


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March 29, 1940 - Dec. 31, 1940

Mar. 29. Foggy & wetish a.m., cleared later.
up late & began T. Lunch in Gk. rest.
across the street. From Sparta, boy had
been at A.S. Coll. Had Garden Club
tickets for tour as it was clearing we
did a round in country. Bull to ticket.
Dirr, gorgeous agaves, palms unda-
maged. Turned r. - eventually to
Isle of Hope, great search for Miller's
- no luck but saw other fine old
houses. Lost various times but no
matter, saw Geo. Ag. Coll, Bethesda.
Finally to Wormsloe, oak are. 1 m.
long, gorgeous place, magnificent
trees, camellias, lily, boathouse,
house itself very fine (see No. 6).
Formal garden at back has very
int. iron fencing, new patterns.
Wrote place early. Found by Mont.
going to Beaufort, 3 gardens. Mrs
Clarke's camellias. Fine fraction.

On to Vernon View - out to end of point - tho' couldn't find garden. Back again to I. P. H. and to tables by water magnif. gables & can in more open pine plantation. Walk out 2 door terrace - chimney looks good - view. Across to White Bluff Rd. & back stat way. In before 6. Has been very hot in sun. Tavern for drinks & dinner. Upstairs early & finished T.

30. Misty, sticky, rain in night & showers later. Up late, did a lot of mending. Walk F-W & diary. Cleared before noon & L & took a taxi to Pink House and had a delicious lunch. Then got me a nightgown, then up after noon to State - to Dartmouth - back via Oglethorpe, old cam. st.

met A. at hotel & later we got car & went Bull, Viet, to Thunderbolt & got lost & went all round. Grey club etc. & back to Victory & finally to Bonaventure. (Shone Farm L. 1 m. beyond Stat.) As beautiful as described, trees, flowers, mon. Back to Th. - out across islands, thick marsh, Wilmington, Sagamore (saw Fort Pulaski across inlet) Sav Beach. Some kind of beautiful wooded islands, pine beach, very rare. Magnif. sunset or return. Not in till after 7, then Tavern - another delicious dinner. Met F. Washburn in hall. Upstairs early & read Sav. book in bed.

31. Perfect day. Went out on my own 10.30 - Mad Sq, Wed, Meldrum, etc - up to Gaston St. Back to math off 11.15 & all out. L & went on Oglethorpe.

ending at Witter with medallion balconies, back to Cheppewa Sq. - Ogl. mon - French Bacon. Met Mr & all up Madison - to things then - Jones, Taylor, Gordon searching for tea place - no luck so back to Cd de Luxe for good dinner. All for siesta. Read to L, out C 4 to Telfair with its fine rooms of furniture back from end Bull. Took a rest 5:30-7, reading. Supper Cks = Athanas. Son Nicks at 8th. Coll. so we had much to talk of with him - left L-N below & up to write H.

April 1. Fine. Got packing & business done - off before 11. Went Bull to Bay - along front to Ft. W. then back - out 17. To borders Walterboro & then 303 hunting for plantations most of which were private or invisible. Finally to 32-17

Could find no good lunch place, trees all in new leaf, lonely reds & greens. Took 174 Adams Run - Edisto - got lonely place over E Island to E Beach a State Park where had quiet lunch under palms on bridge. Lonely island, old Presb & Epis churches, oak avenues, picnicsome cabins. Back to 17 along more shady roads before Ashley Bridge. "Lug" had given H. a map with route to 64 Murray Bowl. Ft W just arriving with flowers still we did. Waited till we settled. Mrs Gerald's daughter Jean & Clu took care of us. Lonely rooms. All in car to Green Garden for tea, too late, so walk 1/2 hr. in old streets till dinner where we had a great group. Mrs G. here on our return. Mrs Foster in for a call. Then up to unpack & turn in.

2. Fine, brilliant day. Nice breakfast in room, settling - Mrs F came at 11.

Drove us round & met Mrs Baker at St Michael's. Later St Phil, Nugent, Dark Theatre, Pirates' house, antique shop, out to Citadel past big park, old market & fine lunch Henry. To Dr Miller for L & he gave her a good look over, also sleeping tablets etc. Got taxi at Marion - back for rest 4½.
 I lay on my bed & I read then to sleep with Chas. book. But C got out to GB & met F there. Talked while we waited, then she left. Went later Mrs G having poker party but quiet. To bed early, read Leclerc's "Land marks of C." which Mrs B. got us.

