Nothing at all closely like this stamp is on file with us at the Agora. I may just refer to another handle bearing a ligature stamp, SS 2778, of unknown class. The stamp is quite different, and the shape of the handle is also different, being round in section. The clay however is rather ~~different~~ similar. SS 2778 comes from Section K, late Roman well at 32/E (grid number I 15: 1), the date of which seems to be 4th or 5th century after Christ. In the late Roman period stamped handles are not at all common. For ligatures in stamps on the toes of late Roman unguentaria, cf. Hesperia III, 1934, p.295, nos. 289-290, with comment by Waage.
