Here is a note in writing that I think you wanted about the possibility allowed by the amphora stamps in the filling that construction of the Stoa of Attalos was undertaken early in the King's reign. As I understand it, you are making a study of bronze coins of the Achaean League, one of which was found in the filling of the Stoa of Attalos. As others had been found in Corinth, 146 had been considered the reliable terminus, until something earlier was suggested for the construction of the Stoa.

As Susan Rotroff mentioned to you, the date of the construction of the Stoa of Attalos is taken up incidentally in my article, "The Middle Stoa Dated," in Hesperia 1985. See pp. 14-15, 24 (end of note 63), and 32 (end of text). Of eponyms in Knidian stamps datable later than the phourarchoi (whose time ended in Knidos in 166), only 9 were found on amphora handles from the filling of the Stoa of Attalos. So its construction could have been begun in 157 B.C. Now since publication of my 1985 article, two of the 9 have been redated with probability, and only 7 are left for this period. So perhaps construction was begun in 159, as soon as Attalos became king.

The evidence of the amphora stamps does not require this earlier date, but allows it.



The greater part of this group is datable in the 3rd century B.C., many in the first half of the century, including those naming ΑΡΤΕΜΙΔΩΡΟΣ, ΔΙΟΚΛΗΣ, ΕΠΙΓΩΝΟΣ, ΖΗΝΩΝ, ΘΕΥΔΩΡΟΣ (the fabricant), ΚΑΛΛΙΚΡΑΤΙΔΑΣ, ΚΡΕΩΝ, ~~ΜΥΤΙΣΤΕΝΧΗΡΕΧΑ~~ ΟΝΑΣΑΝΑΡΟΣ, ΠΟΛΥΚΡΑΤΗΣ, and ΤΙΜΟΚΛΕΙΔΑΣ; some of these are close to 300 B.C.

Apparently none is later than the latest from the deposit at Pergamon, i.e. presumably than about 180 B.C. This is in line with the decrease in Rhodian after the early 2nd century noticed generally at the Agora, and cf. SEHHW, p.1647, n.10.

However, the first eponyms listed, ΑΡΑΤΟΦΑΝΗΣ and ΑΡΙΣΤΕΙΔΑΣ (II), are evidence for the relative dates of the MSBF and the SABF, since they are two of the small group of eponyms (7 or 8) who appear in the Pergamon deposit but not in the MSBF, and who are seen by various indications (e.g. appearance of secondary stamps on handles naming them) to be consistently a little later than the MSBF Rhodian group.

The Rhodian in the SABF are thus more useful in defining the date of MSBF than that of SABF.

The greater part of this group is datable in the 3rd century B.C., many in the first half of the century, including those naming ΑΡΤΕΜΙΑΣΡΟΣ, ΔΙΟΚΛΗΣ, ΕΠΙΓΟΝΟΣ, ΖΗΝΩΝ, ΘΕΥΔΣΡΟΣ (the fabricant), ΚΑΛΛΙΚΡΑΤΙΔΑΣ, ΚΡΕΩΝ, ~~ΚΥΤΙΩΝ, ΚΥΤΙΧ~~ ΟΝΑΣΑΝΔΡΟΣ, ΠΟΛΥΚΡΑΤΗΣ, and ΤΙΜΟΚΛΕΙΔΑΣ; some of these are close to 300 B.C.

Apparently none is later than the latest from the deposit at Pergamon, i.e. presumably than about 180 B.C. This is in line with the decrease in Rhodian after the early 2nd century noticed generally at the Agora, and cf. SEHHW, p.1647, n.10.

However, the first eponyms listed, ΑΡΑΤΟΦΑΝΗΣ and ΑΡΙΣΤΕΙΔΑΣ (II), are evidence for the relative dates of the MSBF and the SABF, since they are two of the small group of eponyms (7 or 8) who appear in the Pergamon deposit but not in the MSBF, and who are seen by various indications (e.g. appearance of secondary stamps on handles naming them) to be consistently a little later than the MSBF Rhodian group.

The Rhodian in the SABF are thus more useful in defining the date of MSBF than that of SABF.

Stamps with the reading ERM(on Chian handles seem to be datable about 300 B.C.; see comment on the Chian in the MSBF. According to the parallel from Pergamon (see above), MEN(should date before about 180 B.C. Neither MEN(nor KPO(appear in the MSBF, and the latter is not at present fixed as earlier than before the middle of the century (appears in Corinth as well as in SABF).

SS 10961 Handle of Thasian type,; stamp is a delta or a monogram with delta. Cf. Phyx Miscellaneous from the Filling of Period III of the Assembly place, and date probably before ca. 340 B.C.

SS 11049 Handle which has been called Knidian, but the clay is over-fine-grained and hard. Left end of a ~~XX~~ 2-line stamp: E|
ΔPA| an iota(?) before the delta

SS 14053 Handle of Thasian or Mendaeian shape, with rim preserved. Stamp an aryballos or ribbed mug in beaded circle. Examples of this and closely resembling dies have been found in various 4th century deposits. (See under aryballos.)



SS 5379 (Rhodian of Timakrates) predates the construction of the 'Brick Building' which was built after 229 and went out of use when the Stoa was built. Other definitely pre-Stoa handles: SS 1837 (Knidian of Nikias) and 1863 (Knidian of Theugenes). Contemporary with the construction of the Stoa should be the jar SS 5486 (Knidian of Sotion) which lay on the floor of the 'Brick Building' when it went out of use. R.E. notes that part of the construction fill was stuff brought to fill in holes to level the floor: the Rhodian handles of Zenon and Theodoros are of the earlier 3rd century.