3. Met early but burned away. Out on foot c. 11 to meet FW. Very hot but got taxi at Ft. S. hotel. Met Mrs McConan & dave. F, Mr. Mc and I sat on shady back porch, then to St. Ph. & church yard, Gordon

walk to Gitter Gallery to see Trembley Washington. Also A Jackson, Monroe (Mose), Calhoun, Beauregard, Morris (Foster) et al. Upstairs for Foster miniatures. Met Nancy McC. on train from Sully, others, covered by Hist. Ex.
 To St John for lunch, nice & old & spacious. Later L & N came. L had been painting. Really hot, came back c. 3 for siesta & I read a lot of Chas. to L & N. Cloudy out but it cleared for sunset & we dined in coffee shop of Marion H. Very good. I thought us back - then went to Lucy's and wrote letters. A long one to T.

4. In out, warm. Very late start Errands, incl. leaving necklace for cleaning & got sandwiches etc. Met Fr all pf c. 12 for Cypress Gardens via Nutting 952. This is a lot of industrial suburbs, then fine

country turned off Goose Creek Rd. to re St James's church, charming little one, pelicans, chester heads. Fine Ionic gallery. On to turn R. for C Gard. Got there between clouds, lunch near pavilion. Then in - were paddled all this absolutely still and dreamlike, most heavenly, as clear, diff. none, dogwood, wistaria, Judas, jasmine. Imposes to describe but a paradise. Kept even much pleasanter. I took lot of photos. Took walk afterwards round park later & over bridges. Very before too full or noisy. Back c 5 & took it easy & read Ch. aloud. Again to Marion, back c 9 - ch ch & I got stuck to wash kit.

5. Hot, but buggy. I finished picture & I to F. c 11.30 then to Giffes + garden walk. Very hot, over 82. Met Fat St J - all there for lunch. At 2

to Ft. S. Hotel, tickets for garden tour. Guide - Mrs Gribble, delightful. Not of car, but more independent. Across Ashley Rd. to Fenwick Hall, old & well restored. Very fine panelling, marbles. Pictures & furniture in newspapers. Back to 61 and to Drayton Hall, never open, so great chance. Georgian, 4 cols, double ^{steps} up. Splendid big hall, Adorned mantels, exquisite classical details in cornices, moldings etc. Mr Gerald there with Mrs B, so we saw all. Upper floor also shown. Splendid facade towards river & long avenue. Too hurried & too crowded but lucky to see at all. Back to town over Cooper B. to Sweet Farm. Lovely trees & setting & beautiful old house, fine furniture etc. Drove to Bonnett Hall modern in Georg. style, brick cabin fine size & are. Drove past it - also later part - Christ Ch.

Ended at Pirates Crag, Mt Pleasant
- has tea-handy gardens, big house
full of junk & animal skins & a
grand view over water. After 6 when
got to F.T.S. for a drink - Left F &
had light sandwich supper Bayars.
Games eve. Began Road to Fully by
Ford, about Charleston.

6. Cooler & breezy. Spent some time
planning out later tour - off for a few
errands before collecting F at 12. Over
Cooper bridge to Mt Pleasant - Sullivan
St., past Ft. Moultrie & on as far as
road went. Saw car stuck in sand.
Back to Hück's for a delicious & most
lavish lunch. Fine place. Drove slowly
back past FTM reservation. Past at
end ist = J. P. Palms, great summer
resort. Round in village at M.P. then
main road past Snee entrance, as
had seen smoke. Only burning ff.

Cut over sandy road back by loop thro'
country. Back before 5, left F, then for
a road till dinner. Chilly & used elec.
stove. Also heat on. Out for drinks -
dinner Henry but no fuel so got only
drinks & rowed to Bayars. Shops open Sat.
eve, so round & round, & found Kodak
only one closed. Back before 9 & took a
walk on MB to end & back. Then 6 Ch.
No wash - I on top. Rest L Ford.
7. Sun early, then overcast. Mending,
cleaning out, diary. Wrote ff. Began B.
N went to Lewis's & we had nice walk
to & from Green Garden, looking at
houses. Sun in & out. Warmer again -
back 2-30, odd jobs, finished B. Cards
to MB, Geo, MFW. Took it-easy reading
Ford. Dinner St. J. Held some VI, 6
games. Dine with Lucy to Quar.
8. Terrible night - wind & rain, so up late.
Clear fine but very windy. Out before

12 to sale at Frock Shop & L got a white dress & I a white or a blue. To antique place to see desk. Met F for lunch at St J. L & I had done birds at 2, - a few errands. Back to Garden Hall, Gitter P.O., met Mrs Baker, rejoined L & walked back, lonely houses began etc. In about 5, N here. Had finished Ford in bed a.m. Did odds & ends, Out c. 7 drinks & dinner Kenny's. In before 9 had 7 games. Read Sea Int'l.

