Beginning on May 21, 1958, duplicates were
made from the publication by AD supplemented by ME
for non-Rhodian problems, etc. They corrected wrong
readings as far as possible without seeing rubbings or
plots. or of course the handlist.

In June, 1962, AD made a list of items
of which rubbings were wanted, either because they
were new types or because they presented problems.
Added to this list were items listed by ME in 29. VII. 60, for
rubbings and for notes on fabric. Note that by no means
everything was rubbed, so most items have not been checked.

In July and in September, 1962, I made
