SAH from MSBF 1953 - INTERIM REPORT

A running record was kept of Knidian stamp types catalogued from Sections ΜΣ and Κ in 1953 - beginning on or before February 24 - since most of them presumably come from the Middle Stoa building fill. An analysis based on this record shows the following figures:

No detailed analysis is given of the large group of early handles. The fabricants and eponyms have been listed, with figures (p.2). Note the large number of the fabricants ΕΥΒΟΥΛΟΣ, ΘΡΑΣΩΝ, and ΝΙΚΑΣΙΒΟΥΛΟΣ, of the eponyms ΕΥΚΡΑΤΗΣ, ΘΗΡΟΚΡΑΤΗΣ, ΝΙΚΑΣΙΒΟΥΛΟΣ, and especially ΠΟΛΙΟΥΧΟΣ. No investigation of the context has been made for these handles of Group I, some of which of course do not come from the undisturbed MSBF.

For Groups II and III, the types are analyzed (pp.3,4), and I have investigated in the notebooks the context of examples (see p.4).

Investigation in ΜΣ notebooks shows that the three handles of Group II come from Roman context (see (1) and (5) in list p.4). The two handles of Group III come, the one from a martyra (see context (9)), but the other, ΜΣ 666 (SS 15096) apparently from the MSBF itself; this latter is datable in the late 2nd or early 1st century B.C.

A late Pontic handle has also been noted from this section: ΜΣ 312 (SS 12073), from "S area 3, Layer III, strosis b." According to Grakov the stamp is to be dated 122-70 B.C. *and what about SS 12108, also Grakov points 7-8?*

b Investigation in Κ notebooks shows that the handles of Group II come from the following deposits:

K 1936: "Hell. fill possibly disturbed by drain," listed as (4).

K 2528-31, 2535-6, 2538-9: "Martyra in Fountain House Porch, Layer 3," listed as (2).

K 2573: "Martyra over east end of water basin Top and trench for drain B." (6)

K 2620-21, 2626-27, 2635: "Fountain House Porch to Stepped Retaining Wall, Layer 1." (3)

K 2664: "Fill over Stepped Retaining Wall," listed as (7).

And that the handles of Group III come from the following deposits:

K 2095: "West of 'steps' to 27 meter square: top of Hell. fill, working level." (10)

K 2520-21: "Martyra in Fountain House Porch, Layer 2," listed as (2 bis).

K 2674: "Hell. fill S of Middle Stoa Piers 5 and 6. Possibly disturbed." (8)

Two late Pontic handles have been noted from this section: K 2146-7, both from "Hell. fill over water basin N of drain B Working floor to ca level of bottom of drain." These also belong to Grakov's Group VI, which he dates 122-70 B.C.
Should be safe.

From this preliminary investigation - made without availability of catalogue cards, or existence of a deposit list, - and covering only a small part of the material - my impression is confirmed that the handles as a whole are datable little if any later than the first quarter of the 2nd century, the provisional date of Group I. I would be glad to have comments on the listed contexts, most, at least, of which seem to allow of detaching the later handles from the Stoa fill. It is true that the Knidian are not even the largest single class in the fill, but they are the most indicative, since in Athens as a whole they tend to increase after the first quarter, whereas the Rhodian, the largest class among the handles catalogued this year from MZ and K, almost disappear after that time. On the Rhodian, it is interesting that in checking for photographs needed we found that a large number of the stamp types on the new handles were duplicated from the deposit at Pergamon which has been dated 220-180.



Analysis of MSBF

Analyses of all the separate categories have been made; with comments on date, and indication of individual items being thrown out.

AD is now completing a check as to whether all items in the various lots have been included. He does it by working back from the ^{category} analyses and entering name (or whatever) and SS number ^{(1) - suff} listed in order from the list of lots made out from working through the SS cards of 1953 as a whole; and (2) lists by Cat. Dept., type list, for pre-war MSBF. This check is also done for the SS numbers in the analyses; and it provides finally a complete list in numerical order of MSBF stamps.

