1. ΑΡΗΙΑΣ Nilsson no. 11 There is nothing reliable to support this doubtful reading.
2. ΑΤΗΣΙΑΑΖ Nilsson, p.533 Reference is to a type probably of ΑΤΗΣΙΑΑΖ (characteristic) (Skorpil, Bull. vol.11, no.465) as in Rhodian stamps It seems probable that all listings of ΑΤΗΣΙΑΑΖ are misreadings or miswritings of ΑΤΗΣΙΑΑΣ. An early handle in the Benaki coll. reads, retrograde, ΑΤΗΣΙΑΑΖ. This is the best there is, and quite likely a miswriting. CIA
3. ΑΙΖΗΙΟΖ, our R 37. Name now well-established on Rhodian handles.
4. ΑΔΕΣΙΚΠΑΘΖ Nilsson no.38. There is no support for this reading; it has not reappeared anywhere, nor any other with this name. Some day we will probably identify the stamp that was misread.
5. ΑΔΕΣΙΜΑΧΟΖ Nilsson, p.533. N.'s reference is to Skorpil in Bull. vol.11, no.469, a circular type with a(rose)in the middle. Apparently the preposition was not impressed in this example; I do not doubt the eponym is named.
- 5 bis. ΑΡΧΕΛΑΟΣ. Nilsson, no.150. Yes, no doubt R 116: ΑΡΧΕΛΑΣ regularly appears accompanied by the name of a month. His own name is in what I take to be the genitive, ΑΡΧΕΑΑ. I suppose it could be always an abbreviation of ΑΡΧΕΛΑΟΥ.
6. ΑΡΧΙΑΑΣ. The reading in BCH 1952, p. 526, derives from the Delos handle TD 1867, in which the ΤΕΜ is almost invisible. Now we have other examples of the type, ΤΙΜΑΡΧΙΑΑΣ in a circular type with rose in center, and cluster of grapes to the left.
7. ΔΑΜΟΔΙΚΟΖ. Nilsson, p.533. N.'s reference is to Skorpil in Bull. vol.11, no.485, in a type combining the name with that of a month, a style used by ΔΑΜΟΝΙΚΟΖ and probably his (suggestion of Maria Petropoulakou).
8. ΑΙΟΓΝΗΤΟΣ. Nilsson, p. 534. N.'s reference is to Skorpil in Bull. vol. III which I seem not to have. <sup>3</sup> I know this name in stamps only as that of a Knidian duovir, accompanied by that of ΑΙΟΑΑΟΔΩΡΟΣ.
9. ΣΗΙΚΑΗΖ. Nilsson, no. 193. N. restores a genitive ΣΗΙΚΑΣ(ΥΖ) This is no doubt YAKINGIO(Y) and with month. a type naming the eponym ΚΑΕΑΡΚΟΖ, abbreviated, as the name often is, (ΚΑΕΑΡ-ΟΡΑΣ not to be restored, as months are not named with him.)
10. ΗΠΑΚΑΙΙΑΑΣ. Nilsson, no. 224. No. 1 is to be restored ΗΠΑΚ/ΑΕΩΝ (known type), and no. 2 ΗΠΑΚΑΙΤΟΥ or ΗΠΑΚΑΙΙΤΩ (known). As for the item in IG XIV, the fabricant ones reading ΗΠΑΚΑΕΙΙΑ we have filed under Unclassified, as we have not seen any Rhodian with that name; a partly restored eponym type may be a misreading for ΗΠΑΓΟΡΑ which has the same device and month, and the month misspelled in the same way (ΑΤΠΛΑΝΙΟΥ).
11. ΗΠΑΚΑΗΖ. Nilsson, under no. 224. Not a reading by Nilsson, but taken from Dumont,

p. 3)

Inscriptions céramiques de Grèce, Paris, 1871, p. 95, no. 142 (out of alphabetical order). We have not found this object in the National Museum (where much in Dumont is to be found), nor the type on a handle anywhere else.

