

September 14, 1938 - September 26, 1939

Sept 4. Misty at first - cleared fine. Finished AC in bed. Not up too early. Spent all a.m. unpacking everything - lots of cups, boards - drawers for items. Many hung out on porch to get wrinkles out. L in village doing errands. Wrote to Geo. after lunch. Out c 4 pm drive, Wilm. - river walk, ski jump, village golf course. Back to Club for mail - tea. Eve played Chinese checkers, great fun. Then daps in The Beast Must Die, by Rich. Blake.

5. Showery, sometimes clear. Did odds - ends & wrote B, sent cheque for wages. Out c 11 to village, including Worcester Sport Shop, took back 3 pairs, 2 too small. Hat fitter. L had ordered a blue wool for me, not here yet. Papers after lunch. Out 3 to try on - then Saranac. Left 2 hats to be done, bought a navy felt, Sketon. Finished The Beast before

dinner, Eve some news & ch. to Mif. 2 games checkers, began Hasty Marriage.

16. Clouds on mts. Partly f., partly cloudy w. L in a.m. More f. after lunch, still checkers on mts. Out latish to Brewster. Bill had come, also B+H refitted. Ordered coat. Back before 6 - L & I had walk on golf course. ^{Stiff with} Eve 2 games, finished walk.

17. Unsettled, milder. Slept most a.m. turning up hem on thread skirt; L put pins in, pressed it - a blue day. Before lunch - L, C, I out before 3 to practise course, showering, caught in rain, but did the 9 holes. Back 4.30 & did more f. on classifying authors in refs. Eve paper, 2 games. Began Street Dust.

18. Unsettled, mist, some sun. All a.m. cleaning shoes, silver, gloves etc. Began H. Enormous dinner, some music incl. 2 interl. Sust. Ruth Rom G, for Hung. Read NYT &

Hes. Trib. Out before 4 to practise course. L round once, C & I did 20 holes. On return found Dudley Johnson & his brother - all had trout. Got our supper, mostly left ready. Eve Bach Cantata, mostly news sum. 2 games. Began Croft's latest. End of Advent Harrison. 19. Still unsettled. Laundry etc. Finished & I did did up her book to hat. Knit T. Papers after lunch, later L C & I to practise course - C & I 15, L 9. A few drops before return. Bill hub. Eve 2 games. Crofts.

20. Wet, worst day yet. All up late. L & I to Club to see if any news for me, no luck. To Saanac, left both silver necklace for new chains, Woolworth, ribbon etc., Mr. Johnson both my black hats ready, also several L's. Back to Brewster & put on B+H refitted, also new blue wool. Sewed loops, did washing etc.

Wrote B+Co, M.B. L starting, putting on packing. Ere 2 games, began Agq.

21. Wet, just as bad as yesterday. Nearly snowed out. Did up 6 packages of books (t) to Athens & 2 lots clothes for L. Wrote Royal, KMFN, mid-night, GS, partly a.m., partly p.m. Later L, C, I sorted Troy prints (3894) while C worked. Before & after dinner C & I did all the small ones. c 200.

22. Unsettled, windy, sun now & then. Late start, L upstairs. Discussed clothes to pack etc. Cleaned bag, rev. silver, sewing bag & all scraps. Paper after lunch, L & I did several M. Guard. cross words. Out c 5 & left her at modiste & went to Sarasac for ^{Precious} necklaces. Rain. Back c 6.30. Terrible floods - hurricane on Ad. cont.

Ere news, 2 games, Mammoth Mansions, Myrt.

23. Wet again, not always raining. Put in a very domestic a.m. after writing H-

Tried luggage in car. Mended pullover T made me. Washing & cleaning. Putting shining in suit blouse, rifled out in cleaning. Awful job, before & after lunch. L out soon after 3. Real Hume. Out 4.30, hair done, back after 6. Ere news, 2 games, finished Hume.

24. Unsettled, but some bright intervals. Spent most a.m. doing a terrific lot of pressing. Started packing trunk p.m. C & I on practice. Ere 3 games, finished Agqan.

