Dear Mr. Ashmole,

Thank you for your kind note of November 28.

I enclose the remainder of the copy in our BM sequence, taken from Miss Arthur's final batch of rubbings, which she sent me very promptly, and it is I who am slow in forwarding the enclosed.

It may be a convenience to know the storage by case of this series, to see in case somebody wants ^{one} of the handles included in our record. Miss Arthur checked first and last numbers for me, and this is how they lie:

Case 37 contains BM 1 - 91, registration numbers 1955 9-20, 1-91. These are a selection from Case 1, from Naukratis, in which none of the handles had previous registration numbers.

Case 38 contains BM 92 - 196, registration numbers 1955 9-20, 92-196. Selection from Cases 2 and 3, again from Naukratis, again without previous registration.

Case 39 contains BM 197 - 269. This is a selection from Cases 4 through 15, the BM series running in order of the cases. Included are 1955 9-20, 197-263; but some items in these cases (4 through 15) had old registration numbers, and six of these were selected, becoming BM 254, 257, 259, 263, 265, 269. Note that handles in Cases 6 through 17 were found by us (and have remained) in order by publication numbers in I.G. XII, 1-2, pp.175 ff. (Rhodes); they have publication numbers written on top near the stamp, but usually no registration numbers; those removed by us and put into cases 39 and 40 have been given new reg. nos. if they had no previous ones. Most handles in Case 39 are from Rhodes, or of unknown provenance.

Case 40 contains BM 270 - 340. Selection from Cases 17-21. Included are 1955 9-20, 265-327, plus seven previously registered items, which have become BM 277, 278, 282, and 296-299. Handles from Rhodes, Knidos, etc.

Note that either at the end of Case 39 or at the beginning of Case 40 must be the single item from Case 16, BM 28 270 (1955 9-20, 264, pub.no. 1378) which escaped Miss Arthur's attention when taking end-of-case notes.

Case 41 contains BM 341 - 403. Selection from Cases 22-25. These are mostly items which had already been registered, beginning with 16 and 23 respectively from the series of 51 12-1 and 54 8-9, which had been in Case 22. Included are three new reg.nos., 1955 9-20, 328-330 (BM 392-4) found in Case 23.

Case 42 contains BM 404 - 496. Selections from Cases 25 (cont.) - 32. Most of the items had already been registered, but included are BM 1955 9-20, 331-2 (BM 413-414). BM 422-475 are selections from Cases 28 and 29, from Alexandria, in the 48 7.31 series. BM 476-496 begin the selection from Miss Hutton's 1925 1-19 series. Note that the 48 7.31 series was not in order when found, and the handles remaining in Cases 28 and 29 are still mixed.

Case 43 contains BM 497 - 649. Selections from Cases 32 (cont.) - 35, continuing in the Hutton 1925 1-19 series, with no new registrations.

Case [44] which I fear is not marked - could you ask someone to mark it before we forget what it is? - contains BM 650-669, from Cases 35 (cont.) - 36, the end of my selection from Miss Hutton's series, plus 1955 9-20, 333, a handle found by Mr. Brenner among sculpture fragments.

Since writing to you in November, I have rediscovered Petrie's notice in his Naukratis of "about 1200" stamped handles found there by him. This being about twice as many as we have found in your cases, I thought probably there had been a division of finds, and half had remained in Egypt (and no doubt formed part of the heaps we found there last spring). But Peter Fraser has the impression he has seen a lot from Naukratis in the Ashmolean, where he assures me there are 12000 or so handles. I wonder if this can be so, and shall ask him to verify when he goes back.

Peter organized a very good trip to the Fayoum over the Christmas holidays, which I was glad to be able to join. Roger Edwards came also, and we all collected sherds diligently at all those Hellenistic sites, Ruth Fraser being the cleverest, finding lots of jar handles and two whole lamps. Have you seen that country? The site of Krokodilopolis is most astonishing, four square kilometers of enormous high sherd heaps, formed by a reverse of the usual procedure on ancient sites, since the earth is sought and the pottery discarded.

We are expecting Homer Thompson here about January 25, and Mr. Hill, and Mrs. Blegen, tomorrow.

Dear Mr. Ashmole,

Thank you for your kind acknowledgement of October 24th. I am most grateful for the opportunity to see what you have in the way of stamps, and we have made some very useful additions to our files.

