Paris had numbered his ms. through Rhoda and Thasos, 30 - 50. What was the gap? Notes on individual handles, no numbers entered.
Ms entered "M.P." numbers, ^{on his manuscript} when she identified them.

In our duplicates of Perrakis handles, she has entered Paris numbers where known. She has also entered "Paris" when the object though without having numbers it, also what can Bon no.; so dupl. ^(undated) are 1958 and 1960. End, no more was plotted; then, only Bon, after.

Most of these are accompanied by drawings by means of which it has been possible to identify them with stamps on specific handles which we found in 1950-51; and to isolate one section of his manuscript which as a whole does not correspond with anything we have as yet found in Delos, and so provides a supplement to the handles we recorded. This is the section composed of his XIII lists, i.e. handles found in 1913 by various excavators named by him. The Thasian from these lists have been included in the Bon volume, from his drawings. Through these manuscripts, we have entered our inventory numbers for the handles, i.e. the Delos TD numbers. These will make it possible to find individual handles copied by Paris.

Papers of J. Paris

The tie-folder containing the Paris dossier was returned to G. Daux in September 1969 (23 or 24.IX.69, see papers here). For what reason I do not recall, it has been back here with us now for some time, perhaps in connection with researches here by one of the French members? Something may turn up to explain the fact, among papers needing to be filed. I propose now to ask M. Debidour (currently working here, using our Thasian files) to see that it gets properly into the archives of the Ecole. I should inform M. Bruneau of this happening, as he has Delos more in mind.

Note that this folder, of notes on the Paris mass., includes our Delos records describing the Cases we found in Delos, and their markings. As we numbered Delos SAH by case-lots, a proper collated list of the cases ought to be made, with at least copies for the French School, in Athens and in Delos. For a good many of the handles, we would have here some record of finding-place.