25. Fine! brilliant autumn day. Clock changed i. had longer morning. More time & more in car for P.M. C & I out 12.30, shakingly late back, 2 rounds. Large dinner, 11th Times. 2 Lauderdale bags about 4, photos, ice cream. Left them with L, C, Ray & I up Whiteface. Magnificent drive & view. Tunnel, lift, top house, castle. Saw all over mts. - lakes, fine sunset. Back 6.30, more packing. Pack Pantata fr. Forgot change of hose

for news, but got it - later. 2 games.

26. Fine, clear, cool. Wrote T. Rest 2 a.m. washing, packing, tying books, helping dismantle. Out c 1145 to see C off on train, then errands in village. 2 - after 3.30 11s. tenning to Hitler. More packing till 6 or so. Wrote B. Went over to Mrs M^cC and read paper - Moonflier till she came back.

27. Thunder shower early, cleared some, but rain again till nearly noon. Did all the last things & left house c 9.30 in a deluge. To club, Brewster for coat, then via Saranac, Clear, Tupper & returned to Water town. Mostly very wet, but less yesterday. Went down a lot, through farming country. Lunch in Cortland, Super Grill. Left before 1.00. Clear by then, sun out sometimes, via Watertown, side of Ontario, Oswego, Auburn - reached Well before 4. About 260 for the run.

T. & G. gave us warm welcome - House lovely with all new improvements. Tea, boathouse - lake. Many news bulletins, much gossip, good cocktails - dinner. Saw Ni's moving pictures in his 411 after 11, more talk, late to bed, later to sleep.

28. Fine, grand day - up late, off c 10.30 to Ithaca & saw Cornell campus, then to library etc. Lunch Swedish place. Afterwards to T. Falls & along C Lake - back by 4.15. Got news & more news off - on. Very dramatic. Bridge etc. Before that saw a lot of Ni's old 12 photos etc.

29. Fine, less brilliant. I went to paint - & found my hat. Charlie called. Saw some funny old newspaper pictures. Went in Ni's new Ply. mouth for eggs. Waffles for lunch. Off soon after 2.15, fine drive, rolling country almost due E to turn for Cady, & to Sodus - Pinckney by tea time. c 100m.

Alice OTIS & Dulles here for tea. In same room & next. To Rosalie's before dark, a brief call. Myron came for supper, much talk, round table debate on Greek situation, thought it pretty futile. Fine big fire-chat.

30. Fine, mild sun in & out. Very early, break fast & papers in bed. Later to Coopers-town, saw sights, called Miss Bowen & saw her photos & had sherry. Lunch Mrs Hyde, charming house above lake. Daughter, KC, coming to Greece. Drove through grounds to large house. Back c. 3 and met a Fletcher till tea. Miss Bowen, Mrs Morgan, ~~McKee~~² McKee Mrs., & Warner, Mrs. Lee Rosalie. Nice party lasted till nearly 7. Quiet nice evening, F full of places.

Oct 1. Fine. Left c. 11 via Oneonta & Catskills, grand foliage, splendid

drive. Very sketchy lunch Fleischmanns, most hotels closed. Came Ashland, Lexington, Bridge. Alum H. before & called up ETH & CS who came to tea. Marie big dinner, 2 MCC, 2 Tanks, 2 Chat, Forks, White, CMT, GS, ETH, 14 in all. Everyone very mellow after cocktails mixed by MacL. Great success, all had fine time.

2. Fine, another glorious day. Wrote F, N, Geo. To ETH early, L to Chet. about 11.45 to ETH & CS and up to Strasburg to new park and inn on point - lonely place, H took many photos, huge feast. Back c. 3 to see Museum, cars now ready. Fine. Drove as far as bridge & back by trolley. Checked, saw post paper. Marie to tea. Off 6.30 with GS & H to Nelson for supper, met Charles. Saw Higgins. Back to Davison to see G's paintings here she came to see L's. Turned

in early, papers in bed. Had mat Roeferry Riddle, maid.

