perhaps meant to indicate a wreath."

There are known a great number of examples of KT ⁵⁵³~~533~~, but none very clear; the reading is put together from various handles. One has been published: Tenos I, p. 249, nos. 168-172; cf. also pp. 56, 66. We do not know what stamp was on the other handle of these amphoras; a nearly whole amphora with this stamp on one handle has been put together in Deles, but the other handle was not found.

Whereas the type of Klempittes shows a jar with baggy body much like our (most) LK jar, the others do not, and the type of 120K102 has one with a wide flaring lip. Do we have to sort these further? Abbreviations in large letters

devices without words. (see under Knid, Ag, clude, hemi ^{pelus}, etc.)

amphora, usually surrounded by the word ΚΑΤΕΘΕΤΕΥΣ running along the four sides

The abbreviations are apt to be in very large stamps the edges of which often fail to be impressed. When the margins are clear the stamps are usually rectangular with rounded corners tending sometimes toward a rough oval.

Date — the majority of these are probably late 1st cent.

B.C. None appear to be later. Some may be earlier.

SS 349 ΔΡΑ ΘΕΥ ^{refr.} is supposed to be late 3^d - 2nd cent according to context but this seems unlikely from its fabric.

This large group is to be separated from the miscellaneous Ἀγρόρα

These handles (according to a few present) are short ca. .20 in ht. as compared with ca. 29-30 of the late 2nd cent 1st kind. and even the .22-.25 of the earlier kind. (371 is .225)

Dear Dr. Bezeckzy,

Thank you for your note of March 13, with interesting enclosures: your proposed publication of some fragments of late Knidian amphoras, including a stamped handle, found far from their source. You had I believe, called on us here at the Agora Excavations in Athens, on Oct. 2, 1990, and consulted about this material.

For where to publish this material: I myself have usually published in the journal Hesperia, but that mostly takes reports and discussions of finds made by members of the American School in Athens. I think you should probably try for one of the French or Italian journals, that deal more with finds further west. You might write to:

She is very knowledgeable and active in the field of amphora imports to the west, dating over several centuries. I think those western journals like to include results of petrological analyses.

One comment on your stamp: I think now that it shows not exactly the profile of the head of a man, but of a theatre mask representing such a man.

I suggest a little alteration in one paragraph of your text, the fourth:
". . . Many stamped Knidian amphoras are kept in the Agora Museum, and thousands of stamped handles from other Knidian amphoras. Six of these handles at the Agora have stamps like that on the Magdalensberg handle . . .

In your first paragraph you write as though you think Knidos is an island, or is on an island. But actually it is a port on a peninsula on the coast of Asia Minor, the Datcha peninsula in modern Turkey.


It might be a good idea if you could get someone who also knows English to go through your final text before it goes to an editor. There are several spelling mistakes, also places where a word seems to have been left out, etc. I am very glad you are including a map. Would it be a good idea to identify some things in it, such as the Danube? possibly the outlines of present-day countries? - if they can be expected to stay the same for a while!

I see that Dr. Laubenheimer already knows some of your work, see enclosed photocopy. So perhaps you already are in correspondence with her.


