I enclose a copy of the readings of the amphora handles found at Sinope which you sent to Carolyn Koehler. Of the 11 stamps, 6 were certainly made in Sinope itself, and one other may have been; 2 are certainly from Rhodes, and another may be; the last one (with BO in a square stamp) we have not yet identified.

Two of the Sinopean, the ones with the names of the magistrates (astynomes) Pasichares son of Demetrios, and Zenios son of Apollodoros can be dated to after mid 2c BCE, Zenios to after 122. The astynome Xenokles son of Apollo- is one we do not ourselves have on file, though a little more research among the Russian publications on Sinopean stamps may well turn up a date for him too. It is possible that more work may enable us to find parallels (and so readings) also for the 3 Sinopean stamps marked "unread" in the list below.

The two legible Rhodian stamps are both earlier: the magistrate Kleukrates appears in stamps with a head of Helios as a device before 175 BCE, and the magistrate Daemon with a Helios symbol is datable to the earliest period of Rhodian stamping, before the middle of the 3rd c BCE. These magistrates were eponymous priests of Helios, not astynomes as in the Sinopean stamps.

Here is the full list. Some abbreviations used:

hdl = handle
Sin = Sinopean (i.e., made in Sinope)
Rh = Rhodian (made in Rhodes)
fab = fabricant (potter)
ast = astynome (municipal official in Sinope and other city states around the Black Sea)
Dim = dimensions. PH = preserved height, WxTh = width by thickness of the handle in mm at the place where the stamp was impressed.
Par = parallel example(s). Pridik 1917 is the publication of the stamps on tiles and amphora handles in the Hermitage Museum, and an SS inventory number represents a stamp from the excavations of the Athenian Agora.
Frg = fragment
Fab = fabric (description of clay)

Surface Finds from near Sinope

All hdl's were sent to CGK by David MacDonald, who received them from a US Air officer, who picked them up in the late 1960s "on the beach, toward the edge of town, where the ruins of wall running down to the sea can be seen eroding out of the bluff that backs the beach." (letter of 30.v.95 from D. McD.) All were read from rubbings taken by Carolyn Koehler and sent to Athens, with emendations and parallels provided from the files by Maria Petropoulakou.

Dear Prof. Koehler,

Please find enclosed a small group of amphora handles collected at Sinope in the late 1960s by an American Air Force officer. He described the find spot as on the beach, toward the edge of town, where the ruins of wall running down to the sea can be seen eroding out of the bluff that backs the beach. I am sorry the description is not more specific, but the amphora handles had been collected casually some years ago. The retired officer was not able to point out the spot on a map.

The retired officer turned the handles over to me after hearing a lecture I gave in which I talked about the despoiling of the archaeological record. I assured him that although these were hardly art treasures, they would be of interest to archaeologists. I hope I did not exaggerate - only a couple are generally legible, as you will see. Still, I think there is some point to putting them on record, if only for the principal. In another matter, I am acting as an expert witness for the legal representatives of the Turkish government in efforts to secure the return of the Emali "Dekadrachm" hoard of coins, illegally excavated and smuggled out of Turkey. I imagine this little of relevance here, but you can appreciate my desire to remain above reproach in regard to antiquities!

Through a letter from Dr Habicht, who is in Athens at the moment, I have learned that you have returned from America in January and that consequently my letter written to your assistant Miss Arvanitou could not have come to your knowledge before. I could not write before now owing to an illness.

I was surprised to hear that you still require additional information about number and origin of the Sinopean vase-handles, since in my letter to Miss Arvanitou I enclosed a complete survey of all Sinopean finds. In case this has been lost, I enclose a new copy and hope that it will be of some use to you.

Unfortunately I cannot enclose rubbings, since the stamps are in the keeping of the Archaeological Institute at the University of Ankara and have not been made accessible after my first and only visit there. I have only a set of rubbings and photographs which I badly need now to prepare my edition of the Inscriptions of Sinope, but I shall gladly put them at your dispo-