3. Fine. L off to Billy c 8.45. San MB's packed. Wrote Uncle Jim. Made up diary. GS came in. Took things to tailor. Off c 11.30 and got just past Milton where I remembered fur so we went back for it. Had a gorgeous drive. Lunch at Storm King dam at Cornwall, fine view over river. West Point looked very fine. Came Bear Mt. park, lots of lakes, grand foliage. Tuxedo but all that part is ruined by big though root. Zigsag over to Englewood, Alice's before t. Then the houses by blue awnings, delightfully comfortable. Car in her garage. M. Doane here. Got unpacked before tea, much talk. M did cocktails. Eve to car - Col. Eccles were in. M, "Puckles" - I, bridge, several

rubbers. Saw A's col. movies of garden. Party lasted late.

4. Fine. Laundry about rising, break. at q. Finished T's letter before we left for NY in A's car - very quick now with new highway on river. Got theater tickets, then left M.D.'s bag at his office & packed from car. To LST for maids' uniforms, aprons, silk underwear. L to Harsa 11.30. Packed round shop, ordered lace - silk flock for next outfit. Met L at H's, bus to Met. Lunch Girle & Myrtilla in court, then to office to see big Medicaid van. Left 3.15 & met Jimmy 57^E & to Eng. in his car. Takes no time at all. Hair done at George's. Taxi back. Bill came for b, and short nice quiet evening before fire.

5. Fine. L off c 10 for errands. Wrote Dot. Made up diary. Wrote Geo & a tremendous long letter to Gov. in Macq.

Esther in for short call before lunch.
Left soon after lunch to Cloisters, which
are simply fine, both as to contents
& position. Bus & to Rock Centre to AA
about car above, then Saks - taxi to
Mrs Bacon, now call. Friend Miss

No hot beer in Const-a-lot.

Mrs B lively as ever. Dashed to now
Longchamps - met Alice for din-
ner, very gay. To Longacre th. to "On
Borough Time"; original, far from
cheerful, D Diggers - others in fine case.
6. Grey - dull. Got bus at 10 - went to
43rd St. Showers on way, then let
up. To GCS - got L's ticket to Cis,
timetables etc. L to dentist. Began
to rain again c. 2, somewhat spott-
ed & into Sterns. Mrs Teague for
lunch. A deluge, L again to USSR,
& to Library. Torrents, bright spotted

umbrella. About drenched. Met L at
dentist, taxi to Saks, then Stat. Line -
booker Saturnia Nov 5. To passport
photo place for L. Still pouring. Taxi to
Mabel for tea & long stay. Esther &
Robt Rohr in for dinner before we left.
Pauline & Jane collected us, dined
Butler Hall, excellent. Took d to Lon-
finished in Nulne, kind a children.
don Terrace, home c. 10.30.

7. Fine. Packing. Wrote Liz, Jess, Lucy.
Called up May & finally GMH. Esther came for
us after lunch & we went there. Anne, Lucy, &
Joy also in wagon. Had sherry. Pauline for
us before 3. Left c. 3.05 for Pk. Route new
to me, via Hudson, Rindale then back face
the towns on splendid road, mostly in the
woods. Turned n. for Fishkill & along by old
route, stopped at Billings - Alum House 5:15.
Called up H. Unpacked & to GMH for cock-
tails, dined Att., had GS, CS, EHTH & 3.

Sat round - talked afterwards. Then L-I did all our repacking. Began last Mr Lin. Knobell, Fletcher.

8. Fine. Another gorgeous day, never have seen such foliage as this autumn. Left c 9.30 via Millbrook, Armenia, GYB (44.4), 7 to Westfield, got off line at Otis (out back, all along charming brook). Much evidence of storm, trees etc. From West. went S. on 10 - across to Suffield & see Ruth. Uncle J still in H. 20 cut out Hartford. Collected Ruth - Bobby - back 10 to E-Hampton, Fernwood lunch, - Northamps to FG. Great time finding 20 Elm. FG at nice rooms, left L & dashed for Springfield. Must have passed Heywards' house but all built up there. Arr. 1/2 hr. early "found train late also! Too bad we hurried from Hamp - late starting, also slow over repaired sections, terrible rain - Arr Hunt Ave - to Puritan C.F.

Geo. in lounge to meet me, very cheery but up & down. Fine nurse Mrs Adams - she went out - we had dinner in G's room - a tremendous talk till after we return. Have next room, 625.

