Dear Alan:

Those two handles from the North Slope excavations, AH 5 and 6, unfortunately don't seem to add up to a context:

AH 5. We still cannot identify this with a specific type reading, but it probably can't date before about the middle of the 2nd century B.C. It seems to be a type, perhaps an eponym type, of ΔΑΜΟΚΡΑΤΗΣ Θ ΑΡΙΣΤΟΚΛΕΥΣ; on this fabricant, see Delos vol. 27, p. 327, under E 66, a little vita. one of ~~his~~ Maria Petropoulakou thinks it may be his eponym types in the term of ΜΕΝΕΚΡΑΤΗΣ, who probably dates a bit after 150.

AH 6. ΑΓΟΠΑΝΑΚΤΟΣ
ΑΡΤΑΜΙΤΙΟΥ

The fabricant ΑΓΟΠΑΝΑΞ is dated too early, as I now think, in Delos 27, p. 302, under E 1. The rest of what it says there is ok; but according to recent studies, his career is 221-199 B.C., plus ~~perhaps~~ maybe say 5 or 6 years at either end. See Ath.Mith. 1974, p. 200. Even pulling him down like this, he does not get to ΔΑΜ. Θ ΑΡΙΣΤ.


Thank you so much for your letter of August 18.

Dear Mr. Wittmann:

Yesterday our office posted to you as directed (i.e. the address) two photographs of the Exekias krater (the krater as a whole, and a detail showing the horses); these are fig. 1 and fig. 4 in the publication, see Hesperia 6, 1937, pp. 469, ff. Also in the envelope was a print of Alison Frantz's photograph of the Herakles head (actually poros, not marble). The official negatives of the North Slope objects are in principle kept at the American School, not at the Agora, but in fact the negatives of the Exekias krater are kept down here with us, as often in demand, and we have the processing establishment. For the head, Alison offered the use of her negative, which also is down here; it seemed to me a lovely photograph, and I hope you are both pleased.

The material is of course ~~of~~ Oscar Broneer's, who published the head in Hesperia 8 (pp.91 ff.). I am sure he would be pleased for Miggy to have the photographs.

I hope to see you both myself, the next time you come to Greece.
