The excavator ascribed this filling to a "late stage in the building program," and these stamps would agree <sup>1 with</sup> <sup>(Neatricaster)</sup> what they say, if you date the filling as I do.

That is, I continue to put the end date of the MSBF filling proper ~~as~~ in the 2nd decade of the 2nd century. One of the latest Rhodian spouras in the filling is Kdseukpáys, cf. ss 12943, which has also a small secretary stamp (with rose) which comes in at this time; ss 12943 is no doubt from an amphora of Δapokpáys, so

Among the Indians, the delany name first appears in 1790 in a list in a MS.B.T., after 1880 it occurs in Australia probably not much earlier.

Naturally the handles, especially the smaller groups, can provide only termini post.

HAT suggests I read (one more) EV's Section Summary of K in 1953, although he says he has in Princeton the plan that goes with it, without which I find it hard to get definite references.

On the way back in a settling basin (P 23095); it is said to have been "covered to a considerable depth by the general filling" but I have never been able to identify any group of SAH found over, or in, this basin.

I do not find any detailed enough reporting <sup>(all chronological or topographical)</sup> to give bearing on the date of the handle groups covered by my recent studies.

SAH FROM SECTION K, 1953, FROM FILLS NOT INCLUDED IN MSBF BY THE EXCAVATOR

In 1953, apart from the groups of SAH listed by EV as from the MSBF (accounted for in VG analyses made 1955-56), a number of other groups were catalogued from Section K, sometimes quite large numbers recorded with a common finding place in the general terraced area south of the Middle Stoa.

Of these groups of handles, all that seemed to have an inner consistency, and a lower limit before about 125 B.C., have been studied as groups, being first sorted into the following chronological periods as indicated by the handles themselves:

A. Contemporary with MSBF, i.e. to ca. 185 B.C. Note some handles from MSBF which also probably

The names of the individual finding-places, as given by EV and copied on the catalogue cards, are repeated in full in the numerical lists of the various date-groups. See attached papers.

Following is a KEY LIST of groups studied; for convenience I have entered also inclusive numbers of fair-sized groups not analyzed, because they included SAH known to date in the late 2nd or 1st centuries B.C. But groups listed with regular MSBF are not entered here.

## GENERAL COMMENT

Note at the end of the full numerical listing of each chronological group the figures added giving the assortment of handles contained. The percentage of Rhodian and Knidian in the various groups is interesting:

	Rhodian	Knidian
Original MSBF (containing more old stuff)	59 percent	25 percent
Group A (lower limit is that of MSBF, taken to be ca. 185 B.C.)	54	38
Group B (before battle of Pydna, 167 B.C., and end of Rhodian domination)	45	40
Group C (to ca. 146 B.C.)	19	74
Group D (to ca. 125 B.C., more vaguely)	10	86

Analyses which have been made of the groups show that in Athens in the 2nd century B.C., after the first couple of decades, Rhodian handles in a given lot tend to be not only more scarce the later the period, but also less up to date than the Knidian found with them. For instance, in Group C, lower limit ca. 146, nearly all the Rhodian are later than the latest in Group A, but only one can be reliably called later than about 170 (SS 13760, of *TIME*, probably about 150 B.C.). Whereas in the same group, 46 percent of the Knidian seem to be datable in the period 166-146 B.C. Following the interruption of import from Rhodes, which may have pleased Athenian merchants more than Athenian housekeepers, perhaps old Rhodian jars, being handsomer than the Knidian, were cherished to some extent. Or perhaps those that did reach Athens came quite indirectly.

 " . . . the disappearance of Rhodian containers from Athens testifies to the gradual emancipation of Athens from the commercial hegemony of Rhodes, an emancipation which began earlier than 166 B.C. (see above, p. 629 f.) but was accentuated by the Roman settlement of the affairs of Greece after Pydna."

The group SS 13767-796 might perhaps have been combined with the above, but are being analyzed separately, though listed here in the numerical list. They include a Knidian eponym, ΘΕΑΙΔΗΤΟΣ, who does not occur in MSBF proper, but may be no later than the rest, since he is not known as a phrourarchos, and is named by several MSBF fabricants. They include also a Thasian of ΗΑΙΣΤΡΑΤΟΣ, who is not in MSBF proper, or at Pergamon, and may be a little later. They do not include much leftover earlier stuff.

