On the first column of numbers on the attached pages, see A.-M. and A. Bon, Timbres Amphoriques de Thasos (1957), p.60, where the "M.E." used in this publication is explained as "Musée Epigraphique, A. Bon," since these numbers were given by the Bons to (otherwise unnumbered) handles, at that time stored in the Epigraphical Museum in Athens. The large collection of stamped handles of many classes has since been removed from the Epigraphical Museum, and put into a neighboring storeroom of the National Museum. The letters "EM" have been incorporated by us in the numbers given to all classes of handles in this collection, and are now taken to mean EONIKON MOYSEION. The Thasian are distinguished from the other classes by the letters AB (Bon initials).

Numbers, then, in the AB column in the attached list are prefixed "M.E." in the publication above cited.

Numbers in the BON column are catalogue numbers of the same publication.

Numbers in parentheses to the right of the BON column, such as (1), (2), etc., refer to explanatory notes at the end of this list, pp.5-7. These are usually concerned with corrected readings or classifications resulting from further study, which have sometimes produced anomalies to be corrected in the revised edition of Bon. In the lists, I have given the new inventory numbers of reclassified handles when these happened to be readily available, as e.g. in notes (10) and (16), otherwise a more general indication, cf. note (19). Records exist by which any of these handles could be found, if desirable to look at it.

Gaps in the BON column which have no footnote number beside them, as for instance opposite EM AB 292, mean that the handle is a Thasian with an illegible stamp, not included in the publication. (Sometimes by error footnotes have been cited for such handles, e.g. for AB 239 and 241.)

AB 326 - 334 had remained among the unclassified handles at the Museum, and were not numbered until January 1960, hence none are listed in Bon. Those identified as belonging to Bon types have Bon numbers in parentheses.

- (1) AB 39, listed correctly under Bon 413, appears also under Bon 1862, from which it should be removed.
- (2) AB 54 is listed twice in Bon, under 573 of ΔΕΙΝΩΝΑΣ, and under 1968 where are listed illegible stamps with the same device. The identification is not certain.
- (3) AB 55 is listed twice in Bon, properly under 1102, and (before decipherment) separately as 1813, which latter number should be eliminated in a new edition.
- (4) AB 61 is listed twice in Bon, probably correctly under 376, and separately also as only example of 1903, to be eliminated.
- (5) AB 85 is listed ~~την επιχειρία της Βόλης~~, correctly as an example of Bon 1306, and erroneously under Bon 1933, where it is a number mistake for AB 285.
- (6) AB 88 is a Knidian handle, not a Thasian, an example of KT 961, now stored with the other examples. EM 8
- (7) AB 104 is listed twice in Bon, probably correctly under 1053, and also separately as the only example of 2098.
- (8) AB 109 is listed twice in Bon, correctly under 413, and also under 1885.
- (9) AB 124 has been listed under Bon 325, and used to illustrate the type. The reading APIΣΤΟΚΑΗΣ however derives from identification of AB 124 with Dumont, p.16, fig. 6, whereas it should rather be identified with Dumont, p.16, fig. 5, and used to illustrate Bon 1824 instead of Dumont's drawing.