9. Fine, sunny. Took it easy, breakfast in bed. Wrote diary, Alice, L. Out c. 11 for a tremendous walk: Comm. Ave, Garden, Common, many trees down. Stat House, went to Mt Hub. to end, new parkway, Beach St. Many changes. Back 12 1/2, in for talk & lunch with Geo & Mrs A. Left c 2 for Mrs. Henry Hill closing. Complete run round, pictures & all. Saw Wm Locke first, then to Classical on 2nd floors. Upper has a selection, lower full of rarer. Ended up in period rooms, big Catalan pieces etc. Went in taxi, walked back. Met Geo & Mrs A on way to church. Had hub - 15 m. rest. Then with Geo, Liz came c 6.30. Letter to Bill

Boston Room for drinks. Then L -> to Lulu's for dinner with Anna Foy who has charming apt. there. Taxi man couldn't find it! A delightful & we had fine eve before fire. Back c 10 -> to tell G all about it. Washing - odd. ends after.
 10. Fine. Read NYT of yesterday in bed w/ breakfast. Wrote T. very long letter. Went to Gisela, began B. Out 12.30 & met L 1/2 at Art Club for lunch, then via Subway to Han Sq. - to new Foggs which I had not seen. Spent whole p.m. there till closing. Walk in Yard. Back c 6 & L 1/2 stayed for dinner upstairs. Finished B in eve, packing.

11. Fine. Up in good time & packed more. Out soon after 9 to Mrs. & cruised around some more. Then to look for LDC, not back yet. Left note. Then saw O'Wilson. Walk to Fenway Court & prowled about

for an hour or so. Taxi back & rest p.m. - lunch time with Geo. Pretty grossy, had nap. Left for Back Bay, train 3.05. Terrible destruction all along line, trees, houses, rubbish. Have cleared up a lot. Train slow down by Matt Haven. Read "Hartford Times" (McKinney) borrowed from Geo. Got out 125th about 3/4 hr late. Found Gisela & had long talk about her book, mine, etc. Beautifully settled in guest room.
 12. Fine, warm & hazy. Brest. in bed, up in decent time, odd jobs. Had done wash & notes to Jess & Alice the night before. Took 4 Bus to Med. Centre, long wait for Sherrick bus at 11.10. Tel Mabel from waiting room - tried Lucy. Fine run, thence 10 m. to N. via Eng, Ten, Cls, Spark etc, along river road to S Myrt. Lovely day with H & H. Sat & talked steadily - both well, house looks fine -

Everything from tray to Euro. politics. Got 4.30 express & whizzed along road above cliffs. Only 3/4 hr. but long wait - for 4 because didn't know route. In after 6, quick change, wrote Geo. Guest to dinner at von Park an old dear. He & G out to theater & I to YMHA in Lex Cen to Buda II in Mozart - G maj, D min, E b maj. fine concert. Taxi back, G in soon after. Began last Partition.

13. Fine, slept unusually long. Paper, diary with T.S., pp for errands. Very unsatisfactory time. Many delays about saleswoman for fork, too big, so gave it up. Met Jess Stearns' for lunch & had a good old gossip after. Went 3.20 to 4th World Th. to "Moonlight Son" also part of excellent "Pearls of the Crown." Had to leave at 5, back to change, then Town

Hall - had Lucy Eph for dinner - a very good chat. Back by 10, G at Hamlet. Read Last P. until she came in.

14. Greyish, cleared later. Took new umbrella. Started late, wrote L, H, M/3. No luck w. you at L - T so went FS & finally Art. man, got suede shoes, minor bust fixed. To Mus. for lunch with G, F. Dudley, Ruth Kinsey. Not in court. Spent an hour in Classical & Ptg. parts, El G, Rem. Back before 4 & rested a few moments. Wrote Miss S. off 4.15 to MFN for tea, dinner Gmtt. Back before 10, back G about Mus. at TC.