9. Fine, breezy. Went c. 11 for Lucy & out via Ashley past gardens to Summersville, lonely road. Simply enchanting at S. with flowers, esp. victoria, azalia, dogwood. To Margie (Mrs Bailey) then peeped all round the town in and out just looking at places, a dream of beauty. Back for a sumptuous lunch at M's. Also daughter &

granddaughter. Mrs Hunt came before we finished & later we went to her home a lovely one with big lawn & garden & nice furnishings. Mr H. here too & 2 scatties. Back to collect Lucy, prairies etc & nice drive to town, then a few errands & to Kenny's for a drink. Took L home. Extra out about Denmark & Norway. Had news up - on from N's car. Lateish to Byers then back for meal which.

10. Fine, coolish & breezy. L & N parked in King St. to do St. M. tower & I went prowling Broad, Orange, Legare etc. Met F near Libr. but off again. All met St J for lunch. L & N return to paint. Fr & St M. churchyard, then left her & rode church st & back for them. Also a few min in Libr. Square on Hill then to T. & N. Back c 3:30 to house & a few acts. Took L 4:2 to Dr Pratt

5:45 p.m. 22-23rd. N & I round for a few photos. Then got L. Much news after a few errands where they got eggs. Sat in car till c. 7. Later got F & we went Henry's. Too full so to Rathskeller - Bayars. Grand eve, walk to Light. - back 6:30.

11. Fine. L-N painting Stoll's Alley - I took list of prize gardens from Nem & Lesesne - went prowling till 1:30 at St J. to get news & lunch. Back to house for black out Ashley Rd. Missed turning to Old Town so on as far as Mag. Then back - Bees Ferry Rd, lonely No' wood, 1/2 - to Johns Isl. - Rockville, beautiful drive. News in car, then 7:30 to drinks & supper at Foster's. Also Gerald & Clarence & later Mrs Baker. Very jolly, back c. 11:30.

12. Forecast very windy after very blowy night. Wrote T. Began ECT. Out at 12:30 L to Pratt, N & I errands. See 4 met in car for news 1/2, then lunch St. J. Began to rain, a deluge before we got in at 3. hideous afternoon. Read last chapters of Stevens aloud. Drink with G.S. But after 7 to Henry (long) ended St J. Back before 9 - more chch.

13. Fine, cold wave everywhere. Wrote Staton, more on ECT. Outman. Had frocks sent to A.H. Met F & picked round. Met Tweedy. Back to car for N & L. News 1:30 then lunch St. J. Back c. 3 & out later to Old Town road which ended in private grounds - then to Fall Beach & along road on it. Another fine deer. Met F & at Raths. Then St J. for sandwiches, very slow, great scramble, then found train late. Met C 9:30.

14. Fine, cool & breezy. Took it easy from sun.
Wrote no letters a.m. Our late to park all round. Got F for news, car in
Meeting, N-C photos. Lunch Henry very late. Back Gard. Walk, Gibbes,
Moss etc & later drove to Ft. John-
son. Back c 6, scarcely later b/t.
Raths - Byars. Bridge col.

15. Fine, breezy. Mending. After errands went again to Cyp. Gardens. Lunch on the way by roadside. Ahead of mob. Many changes in flowers no daff., few wistaria, but lots of white azalea, lilies, summer than last time, just as beautiful. Return via Summersville to show C. the place. Back late via Ashby road. Stopped to stock up for eve. After 7.15 news to Byars. Lucy here on return & had lively eve till all hours.

