On Drain, H 12:1, note the coins: early Athenian Imperial (Suppl IV, p. 120, note 102) and next, p. 121, about channel in ruinous state;

Strong probability that damage to drain was Sulla destruction. Doubts to me as if here again handles tend to be earlier than lower limit of deposit. - ?