Mrs. Will, who is publishing our Roman stamps and those found in Alexandria and in the French excavations in Delos, was very glad to have the rubbings we made for her. She may be writing to you to ask for a few photographs. I hope there will not be a difficulty in finding any particular handles wanted. The handles we recorded are assembled in cases (37, 38, part of 39?) marked 37 through 43. The first two or three cases contain an uninterrupted series of 1955 9-20 registration numbers, through 1955 9-20 253. The last two or three cases (41-43?) contain a selection from Miss Hutton's 1925 1-19 series, in order of her numbers. Just preceding this selection is another of 50-odd handles from the 48 7-31 series from Alexandria, again in registration order. The rest of the handles we recorded, BM 254 through 421 in our series, are of various registrations according to what we found together in cases. You have lists of registration numbers given by us and of previously registered handles of which we made records. I enclose the continuation of the copy of the selected stamps in our BM sequence, from BM 169 through BM 584; this is not quite the end, and I will send the rest when Miss Arthur has had time to send us the rest of the rubbings. This copy will probably help in finding the handles as well as in entering the registration of the new series in your books. I am sorry I forgot to make a note of the numbers beginning and ending the cases.

I don't know if I mentioned the principal of selection this time. I meant to include all Knidian, Thasian, Chian, Coan and Roman handles, since publications are now being prepared of these by various people; also a few Rhodian and miscel-

lanous noticed as of particular interest. I made a count of the handles. This is not absolutely accurate, partly because numbered handles had to be counted in their cases where they were rather heaped, there being not enough time to take them out and pack them in again in order. However, you may be interested in the figures:

All the minor groups listed above were fully covered in the BM series save the Pontic: 13 of these found in Kerch (from Case 23) were not recorded since large numbers of these have already been published from Kerch. A selection of the Rhodian and miscellaneous were included.

Some day I would like to come and photograph some of your handles. In the meanwhile I thought it might be worth while to make a short report on what you have, which would include also separate figures for the three cases from Naukratis which total about 650 handles; I think there has not been any published notice of handles from Naukratis, and the handles in these cases ~~ms~~ have not been registered except for the selection registered by us. Would you be willing for me to publish such a report? Would you have a preference where it should be published?

Dear Carolyn,

Your letter of last Monday, with rubbings through 1925 1-19 641a, reached me yesterday, which was pretty good for a registered letter with something in it. The rubbings look fine, and I'm delighted to have them. Only I hope they have not kept you unduly from your studies. I was depressed to find on my return here that my two Greek helpers had both decided in my absence not to try their next examinations, as being insufficiently prepared. This made me feel guilty. So you must do a good job on yours.

Next time you do go to the Museum - no hurry - there are a few things I'd be very grateful if you would look up for me. First, it would be a great convenience if we knew what part of my newly assembled series of handles is in each of the cases 37 through 43. I have lists, of which Mr. Ashmole has copies, which show the sequence of items in the whole series, but I forgot to make a note of the first and last numbers in each case. If I had this information, I could tell somebody just where to look for instance for something that should be photographed. (Mrs. Will is certainly going to ask for photographs of some ~~sign~~^{name} of the stamps of which you have ~~sent~~ her rubbings.) The first number in Case 37 for instance is 1955 9-20 1. What is the last number in that case? etc. Everything would be simple if there were a single series of numbers marked on the handles, but this is not the case; so do get us those first and last numbers the next time you go.

Then we need another "look" at some of the stamps and handles, we find in the course of making readings from the rubbings:

- 1955 9-20 237 (BM 237) The device is a pointed wine jar. We think more letters may possibly be legible, especially to the left. Could you take another rubbing of this?
- 74 8-5 94 (BM 278) This makes quite an important correction in the book on Thasian stamps which is just coming out. It removes a wrong name from the list of Thasian potters (? or whatever they were). Will you please make an extra rubbing for Professor Bon to help him make this correction? Get the letters as clear as possible.
(In the case, you will find this just before 1955 9-20, 271)
- 1955 9-20 292 (BM 305) Would you try to get another rubbing of this? It is
- * * 306 (BM 319) May we please have another rubbing of this? And will you write on the rubbing whatever marks there may be on the handle? There should be, probably, G.T.N. something
(Not quite certain identification.)
- 51 12-1 18 (BM 350) May we please have another rubbing of this? Left end especially, that is, the end away from the device.
(The 5th 12-1 series comes right after the 1955 9-20 series.)

54 3-9 27 (BM 368)

(This series comes right after the 51 12-1 series in the case.)

