AD will try to get the Rhodi ^{read} and listed while he is still unemployed elsewhere. M2 & code on the use of NEW TYPES, and the illeg. The illeg. should remain in a drawer, because of belonging to the strictly Athen class.

These will later be marked with their EM numbers "N. 37 EM 4" and sub-lit - i.e. duplicates as well as travels to be marked.

Mus., and correspond with the "21 Koan" noted as in these cases in ^{my} ~~the~~ Journal of work done in the N. Mus., back of p. ³³ ~~32~~. ME points out that [contrary to the situation with the Thasian] there are many more Koan from the 2 cases than are published by Neroutos, and this includes some good clear examples such as Ko EM 95 and 102. She suggests that the collection grew after Neroutos' publication and before it came to Athens. Also, several of the items above listed, as indicated by ^{having} no EM number beside them, she has not been able to find among any of the finds in the N. Mus. (Nor in either of the Alexandrian collections, except for one possible identification with ~~AVG~~ AVG 889, which might be part of (3) above.)

See Journal, pp. 31a, 33a, for notes on a "last Zambit" which contained bookweights as well as handles, and a remarkable no. of Latin.

On p. 33a is a statement that Kind⁽⁶²⁾, Plodia⁽¹¹⁾, and Thasia (1 or 2) were put ^(5. VIII. 51) in drawers marked "to be read". We have found a drawer labelled "Plodia and Thasia to be read" in which however AD counts 28 Plodian, though the Thasian (apart from 2 formerly numbered EM LK 96 and 97, with separate) are 3 and so corresp. well enough. Maybe some of those 28 Plodia would have been called S. & P. opa in 1955, but note says the S. & P. were 11 or 12, and were put with their kind.

AD is reading the Plodia, and making particulars, and will list what there is. (See attached).

Note that a lot of the Plodia^{2.8.59} on the list are common in the Benedict collection than among finds in Adria, which argues for an Egyptian origin for this lot. However ^(and) disparity in numbers above mentioned additional handles "to be read" may easily have added themselves to the drawer.

The Thasia are being numbered A.B. 332-4.