15. Fine. Stayed in most of a.m. - wrote most of T's letter and one to k. Took 96 cars, 3rd L to Chat Sq. to Krich. Village, big block round garden court, Cherry & Cath. Sts. Had enormous walk, along side arches 13 Bridge, City Hall,

St. Paul's, Envoy to Trinity, inside, bus up Bay to 4th, to W. Square - as far as Gov. Bus to L-T, 2dov net, Town H. Finally up by Rock Cent. Bus & for Claint. but it turned 168 - too late anyway. Got out 110 & hunted for tea shop, no luck. Met Susan Martin - had tea with her at Schrafft's. Back about 6 & a brief rest for dinner - 2 Leh-Hart. Dr. Roach (aunt) & Oliver. Fine party, heard all about Samoa.

16. Fine, later break. Packed. Left G, cold, 4:11 for GCS & parked bay & got Park ticket. No 4 to Penn. Stat. but very early so to Hotel P & wrote L. Got 12:36 to Forest Hills where Harvey met me. Nice time with them, delicious dinner - out all p.m. in car, new roads & parkways & Jones Beach. Dashed back for 6:24, to

GCS & back to Park on 7:40: Big mob on arrival. Could in taxi with me. In at 10 and up to Room 18.

17. Fine, very warm, nearly roasting in available clothes. Got luggage out of storeroom. To Libr. - left brief case, to Class. office 10:10 for coffee. PND, Jnes, CS, Ted, G/Pet. Helped I wash up, get soap etc in store. Library, chiefly class alcove till 12. Met G/HM on wait. To H and lunch in sandwich shop in A.H. Came back, so unpacked some, then undressed & lay down with "Clung Problem". CS in about 3 - we had talk & tea upstairs. Met Gisela - Charlotte - finished T. Up c 5, tub, to H for a vermouth. Dined Wm. with G/HM, CS, FB, EH/H. His room after & back soon after 8. Rest an hour, then up & early to bed.

18. Fine not so hot. Misty moisty at first. Got to Libr. soon after 9, Gt Sem. on illust. Coffee in cl off. Libr. till 12 - lunch Sand. with H. Think I spent most p.m. in Libr till time for Davis tea for B. Duvalle. CMT took, H, EF & me. Windchills in full force. Back for dinner won't go Library in eve till it's closed.

19. Fine, warm. Library on class. refs. most am. Lunch Dan. with GS & Mary Tripp. Library 1.30-3, met GS & walked to Bock's - selected L's flowers for party, walk round's greenhouses, Stark G, tea off P. & saw a lot of people. GS & I errands after - no time to stop. Dashed off letter to L. Got H. - to dinner E. Carter, Co., Poly E, Good, ^{Haley} & others - Coffee in lounge there El Took it easy rest of eve, reading in bed.

20. Showery, poured by noon & eve after. Library, Mrs. to see friends, more libr.

Lunch W. with H, very wet. Odds & ends till time to dress early for show. Ready 3.50 for taxi, H, GFM, got Circula from Main & for private view before tea, 4½. G. LRT, Bowers, Harrison, Evans, Bryce & (grad. stds now w/ B&H) Shipley (at NYU) Peaks & a lot more. Night, not cold so couldn't come. Taxi to AH for supper, sat between Phil & AT, nice party, big several small tables. Nearly drowned going to TH for G's lecture. Clothes from NB. Grand speech on Adventures in Mrs. Hugs success. HHD took G to train, others in Mrs. for party. Survivors took it well - a regular triumph for FHDH.

21. Fine. Library (Gt alc.) 9-10, 10.45-4. Coffee in Mrs. 10.10. Got nearly all refs. checked. Tea at AH with book, GS came in. Letter to L about party - Vermont with H, dined won't, LRT, GB, HS, FB.

Adyourned later to ETTT for long talk on Acar in Rom. Sherry & sandwiches.

22. Fine, GS - J on 9:53 to Myt. To Velt for '97 lunch = Reiner, Bennet, Nomell, Langfield, OAK. Splendid time. Saw GS at 3:30. To Princeton on 5:08, night at Alcibi. Myrt & H Woodruff in vlt.