We are not sure to which of two types this belongs, KT 929 or KT 1638, but we think the latter. I enclose photographs of better examples of these two types. You will see (I hope) that the device is a lion (ess?)'s head. Can you see letters to the left of the head on the British Museum handle which would make sure the identification? Can you get a rubbing to show them?

I hope all this will not take too long, and remember, there is absolutely no hurry about it.

We haven't had it cold yet, but while I was away there was a terrible lot of rain. Floods. And I had left my best, selected, freesia bulbs in the only tin I have that doesn't leak out the bottom. And somehow it wasn't covered - I thought it was. Hideous state of drowned sprouts and decay. I am still hoping a few may be sound enough to push on when properly planted.

I have to dash off to Peiraeus (port of Athens) to try to meet the Megaws and persuade them to call on our friends and excavations on their way home to Mrs. Megaw's mother's flat.

Dear Max,

I hope you are well, and your uncle's condition has improved, and that you are having an interesting time reviewing archaeology in the Am. School library.

This is really a business letter, and like Mr. Bonwick's it needs an IMMEDIATE reply; because otherwise I won't be able to say if the things you will decide need to be done.

This morning I mailed to you six pages of RUBBINGS from handles selected from the first ~~assortment~~ ¹¹¹ cases found in the cases, as I have numbered them ~~the~~ 36 cases found in the British Museum. Here are three more pages, taking us down to BM 170, still from case ②. (The prospect is not as bad as it sounds: a great many of the cases have almost entirely Rhodian, which we will not record this time.)

There are two things to do now with these rubbings:

- 1.) find out which of the handles really need photos, and are worth it. That is, I think we have 6 handles

(2)

out to "may be used later" bind, unless they are
 very interesting, and perhaps also ^{more or less} the slight variations.
 (I am not absolutely sure I can photograph them, but
 I hope so.) The birds & duck are of course clearly the
 Kinkin and the Coan. I am recording to Roman from
 Mrs. Will's records, but don't expect to photograph from
 her. The Thasian will be hard for you to check, because
 of our files not being all assembled, so don't bother
 too much with them. The Sea Gulls are rather extra.

2.) If possible, make the triplicate copy before
 writing to me, and send both these copies in your letter.
 Write any questions about stamps or handles in red
 on the original only, and I will try to solve the
 problems which I am still here, and correct readings,
 etc., and then give the carbon copy to the Museum
 before I leave.

In any case, the triplicate of these handles will
 have to be done for the rubbings, because I will not
 leave them to do most of it here. So don't remove
 any of the rubbings until it is done, as there is no
 other detailed record, no copy of reading, except
 for the four pages covering Thasian and nearby
 numbers which I enclose here. From these

page you will see how it is to be done, with BM numbers followed by museum registration number ($\frac{1955}{9-20}$ etc.) followed by finding place. These are new museum registration numbers, now being given, to items which have never been registered before, though discarded 100 years ago perhaps. So I make our BM numbers begin with them, for convenience. (There are other handles which have been registered, and under different series, so we know to have our BM series, like TD and others, to keep our records straight. When I send you these, I will tell you the old registration numbers.)

For finding place, see the summary of registration numbers given, of which I enclose here the first page. This will also guide you, in case of doubt, as to which kind of handles the stamps in the rubbings are on, since the numbers are given by category.

I hope all this is fairly clear, ^{although} as it has been written in various places, and is being finished — something of a hurry. If you see Mr. Baudis before I do, let him I appreciate his rubbings more since I tried to do a lot myself. Some of them were

made by a young art student who doesn't know
Greek, so they are mostly numbered upside down.
Up & down, the new registration numbers have also been
written by one or other of two art students working for
me. They are poor and not too many, but such I
hope they are going to give me somebody

to rub them & write the rest. They are so complicated
they take a long time. It is so dirty down in
that it is impossible, with such black London dust,
that I thought I might be able to do the rubbing
with ink, instead of pencil drawings.

I have been to visit Professor and Mrs. Gomme, who
are - Greeks like you, and are old friends; and
we must now plan toward coming back to Athens, as
soon as we can get finished. I shall send some rubbing
in a day or so. Please if possible write to me the same
day you receive them, each time, and will be better
arranged for in Central post office. (I expect Miss
Talbot would give you a stamp, but better to help her
letter yourself at the Kiosk & postbox.) I expect to leave here
some time next week.