Under way is a list of individual finds ^{covered} for post-war MSBF, since the excavations could not list ^{bottom} MSBF nor yet the Cat. Dept. All the finding-place indications are listed, with inclusion SS nos. in order of SS numbers. Note is made of items that seem to relate in the individual finds. Preliminary comment on date of Knidian

Of the starred items, SS 870 (from a jar of Damokrates son of Aristokles) and SS 589 (Charmokrates, in the term of Hermophantos) are probably to be dated in the third quarter of the 2nd century B.C. These two handles are much worn. The other five starred types are of the late 2nd or early 1st century B.C.

Apart from these seven handles, the Knidian are before 150, and some at least probably of the third century. They seem to be, as a group, earlier than the stamps so far tabulated as from the construction fill of the Stoa of Attalos. ⑧

Investigation is to be made of the seven late handles, to see whether they can be separated from the rest.

The ^{SS} casts were got out by, as far as I know, R. Edwards, with all the rest of the finds from this fill, for general lists & to be typed. Taking ^{for} D.B.'s note book lists. (?)

We have sorted them by category, and alphabetized the Rhodian, by far the largest group - more than twice as many as the Knidian. Readings of the Knidian have been collected and revised, some new file cards made. (One seemed to have been lost: EYKPATH² anchor.) They will be alphabetized and listed 1) by fab., 2) by sponge; and items on which no names have been read, added.

The Knidian filled a tray twice. The second lot ^(numerical order) has not been put away. Their appearance: of 38 handles, 12 known part or rim preserved, mostly not very close to the Knidian drip illustrated in Heg. III page but others are squares, more Rhodi - st. with flat tops; Rhodi appears increased by many having a slip. One (ss 115, - Hippo? -) has nearly complete perimeter - PH. 255 (short), small worn fresh breaks, but in general, no missing of many large pieces.

Stamps: ^{genuinely} letting small, or faint, or broken; st. struggling and uneven large. Note that some later items have been identified with this fill: ss 499, 589, 591, ⁶¹⁰ ₈₇₀, 890, 1008, 1266; and ^{but here also} 'or possibly Late Knidian' 666, 887, 1267?

Mile 3000 Belly Fill

So far, only the Rhodian have been analyzed. It is probable that they will remain the best material for dating this fill, since Rhodian in Athens stop too early for their late dates (in the early 2nd cent.). To be significant, and we haven't identified Thasian handles of late date than 180 (except possibly the which has SS 3955 with its uncharacteristic and illegible stamp); and the little is known of the miscellaneous groups as yet. There seem to be Pontic in this group.

What progress has been made with the Rhodian? The cards were put in alphabetical order. One or two trays, at a time, of handles were got out following the alphabetical order. For each name, a general study was made in the files, as to context here and in other sites, as to pairs, as to fabric of available material (Agora, etc.). Notes were then added to the name cards in the dating file (taken from Hilt's sponge list for the sponges), new cards being made for numerous fabrics. Report on investigation of material related to date of construction ofMiddle Stoa

The material examined in this investigation includes the catalogued pieces listed by DBT (Theta, pp. 1453-58) as "only those from undisturbed areas" (p. 1445) in the Building Fill, and the storage containers given as pertinent (23-210).

Since it was not possible to determine accurately which containers the excavator had considered as coming from undisturbed construction filling (many listed containing obviously intrusive material), and since there was an element of doubt in certain cases in the catalogued pieces as to whether or not the pertinent contexts were dependable, the investigation was carried out as an overall survey to determine into what periods and in what proportions the material fell, with a subsequent recheck against the notebook entries.

