the night before. Wrote T after lunch, out c 2.45 - including to do the S but took road to Vani, pp which we digressed & went to the sea then back by divers ways to Vani & home for tea. Wrote Uncle H, out 6<sup>30</sup> for good call on Miller, then Eng. Many there, had fine talk with Mr. Eng. Eve wrote Alice S & Geo. Time for bed.

9. Grey, very windy. Wrote C.H.M., W.r. I, more cards. Out 12 to Orija. Finished W.r. II, 7 W, Birdling. Too disagreeable to go out, caught up some papers, L & I did a few crosswords. Extra det. in at tea time.

Finished Volcano in eve.

10. Slightly overcast, had rain in night. Out for errands, got clips, Germ Sch. where we met B. Geog. - had dinner with him - trench, to Phil. Fine in p.m. - out with a few cards 20 or so which we left before tea. Drove to Phoibitai, very good.

11. Fine at first. Went c 11 to Museum & found Wagner & AlWK, called on Phil. On to Ong at 12. Read some Hesp. Out c 4 & played with cards ending at Davies' - stayed to tea with Mr. & Mrs. Gordon. 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## SENATOR ORSI

### A GREAT ITALIAN ARCHAEOLOGIST

Mrs. Arthur Strong writes on information kindly provided by the Società Magna Graecia:

It is doubtless owing to the political pre-occupations of the hour that the death of the illustrious archaeologist, Paolo Orsi, which occurred on November 8 at Rovereto, has passed almost unnoticed. Yet his loss will be felt in the world of learning far beyond the boundaries of Italy. Orsi was born in 1859 at Rovereto, then in Austrian territory, but, his studies being completed, he chose, out of loyalty to his Italian origins, to settle in Italy. His monographs on the Trentino and a volume on the Cave of the Idaean Zeus in Crete revealed his rare gifts of scholarship.

In 1888 he successfully competed for the post of inspector in the Museum of Syracuse, of which he was soon afterwards appointed director. He declined the offer of more than one brilliant university post in order to remain at Syracuse, where, in consequence of his epoch-making discoveries of the Siculan civilization and of the Greek cities of the island, the museum was to become one of the richest and most interesting in the country. The exploration of the Neolithic villages of Stentinello, near Syracuse, and of innumerable burial grounds, enabled him to distinguish four periods of Siculan culture from the early Chalcolithic age of the second millennium B.C. to the fifth century B.C., when the Siculan culture was submerged by the Greek. 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In 1907 he was appointed *soprintendente* of Calabria and Basilicata. In Calabria he discovered the important pre-Hellenic sites of Torre Galli, near Monteleone, and of Canale, near Locri, which, according to Alberg and Randall-MacIver, mark a decisive date in the study of the pre-history of the peninsula. At Locri, where he laid bare, among others, the only specimen of an Ionic temple so far known in Magna Graecia or Sicily, he discovered the superb and now famous figured *pinakes*. Orsi's notable campaigns at Caulonia, Hipponion, Medma, and at the shrine of Apollo Alaios, near Ciro, were in part financed by the Società Magna Graecia, of which he was president up to the time of his death. The precious material from these finds will, it is hoped, shortly be exhibited in the museum now under construction at Reggio-Calabria—a standing memorial of Orsi's services to the archaeology of Magna Graecia. The Byzantine churches of Calabria were also studied by Orsi, who published a fine volume on the Basilian churches of the region.

In order generously to endow and help the cultural institutes and the social services of Syracuse and of his native Rovereto, he lived for 40 years in a small inn; his life, indeed, was one of continuous sacrifice that he might devote his own modest income to his archaeological campaigns. When, after the War, he returned to Rovereto, now restored to Italy, it was to find his paternal house despoiled by the Austrians, and his rich collection of antiques, his library, and his scientific correspondence scattered to the winds. He was a member of the Accademia del Lincei, and was made a Senator in 1924. Among his many foreign honours was that of honorary member of the Society for the Promotion of Hellenic Studies.
