- 1) A Sainos - no difference in clay KO 593 greyish clay due on baking  
(30 handles)  
with this name 6 handles with rim preserved. All rolled rim except 1  
one (KO 384) w. a little sharp edge, slightly close to the  
Tridik ones. Variations in profiles. KO 155 and KO 446  
w. the same die but the first is more abrupt in curve.  
KO 414 more arched. There are 3 dif. dies without device,  
same reading and also 3 dif. dies with rose: see file card.
- 2) A Guraios - Variations in die. All from the same red clay w.  
2 Guraios  
(3 handles) slip. A handle w. rolled rim. All slightly arched  
handles in profile. KO 479 whole handle pres. H 4. 162
- 3) Aiguticos - like A Guraios handles - Rolled rim pres.  
(1 handle)
- 4) Axaz  
(4 handles) Angular handles - KO 5, KO 195 w. heavy greenish  
pro. KO 364. light red clay with <sup>more</sup> mica on surface. No  
slip? or gone out
- 5) Axakl pink clay w. small dark bits - greenish slip
- 6) Aragajopas - Rim pres. like A Sainos (KO 384) see above
- 7) Ax Sper - KO 326; Rim w. sharp edge and flat top. Handle at  
close to the rim. red clay w fine mica.

7) *Aztecarios* - KO. 329; red clay w. heavy greenish slip and sharp edge rim with flat top

8) *Astyanax* - red clay w. few white bits, heavy greenish slip  
3 handles. no incia. Rolled rim

9) *Axquimil* - Not fine clay more porous

10) *Axapalco*s - handle set not very close to rim. Thin rolled rim pres.

11) *Baoiztli* - KO 494. grey clay at core red at surface w. greenish slip

12) *Bocovas* - KO 567; clay not fine as the others, w. heavy greenish slip.  
(8 handles) Arched Handle set close to the rim of which very small part is pres. 0.55X 0.28 compare KO 570: 0.46X 0.24

and KO 292: 0.5X 0.25

13) *A codicum* KO 333; shorter top handle than the other examples and slip not as heavy as on the other examples.

9 handles w. slip smooth surface

- (26) Μερκεπάρης - On 4 rolled rim preserved. On KO 193 of dark red clay  
7 handles

- (27) Μεργάρης - KO 414; slip greenish dif. than the others which are pink  
7 handles stop


Clay pale orange-tan with grayish core. Small gray + white bits, a few voids. Surface slightly paler in places.

## Non-double in the Koan corpus

### What to include

No non-double examples should be included unless they have the same reading as appears on double handles.

All non-double examples should be either the same die as appears on double handles, or a closely similar die.

### In the catalogue

The discussion of non-double examples should be a separate paragraph, giving finding-place and publication references. We will not add the non-double to the tally or the list of sites for the type.

Each example given will also have the Plate no. on which that die ~~xxxkxkxkxkx~~ is shown, and it will be stated whether the stamp is the same die as one already on double handles of that type (in which case the photo will usually be on the existing plate) or whether it is a different but closely similar die (in which case its photo will appear on the additional non-double plate).

### In the concordance

All non-double examples will be listed with an asterisk, e.g. \*ABC M ...

The ones which are the same die as the double Koan will be listed under the appropriate die. The non-double dies which are not found on double handles will be listed under Die X, and sometimes therefore Die X will have to be added to types which previously had only one die.

### In the bibliography and sites cards

Non-double examples are added in numerical order by type (like the double examples) but marked with an asterisk.

### In the introduction

It should be stated that Die X includes also non-double examples for which no double example exists (yet)...