The entire body of material, catalogued and storage, falls into three groups:

- 1) the main bulk, dating from the latter fourth century BC down into the first half of the second century BC.
- 2) a very small amount, dating from the second half of the second century BC down into the first, several pieces being post-Sullan, one perhaps of the second half of the 1st century BC.
- 3) a very considerable amount, dating not earlier than the Late Roman period (post-Heruli), along with much Byzantine and Turkish, and some modern.

The third group is sharply separated in date from the rest of the material and is obviously connected with activities in the area subsequent to the destruction of the building.

The second group, being critical for the date, was checked in detail against notebook entries or against the notes made of the contents of the containers, as the case might be. In all cases of objects definitely later than the middle of the second century BC it was found that they were from questionable, disturbed contexts. A list of all the pieces concerned, with comment, is appended. It is my opinion that these objects may all be considered intrusive and irrelevant to the date of the building, not only because their contexts can be called into question, but because of the total absence in the material of other types of objects which might reasonably be expected to appear in the construction filling of a building built in the years following the conquest of Athens by Sulla, in which period the building would necessarily be placed if this group of objects were accepted as evidence. The following are the types of objects, dateable after the middle of the second century BC, and common in the period represented by this group, which were borne in mind especially in going through the material, and found absent:

Megarian bowls, long petal varieties (except as noted on appended list)
 BG plates, offset rim (as P 3331, Gp E)
 BG plates, vertical rim (as P 11815, X Cistern 84/NST)
 BG bowl, 2-handled, vertical rim, late type (as P 502, Gp D)
 Late West Slope pyxides (as P 6010, 6012, Gamma Cistern 95/KTheta)
 Late West Slope covered bowls (as P 12164, Omega Cistern 74/H)
 Samian ware
 Pergamene ware (except as noted)
 Brittle Ware
 Gray Ware (except as noted)
 Late forms of Type XVIII lamps (as L 1787, 3312, Omega Cistern 74/H & Gamma Cistern 95/KTheta)

In addition, no coins of the period represented by this group were found.

(^{1st}) The third group then remains as that concerned with the construction of the building. For the dating of this group a selection of pottery was made in going through the containers, to supplement that already catalogued. This included all pieces sufficiently preserved to give an appreciable part of their profiles (necessarily limited to the sturdier pieces such as small bowls and plates), all Megarian bowl fragments, and other pieces of special interest or distinctive character.

From the point of view of the pottery it is apparent that this group covers a wide expanse in time, with a consistent distribution throughout. It begins, mainly, though some pieces are a little earlier, toward the end of the fourth century BC and carries on down to the period shortly before the beginning of the construction of the Stoa of Attalos. The latest pieces find parallels in two deposits: (1) with pieces in a household deposit (Ash & Carbon Fill south of Mud Brick Building) which is regarded as having accumulated in the last few years before construction began in the Stoa, and (2) with the latest pieces in the Fill over the Floor of the Square Building, which apparently remained exposed to accumulation until the time construction of the Stoa was begun. A list of pertinent and representative pieces with parallels is appended.

The latest of the coins from the filling (revised list, pocket, Vol. VIII) have been checked against pertinent notebook entries and containers, and with two exceptions are seen to have come from contexts which there is no reason to question. The coins which may then be used as evidence for the latest dating of the filling are as follows:

- Athens, NS, ca. 172 BC (Mar. 9, 1953, #1)
- Thessalian Confederacy, 196-146 BC (?) (Mar. 9, 1953, #3)
- Athens, NS, 196-187 BC (Mar. 28, 1953, #20)
- Delos, Athenian cleruchy, after 166 BC (June 1, 1953, #3)

From the point of view of the pottery there would seem to be no definable lapse of time between the construction of the two Stoas. From the numismatic point of view it seems likely that the construction of the Middle Stoa can be placed in the second quarter of the second century BC. If the attribution of the latest coin to Delos, Athenian cleruchy, after 166 BC, remains secure, it would seem probable, since only one coin of this type was found in the filling, that the construction occurred soon after the acquisition of Delos, perhaps in the 50's of the second century.
