Dear Dr. Börker,

Yet again a request for help with a Koan (?) stamp from Samos.

In October, 1973, Dr. and Mrs. Homann-Wedekind came to the Stoa and mentioned (among other things) that rubbings after two ones of which you took of stamps at the Heraion had included a stamp reading ΔΕΞΑ, and that Dr. Homann-Wedekind would bring rubbings and/or photographs of this stamp in March when he returned to Athens.

This stamp does not appear among the rubbings which we have from the Heraion. It is of particular interest as we have both Early Rhodian stamps and Koan stamps with similar readings ~~and~~ ~~xpaxx~~ -- perhaps it might be a non-double Koan? Can you give any advice about how to get a rubbing and/or photograph of this stamp?