16. Fine, lovely day again. Got F soon after 10.30 & off to Magnolia. Gorgeous show of aglaea, lovely place, acres of gardens, beautiful river views etc. Spent part of a.m. there, then left L-C at Hunt's P.F. N & I got a breezy place in shade for lunch. Met at Mary's at 3, pralines. To Middleton which is superb, land-
scaping splendid, walks to river. One old wing left. Magnificent ges-
teas, & camellias, mostly gone. Had nice negro guide, also a plan-
tation all round, expected tea but it was dried, so we sat in garden chairs. Back c 6. Packed a little. Our late to F Marion for dinner, slow & poor. More packing.

17. Fine. Up in good time for last things & packing car, etc. Stopped in town for P.D. sandwiches, F fan, gas etc. so left c. 2 & had fine run to New Bern

via 17 Ocean Highway. Left right on not stopping anywhere except not far from Myrtle Beach on by road to a nice open pine wood with jasmine - iris - breeze. Road goes Georgetown, Wilmington, etc. Reached N.C. at 5. Green town a delightful hotel & nice rooms. After cleaning up N.C., I had walk to see a few old houses. Back c 7 & cocktails on veranda. Excellent dinner. Bridge eve.

18. Fine, but warm & sticky. Got packed & drove a tour round town & saw a lot of beautiful houses, esp. the best ones on E Front over the water. Red brick with fine porches etc. Followed route on booklet. Took R 17 to Kureboro, thence to turn off to Tarboro. Lovely old town - S has adorable old house. What a welcome! We

had a gorgeous time & sumptuous lunch with steak & waffles, and such a good group. S not changed a bit. At end C. met sister of Jim Amington whom he'd known in Mass. Left C 3. by 44 & 301 over the border, out of flat tobacco country & found trees much less forward. Via Petersburg to Richmond, 6.20 & to Jefferson, lovely big rooms. Nice comfort old fashioned. Lateish dinner, nice music, up for a few rubbers. Rain. Movie F.

19. Hard rain in night, misty. Late break. with L. Decided to try Hms. nice drive via 60 through pretty country & more ups & downs than usual. At W. went first to liner to see Men Building Sheds is a beauty both facades & finely set out with queen in front & Bobtail stat. an amusing pseudo-Rom. or relief f-

Indian - Virginia. Town done over very like Eng. village, well restored that artfully, hard to find lunch place. At 12 went to Bruton Church during wait, admirably done over simple & impressive. Finally got lunch Colonia. Next to Gov. Palace which is a splendid place, they have done it - all over from old places etc & filled with wonderful furniture. Began to have while we were there so had to miss garden etc. Great business getting on & C was party & A discipline the futile parking man. Done much & saw outside. Let up to Crafts, near Inn & Lodge. C & I in to Capitol also finely done, much dignity & elegance. Long time, so back with showers on - off - on & run upstairs, good dinner.

Up fairly early for bridge till 10.45. Wrote Sally. Began to Polton explain. 22. Misty again. Decided to take a chance & get off C & for Jamestown via S, nearer river & bordering a lot of plantations. Very pretty - and hot sandwiches seem to be site - it is a splendid place - or saw J Smith, Pocahontas, church, old buildings etc. Delightful ride. Showed on to Yorktown, no rain here - went via W. and magnificent park way - 4. is a charming little place, lonely situation, several old houses left. L, C, I in York Hall, Nelson family, restored very well & with big lawns & garden. Monument rather a horror but what a site. Too late at W. except to see a few more outsides, back R. 6.30, partly though had rain. Dry in R.

All had dinner & wine before dinner & some bridge. Managed somehow to get a letter written to T. before dinner - in a.m. Packed a little Bed, 2 & Polton.

21. Overcast, cold & blowy. Packed breakfast with L, plans for trip. But c. 11 for tour of town incl. Polk house & Cap. into which we got - had good idea of building & portraits. Wrote H. before lunch. Off c. 8 & at filling station broke muffler & had tank leak. Left car, taxi with pictures driver did Mon Ave. new residential parts then Baile Abbey w. Conf. portraits - fine murals by [unclear] Back for car, not ready. Returned to Jeff. & got cards - played bridge before & after an early dinner. Away at 8 - moonlight drive to Charlottesville. Too bad not to see more. Arr 10 at Monticello Hotel.

7:15, 8:00

Rooms, esp. clothes cupboard tiny after 9.
but grand view from them. Hotel very full.