SS 13760, of TIMΩ, looks very late, corresponding with other evidence to suggest it is ca. mid 2nd. It is rather roughly made, and short-topped. (No rim.)

Post-MSBF eonyms: ΑΡΙΣΤΕΙΔΑΣ, ΑΡΧΙΛΑΙΔΑΣ, ΞΕΝΟΦΩΝ. These all occur at Pergamon, hence presumably before ca. 180 B.C.

The Early Knidian appear also in the Knidian list from this group, at the end of the list by fabricant.

Two Chian (one a lagynos handle) ~~handles~~ in the MSBF bear the same name as SS 13490. They are considered latish in the series of Chian in the MSBF. (See commentary.)

One would expect the Coreyrean(?) to be 4th-3rd cent. B.C.; however, the only context apart from the present is presence of several in Corinth.

The Pontic belongs to Grakov's Group VI, formerly dated 122-70 B.C., but I think he has got back to 150 B.C. now. (I should finish it at 185 B.C.)

The Thasian ΠΑΙΣΤΡΑΤΟΣ is not attested as early as the MSBF, but SS 13775 comes from the group SS 13767-13796 which must be nearly contemporary.

The stamp of ΕΚΑΤΑΙΟΣ is matched at Pergamon. Nothing better on ΕΥΒΙΟΤΩ than here

In this lot, of legible Knidian with eponym names, 41 altogether, over 40 percent are leftovers from the period ca. 188-167 B.C., and nearly 25 percent more are of the preceding period (date of the MSBF). The other 35 percent are divided about equally between the 166-146 BC period and the third quarter of the 2nd century.

The latest eponyms are apparently ΑΓΑΘΟ(ΚΑΗΣ?), who may possibly be later than the 3rd quarter, though not as late as the end of the century, ΕΥΦΑΝΩΡ, ΚΑΛΛΙΔΑΜΑΣ, ΦΙΛΙΠΠΙΟΣ (? KT 1735), and ΦΙΛΟΜΒΡΟΤΙΔΑΣ; the four latter should be third quarter.

## REMOVAL FROM MSBF OF SS 13005-13031 (K 2616-2642)

In the accompanying analytical list of these handles, "MSBF" appears under "Comment" whenever there are parallels in the deposit. Items dated "Before 150" do not appear in the deposit apart from ~~this~~, and are evidently of somewhat later date though still in the first half of the century, possibly still even in the 1st quarter, some of them. The Rhodian eponym APIETON is one of a very few who do not appear in the MSBF while being present in quantity in the Pergamon deposit; these are all a little later than the MSBF Rhodian, (called ca 180 BC) and apparently indicate that the close of the Pergamon deposit was later than that of the MSBF.

Note that handles from the "lowest" part of this fill are listed among those contemporary with MSBF (SS 13430, etc.).] [Some unread 22/KZ]
- c) SS 13728 - 13747 : Hellenistic fill beside wall, below "intermediate" strosis. [Post-MSBF in this group are the Knidian SS 13733 and 13739, which are of the phrourarchos period eponyms ΑΠΟΔΛΩΝΙΔΑΣ and APISTEIAHE.]
- d) SS 13748 - 13753 : 19/KA, Hellenistic fill above bedrock just north of Fountain House. [Post - MSBF in this group are SS 13749, naming the Knidian ΘΕΥΔΟΤΟΣ, a phrourarchos, and SS 13753, naming the Rhodian eponym APISTEIAΔΑΣ, on whom see above, first lot. Further, SS 13752 names the eponym NIKAΣΑΓΟΡΑΣ, one of the latest of those in MSBF, apparently; and SS 13751 is from a jar of ANTIMAXΟΣ, a potter most of whose activity seems to have fallen post - MSBF, though there are a couple of handles of his in the deposit.]

The post-MSBF eponyms here are ΑΠΟΛΛΩΝΙΔΑΣ, ΑΡΙΣΤΕΙΔΗΣ, ΘΕΥΔΟΤΟΣ, ΚΑΗΝΟΠΟΔΙΣ, and I do not feel too sure of the earlyness of this ΦΙΛΙΠΠΙΟΣ, since there is only a single example in the MSBF (SS 869, from Section Θ), whereas a number have been found in post-MSBF SAH groups from Section K (1953), and a phrourarchos ΦΙΛΙΠΠΙΟΣ did exist. The four other listed post-MSBF eponyms are all phrourarchoi.

