The above made by AA from the file cards we had got out to correct Mlle. Metzger's manuscript and had annotated with the numbers in the no. column above right. These numbers are as I believe publication numbers, and these objects have never yet had any individual inventory numbers by which to identify them, only have been marked with numbers indicating their finding-places, and several could have the same number of this sort. These " " numbers appear on the original rubbings given us 23.IV.66 by Mlle. Metzger which I have just found. Mlle. M.'s ms, which I have returned with the readings corrected, had a certain amount of context information for some items: the two Chian (3 and 4) first(?) half of 3rd century, the Knidian 7 and 8, 2nd century (first half for 7).

Items not covered by the foregoing analysis:

Metzger ms. no. 11, on which see my letter to her of Sept. 24. Although I have since found her original set of rubbings, this item is not among them (received by us 23.IV.66), is perhaps a find of the past summer. If guesses in my mentioned letter are right, this no. 11 is closely contemporary with nos. 5-8 and 10.

Dunant nos. 3 and 6, see my notes of 16.IX.65. (These numbers are probably just mine for these notes.) Of these, 3 is MSBF period, while 6 is duoviri period. They evidently are not from the area covered in Mlle. Metzger's publication ms.

On EYKPATHΣ: whereas he is not in the Combined List of Knidian types found in Corinth and/or in the building fill of the Stea of Attalos, apparently he directly followed KAEYMBROTOS who occurs in both places: see original and revised types of ΕΙΠΙΦΑΝΗΣ in the two terms (KT 569 becomes KT 2235). A large number of potters name KAEYMBROTOS, including all but two of these (much fewer) who name this EYKPATHΣ.

Note that of the unclassified No. 2, other examples have been found only at Koroni and in Alexandria.





ON THE SAH FROM THE PEIRAEUS CISTERN ANALYZED 9.V.66

This group is of much importance in connection with the beginning of the phrourarchos stamp series in Knidos, see a preliminary note of 28.IV.66 filed in Knidian Studies folder. The stamps naming phrourarchoi apparently belong to the period of Rhodian occupation of the mainland, i.e. 188-167 B.C., as accepted by P. Fraser, The Rhodian Peraea, p.93.

Among 35 handles from this cistern, 5 are Rhodian, datable in the late 3rd and early 2nd century B.C. The eponym ΚΛΕΥΚΡΑΤΗΣ (no.9) is among the latest in the Middle Stoa Building Fill, sometimes appearing with an early secondary stamp (rose, no letters).

Among the remaining 30 handles, 28 are Knidian. Of these, the stamps of 3 are matched in the MSBF; they name the eonyms ΕΥΚΡΑΤΗΣ (no.28) and ΛΕΩΝ (no.29) in a stamp and the fabricant ΔΡΑΚΩΝ without eonym (no.26); whereas 2 more (nos. 31 and 32) name an eonym ΠΟΔΙΟΥΧΟΣ, the most common Knidian eonym in the MSBF, although the particular stamp type (KT 1990) does not appear in the MSBF.

Of the other 23 Knidian, 2 name eonyms who are not established as phrourarchoi, ΑΠΤΕΜΩΝ (no.15) and ΘΕΑΙΔΗΤΟΣ (no.7); but both of these eonyms have been shown to date close to the early phrourarchos series, so they predate the series if they do not belong to it. A third non-phrourachos, but nevertheless of the early phrourarchos period is ΤΙΜΑΚΑΣ (no.27); he is one of the few eonyms known as contemporary with phrourarchoi (he is named as eonym in the same stamp that names also a phr. ΕΥΚΡΑΤΗΣ?); these types that name a phr. in addition to another eonym seem to come at the beginning of the period. (Name-connections would suggest this.)

There remain 4 Knidian eonyms in the group, all phrourarchoi: ΑΓΕΣΤΡΑΤΟΣ, ΑΡΙΣΤΙΩΝ, ΤΕΛΕΣΙΦΡΩΝ, and ΦΙΛΑΤΑΤΟΣ. These are known here in single examples save for ΤΕΛΕΣΙΦΡΩΝ, who dates 8 of the 18 Knidian handles in the whole deposit that bear

dating names (the other 10 bear only fabricant names). For each of these four phrourarchoi, there is some separate evidence to suggest he belongs to the earlier part of the phr. period, i.e. apparently soon after 188 B.C.

The 10 fabricant-only types just mentioned are mostly those of the ΗΑΙΔΙΑ ΟΕΥΔΩΡΠΙΔΑ (8 examples) plus one each of ΑΡΙΣΤΟΚΛΗΣ and ΔΠΑΚΩΝ. This last (see above) is of the MSBF period, i.e. pre-phrourarchoi. The others are of the phr. period.

Of the 2 handles that are neither Rhodian nor Knidian, no.35 is a Koan the stamp of which is duplicated in two Agora deposits which both may date in the early 2nd century B.C. Of these, B 20 : 22 belongs by its SAH to the Knidian phrourarchos period. The other deposit, O 16 : 3 had been tentatively called rather earlier by GRE, but the Koan item is a whole amphora, and by its shape it fits much better in the first half of the 2nd century, post-MSBF.

No parallel has been found for the final unclassified and unidentified item, no.23.

Dear Professor Robert,

Thank you very much for your comment on my plan for a corpus of amphora stamps. I regret very much not having acknowledged it more quickly, but I have been away for the greater part of the summer.

M. and Mme. Bon and I have been in correspondence on the subject of these stamps for many years, and particularly in recent years have exchanged ideas rather fully. Unfortunately since the war their duties at Montpellier have been so exacting that they have not been free to pursue their studies in the field of amphora stamps.

I am grateful to you for pointing out an obscure place in my prospectus, the sentence on p. 3, toward the end of the first paragraph, "Finally, the sequence, etc." In recasting the plan for publication, I shall try to express this more clearly. I had in mind for instance a series of Knidian jars on the stamps of which the official, presumably the dating authority, is given the title phrourarchos. Excavation evidence for jars and fragments bearing such stamps suggests they belong to the late third or early second century B.C. It may be proper to narrow and confirm this archaeological date by interpreting the phrourarchos as an instrument of the Rhodian occupation of the mainland in the first part of the second century, about which we know from other sources. I enclose photographs of the two handles of one of these jars (Agora inventory no. SS 9375, the neck and the upper parts of the handles preserved); and note, with regard to the endorsing name following the word "Knidian", that an Aristokles of about this period signs circular Rhodian stamps (with the characteristic rose) which appear both on Rhodian and on Knidian handles.

I am greatly obliged to you for taking the time to consider my project, and should of course always be very much interested in any further comment you might care to make.

Yours very sincerely,

I had noted there were numerous non-Kuidos names among the Pluronarchs, which names were not Persian either. Dugnius says by W. Waller that the administration might have been under mercenaries, which would be more Persian than Kuidos.