22. Fine, cold, clear, very windy. Went a.m. to Michie's Tavern where P. Henry lived, fascinating old place. Then to Monticello which is far finer than all else. Splendid setting, lawns, garden - House most orig. & interesting, full of genuine Jeff. relics. No big stairs, gallery hall, movable bed, done over salon. Grand views & ch. from long back roof to study. Honey moon stone cor. on other side, steps below. Stopped on my up at family graveyard. To top lawn planned by J. for Monroe. Fine box & trees, stat. by Piccirilli. House looks small but has fine rooms - also old furnishings. Addition planned by J. never seen by M. Fine view over to Mont. A fine interesting morning. I sat in front

late lunch. Out soon after & past Clark stat. to Univ. which is a beauty with new buildings all in青春. Older ones round Lawn, esp. Rotunda & colonnaded ones which have balconies at intervals. Went into & visited escort of prof. wife, garden hostess. Very Eng. in effect. In old w. arcaded rooms saw Pois' 13, Wilson's 31. Drove all round & over n. to ball field with arched seats. Fine town, lots of nice old buildings. Court House opposite us. Back for brief visit till dinner. L & C met some Cin. people who stayed till c. 10. Read Garden Raffle of Richmond News, then bridge & then C's epic of Florida tour. Then sat telephoned home where he was married wed. with C's help Rev. Polton.

23. Warmer, not too clear but fine.

Fortunately it lifted before we did Sky Line. Got packed & on way out stopped at antique shop & got decanter & Scotch label for present to send by C. Then across to After - trail which now is c. 100 m. long (3 sections). Splendid drive, up & down to some extent but not above c. 3,500. Saw much more than expected, sun in and out over great valley, Shenandoah. After one failure got lunch Lodge Big Meadow nice inn. Wide views on both sides & back & forward mt. masses. Not any apple blossoms ready & on mt. leaves hardly started, bare as autumn, cold also. A great run to Geo. W. in Winchester, nice hotel. Had drinks before C. had to leave 7:30 for bus & train. Lateish dinner turned in early.

24. Unsettled, showers. Drove

round town seeing sights. Two adorable houses opp. our windows. Went to Ft. Loudoun, very little left, Govt. Head-quarters, cemetery, lots of nice old houses. Then R 340 to Berryville then N. to Fairfield. Mrs. Richardson qd, received us. Lovely red stone house, gardens & stables. Saw orig. grant by Fairfax. Belonged to Warner Washington, also cottage with daughter-in-law, magnificently modernized in best taste. Very attractive ladies who took us to Berryville for lunch in drug store after seeing Andley, Kelly, Custis, etc., part of it. Added to & now belongs Mr. Jones & full of pictures of horses, also a rare lot of hist. furniture, but the older parts are fine. R 267 South to Carter Hall, huge park, fine big

columned house in splendid posi-tion, not shown. From Millwood R 50 to near Aldie & N branch to Oak Hill built by T. J. for J. Monroe, a fine big house, high cols & porticos each end, terraced garden back, beautiful interior, esp. 2 large rooms on garden front. On to Alex. and out on R 1 to Penn Yan which record what a de luxe auto court meant for over night only as it had no place to put rings. Nice little brick houses, bath, heat, gas. but not for several days. Went via Mt. Bone. to Wash & over bridge by Lincoln Mem along to 17 - Conn. to Woodlawn and Hardman Park. Not large - apocryphal but not too dear, covered here for 1 night only but very glad for that. Cleaned up & good dinner.

nice quiet rooms, fruit bats below.

25. Greyish mostly. Packed & out soon after 10 in taxi to Uncle Ho Mary for short call. Then L. J. Long, to see LBN whom we caught rushing for train, looking fine. Splendid exhib. of photos of houses, Mobile, N.O., Demop, Charl. etc. His parlor room, big Robbins with mural tape., also publications, lower floor. Met Mr. in LBN's office. To Tally Ho - Hobbs met us for lunch. Hotel same as ever. Back to hotel, got car packed & off before 3 via Rock Creek Park to Lincoln, very impressive, also effect of G.W. obelisk in pool. To Arlington, Lee's house - less known Sodden also very fine. Left C. & got on Bond. visited F. R. but cussed my silly

new suburb & got to R. 1 - Penn D. for mail. By the time had stopped in Alex to see Christ Church & Masonic Hall. Then to Fowle's to Piccino. Some, lovely rooms for a stay. Good dinner, early to bed. Terrible gas from street. A most
 26. Fine, some clouds. Not much sleep for anyone so up latish. Garden club in hotel so got general ticket & notices. To Market, done like old one, booths from neighboring plantations. To Merrell's Apoth. shop full of delightful odd things, Rising Sun Tavern, Doggett House, A.B. wall paper. Back to lunch - It gave out so had out before 3 to Mary W. house, a charming one - saw pageant NW record Lafayette in garden. Also G.W. & Martha in old coach.