An additional type of this period, 188-166 B.C., is in the Knidian fabricant list that of the ΗΑΙΔΙΑ ΘΕΥΔΩΡΙΔΑ, without eponym in the type.

Note that the dating of these groups of SAH depends largely on the Knidian.

From the list, it seemed possible there were pairs from the same jar. The handles having been got out, and the obvious possibilities examined, find none, but take note of the appearance of the handles:

SS 13760, of TIMΩ, looks very late, corresponding with other evidence to suggest it is ca. mid 2nd. It is rather roughly made, and short-topped. (No rim.)

Post-MSBF eponyms: ΑΡΙΣΤΕΙΔΑΣ, ΑΡΧΙΛΑΙΔΑΣ, ΕΞΝΟΦΩΝ. These all occur at Pergamon hence presumably before ca. 180 B.C.

The Early Knidian appear also in the Knidian list from this group, at the end of the list by fabricant.

Two Chian (one a lagynos handle) bear in the MSBF bear the same name as SS 13490. They are considered latish in the series of Chian in the MSBF. (See commentary.)

One would expect the Corcyrean(?) to be 4th-3rd cent. B.C.; however, the only context apart from the present is presence of several in Corinth.

The Pontic belongs to Grakov's Group VI, formerly dated 122-70 B.C., but I think has got back to 150 B.C. now. (I should finish it at 183 B.C.)

The Thasian ΠΑΙΣΤΡΑΤΟΣ is not attested as early as the MSBF, but SS 13775 comes from the group SS 13767-13796 which must be nearly contemporary.

The stamp of ΕΚΑΤΑΙΟΣ is matched at Pergamon. Nothing better on ΕΥΒΙΟΤΩ than h

b) SS 13637 - 13649 : 24/KH, cutting strosis to working floor and over water channel [This is mostly mixed first half of 2nd, but SS 13642, naming Knidian eponym ΕΥΦΑΝΩΡ, should be 3rd quarter.]

c) SS 13819 - 13863 : Martyr in Fountain House Porch, Layer 3. [This large group is predominantly of the 188-167 B.C. phrourarchoi period, contains also other first half of 2nd cent. material, and SS 13849, which names the eponym (Knidian) ΦΙΛΟΜΒΟΤΙΑΣ, who should be third quarter.]

d) SS 13944 - 13946 : Built into rubble wall north of 23/AA; p.3248. [The Knidian eponym ΚΑΛΛΙΔΑΜΑΣ is not established as before 150 B.C. (cf. SS 13944), though probably he is not much later.]

In this lot, of legible Knidian with eponym names, 41 altogether, over 40 percent are leftovers from the period ca. 188-167 B.C., and nearly 25 percent more are of the preceding period (date of the MSEF). The other 35 percent are divided about equally between the 166-146 BC period and the third quarter of the 2nd century.

The latest eponyms are apparently ΑΓΑΘΟ(ΚΛΗΣ?), who may possibly be later than the 3rd quarter, though not as late as the end of the century, ΕΥΦΑΝΩΡ, ΚΑΛΛΙΔΑΜΑΣ, ΦΙΛΙΠΠΙΟΣ (? KT 1735), and ΦΙΛΟΜΒΡΟΤΙΔΑΣ; the four latter should be third quarter.

Of the Rhodians, all eponyms, ΑΡΙΣΤΩΝΙΔΑΣ is ca. 3rd quarter of 3d B.C., ΑΡΙΣΤΕΙΔΑΣ and ΑΡΧΙΛΑΙΔΑΣ are toward 180 B.C. (in Pergamon deposit but not in MSBF), ca. while ΑΣΤΥΜΗΔΗΣ is mid-second B.C. <sup>xx</sup> (one or two ex. found in Carthage).

The Thasian has no better context than the present. The fabric suggests a date in the 3rd or possibly 2nd cent. B.C.: a rough stamp on the vertical part of a light handle.

For the Chian there is no better context than the present.

Of the Early Knidian, SS 13946 is matched in the MSBF, while another example of the type of SS 13637 was found in ΛΔ, well at 97/Γ, the Bone Well (G 5 : 3); the latter deposit is now dated 2nd quarter of 2nd (GRE) or about mid 2nd,