23. Fine. Breakfast in bed. Read E Olivier's tractate, began the night before, also the Trib. Packed, took with A. At 12 H Woodruff & Myrt. came for me - we met Gisela at junction, on to Museum to see several Antioch mosaics, Silius Tigris, Pyramids, Silenes several other medallions, Paradesis, Spring, Tiger Hunt. Morey came to take business with G. Then Princeton Inn for lunch, fine spread, one big table 31 9 3 in private room. 2 Shear, 2 Holland, 2 Skiffmell, 2 Olm Alton, Donald, Gallatin, Whitehead, Adl.

Brett, Terrell, Becker, Müller, Durrell, Meritt, Dinsmore, Doham, MA, Omar, JTH. Card = Herma head - To Shear; left hats - coats, baby exhibited. Library circle, ITH, Durrell made a big book, Targ photos, to do 5 more tombs; Dinsmore T. of Ares; RS Antioch chiefly what if Turks have it?; BDM 32 east archon Philonios 232; Oliver 3 letters Man. - Comm. to Gensia; Brett 3 coins genuine or not; TH S Agora 1930; Elles, Akk. insc., Kemri, Panath St (meekly) Agora boundary stone, HT; early per. Tholos, mill, pottery, Piet, sculpt. etc. Tea, then 5:40 to Myt - 7:45 Pdt. Unpack, Sayes.

24. Wet. Int. bush; green mac. Lib. 9-10, Lat. 10:10-10:45, Lib. till 12 lunch A/H in Sandalshop GS - CFF. GS - J in A/H library. Wrote Alton, Jr., BTCO. Lib. till 4:30. Chiefly Corpus. Back to A/H, quite letter L. At 5:30 to ETTT for several cock-

tails; pouring taxi to Kendrick. Dinner CS, ENTH, Inez, Edna, Polyx. In CS afterward for cointreau, eggs, sweets. Less rain left c. 8 & walk back. In at 8.15 wrote T. Wrote another to L about Arch Club. Wrote up diary. Bedtime

25. Fine. Parked letters. Early to Library & stayed till 1/2 in Gt Sem. Much LG etc. Cool & breezy, changed to more - to lunch Wms. with EE, ENTH, FF, FB, Molly P. El tel for golf, so after EE's room, went back - changed. Out 2-4, 13 holes, all square. Windy out, course fine - San F Domingo, pros here NW. Back for tub, dressing, odd, - needs. To ENTH 5.45 for cocktails - Dined Wm. ENTH, NFB, FB, MKing - - H to sketch & I Library till 9.30. Slow but sure.

26. Fine. Wrote Pauline before breakfast. Library 9-12, brief lat. coffee. BR

empty there, shiny old bird. Back to H lunch Lillian H + Art Club, GS, M MacC. About 1/2, very jolly group - Letter & Thirkell, Shire, L, Amba. Golf EC 3.30-5. Tub, quick change - H before Wms. with White, Trotter, Sandy, Mitchell. To H after, then Library till 9 AM.

27. Showy a.m., clearer later. Wrote H, Es. See before breakfast - Lib. in good time 4.45-12, mostly in Gt Sem checking notes. Lunch CMT, also H & EF was for golf, so Lib. 1.30-4, terrific rush; Class Club 4.45 tea - lecture by K Richards on Old-Rom Engg. - new, excellent. Dined at 5 with GS, ENTH & EE. Cue-lecture - to Libr. 7.45-9.45. Wrote B, Alice M & diary -

28. Fine, rather greyish. Library all a.m. inc. coffee. Back 12 w 20. LFB had

GS, Drinker came to lunch in Attr library after. EC came 2.20 and we had 8 holes as she was due back early. H + J to tea with VB, also Drinker + Campbell - EBC, GS + I dined with A T, lonely party, Wedgwoods, much gossip.

29. Fine, very windy. Up in good time + packed till 10.30. Got H for errands in Main, Lib till 12.15. Met H for lunch Sandwich, sat on sunny terrace. EC + Haley came early + we played 9 holes. Back 3.10 so went Lib. for an hour. Gradually getting up. Checked up. Back 4.30 + had a tub + mate L, enclosing steamer labels. To H 5.45 for bacon before dinner which H, G + I had in Attr + sat talking in lib. till G went to Soft party. Went early to bed -