To Kenmore, Lewis, fine house & 2 outer buildings - Fine mantels & plaster ceilings. Can't describe all these but have lots of pamphlets. Later to J. Monroe's office - room full of relics, desk for M. Dr. Back after 5 - read *Troy Liberty* till dinner. Wrote T off - on & then made up diary. Turned in early & read *T. of L.*

27. Perfect day. No rush. Out with N. walk over to Kenmore - went all through it again in leisurely way with no crowd. Then to mons. J. Mercer & Mary W. Left N. at Mary H's house & back c. 12.15 for "rest" before lunch. Finished letter to B. Out early p.m. for splendid drive, 17 to near Port Royal - 20² by Madison bridge over Rapp. to Belle Grove & Med. family. Now owned Hookers -

we were shown around by great grand-f. son owner. Most unusual with pedimented wings added & skillfully joined by curving colonnettes. Also curving doors in & 7 wings. Beautiful house, well rest. in best taste, turned garden to river. On till got to R. 3, nice farms & wooded country, then off to Stratford, L. C., now ruined as a plantation. Chief outward char. is groups of chimneys at ends. Fine big estate, lawns & gardens, shop, offices etc. House n.b. beautiful big hall, doors front & back & ends, fine :: Got a pamphlet about it - Bought dish ^{3.50} for M. B. On to Wakefield, G. W. & Westmoreland. Tall shielist, new house in red style, splendid position over Pope Creek, gardens, wood etc. Later to long house for tea. Took return via Colorad & Potomac beaches, lost something, not oak hill & drinks, late game

dinner. Early to bed & mat.

28. Fine, another perfect day. Up late with papers, diary etc. Wrote to O'Dell, Garney. Mr Hobbs & Donald came for lunch. Later we went to Kenmore again as L. had seen it only briefly. Ended with tea in kitchen. Mr D off after 4 & we walked back. Long out but all rather footsore & took it easy with NYT. Later some TFE

29. Fine, another brilliant day. Sorry to leave F.C. 10.30. Stopped at Agincourt church, a lonely little brick structure on hill. Very unusual doorway & belfry. Church looked but could see beautiful triple window in chancel, pulpit, gallery panelling etc. On to Podunk Ch. also lonely site. On one p. very old but much simpler. Turned off for Mt Vernon. Larger & finer than

expected. Elaborately packed for mats of trifles, well arranged. Much resting on grounds. (See map.) Grand site, house full of lovely things but too slab. mantels etc. Not had been gifts. Tables here but could see pretty well. Later to Tomb - ran up on terrace lawn for view. Garden. Lunch at Little Hatchet, tea via Bowl. Through thix & over fire-trath bridge, past Jeff. mon. now under construction. Good map enabled us to get round without too much traffic to R t, over rolling country, farms & woods to part Mt Zion & by road to Tulip Hill a splendid house n. central ped. part, cupid in ped, reliefs above - an eagle in point, 2 ped. wings (later) conn. w. centre. In hall to r. a fine cupboard, shell top, butterfly shelves, superb china. Stairs

bal. & all of walnut. Very fine big rooms, also in wings. Still had over garden doorway, fine terrace, overlooking water. Particularly fine house. On to Annapolis, Carroll in Dr. Gres St., formerly Gov. Paca's, new part admirably done. Nice suite on 3rd. Got in c. 5.30, College St.; past St. J. Out for short walk & to shop in Hammond-Harwood house. All close b. Back to cocktail bar in basement near Marine Grill. Quick change & a good dinner. Fine big public rooms, fine staircase. In lounge after dinner but upstairs early.

 7. Fine, sunny & breezy - h to Cook. Begun on luggage after writing 13. In p.m. got OS & went to garage & tire, then country roads via Salt Point, Moore's Mills 82-55. Near Clinton Corners got a few hepaticas for H. zone shrub. L went to Ctis class in eve & J to Libr. to look over classical journals & L.A.N.
 8. Fine, very clear. Left c 9.30 via Bridge - qW for Englewood. Long drive, trees beginning to come out. Brilliant views