12. ΚΛΕΙΣΙΜΒΡΟ(ΤΟΣ?) which is Nilsson no. 816 does equal our R 313 of which we do not know the whole name. R 314 is ΚΛΕΙΣΙΜΒΡΟΤΙΔΑΣ. Note the dates/periods given in the typed list for the two numbers. (The date suggested for (R 314) in Hesp. Suppl. X has been seen for some time to be too late.)
- (X) See below, §. 3
13. ΚΑΕΩΝΙΔΑΣ. Nilsson, p. 534. N. cites Skorpil in Bull. vol. 3, which I do not have. (X) Compare Musée Greco-Romain inv. no. 14394 (photo VG 348.19). I think M. Empereur told me this stamp - handle - has been published by Botti. This handle of the Mus. Gr. Rom. might be early Rhodian by how it looks in its photo. Ending seems to be -ΟΥ.
14. ΚΑΗΝΩ. Our R 322. This is well-established though in few examples. Late. Known in only one type, in the genitive ΚΑΗΝΟΥΣ, in combination with the eponym ΙΕΡΟΚΑΗΣ. For type, and examples, and notes on the two names, see a rather complete comment in EAD 27, p.309-p.310, under E 24. Easily available by means of the index of that chapter in EAD 27. (See rubbings on cards.)
15. ΚΤΗΣΙΦΩΝ. Nilsson 336, in a circular type with head of Helios. Reading ΜΕΝΕΔΑΜΟΣ, this is an example of a known type.
16. ΚΤΗΣΙΦΩΝ. Nilsson, p. 534. N.'s reference is to Skorpil in Bull. vol. 11, no. 520. The reading there, KTHCI/PWNTO[O looks very real but we do not really know the handle is Rhodian. We have never found this name on Rhodian. Further, what might have been an abbreviation for the name, KTH and KTHΣ, no. 329 in our list of fabricants, is now cancelled. It was based on impressions on several handles which although of Rhodian shape were of far from Rhodian clay. These stamps are matched on double handles, and the handles now considered to be non-double Koan. All that remains as possibly Rhodian is KTH (retr.) on some lagynos handles that may be Rh.
17. ΗΡΑΕΙΑΣ. Nilsson, p. 535. N.'s reference is again to Skorpil in Bull. vol. 11. We have this reading on a Chian lagynos handle in the Benaki coll.; 3 ex. published from Smyrna in the catalogue of the Leiden Museum (1936) (reproductions of rubbings, no photos. or descriptions). Not Rhodian.
18. ΗΥΘΟΓΕΝΗΣ. Nilsson, no. 364. BCH 76, 1952, p.527. N.'s no.1, in which [OO] is restored, seems to match a stamp which we have in a single example from the Benaki collection which reads ΗΥXX TYXAIENEY[Z with caduceus, left, below the name. (See rubbing and photo.) Slightly restored by Maria Petropoulakou. Tau for gamma, but that may not have been well-preserved in N.'s example. I don't find this name in Pape. Have you got it otherwise from Rhodes? N.'s no. 2. There are types that read ΗΥΟΟΙΕNEY[Z without preposition, e.g. TD 2418 on the basis of which I listed II. as fabricant in 1952; but I now think they all name the eponym.
19. ΣΙΑΟΙΖΗΝ. Nilsson, no. 377. Name in gen. with asterisks in the 4 corners. There is no other support for this name in Rhodian stamps (nor in any others as far as I know). Probably derived from a badly impressed example of ΣΑΡΑΝΗΝΟΣ with asterisks in the corners.

20. ΣΩΣΙΤΙΜΟΣ. Nilsson no. 387. These are two abbreviated names on an early handle  
 ΣΩΣΙ( retr. Cf. APIETI NIKA ΔΑΜΣ  
 ΤΙΜΟ( TIMO TIMO TIMO

It is rather surprising that N. included this handle in his general run of Rhodian, as it must have looked unlike his usual Rhodian.

21. ΤΗΜΑΣΑΓΟΡΑΣ. Listed BCH 1952, p.530, but as eponym.

as we have a series of types of this latter man combined with months, all rather abbreviated. And N. speaks of confused effect of double impression.

In the meanwhile I have found our offprint of Skorpil's Bull. vol. 3 article, and add notes on nos. 8 and 13 above:

8. ΑΙΟΓΝΗΤΟΣ. Skorpil's reading is ΑΙΟΓΝΗΤΟΥ  
 caduceus cluster of grapes.

One of our Knidian types naming ΑΙΟΓΝΗΤΟΣ does have a grape-cluster under the name in the gen. There are more names above, when the whole is preserved. I cannot make a sure identification, but only say that we have not seen a Rhodian stamp (or a rubbing or photo of one) with the name ΑΙΟΓΝΗΤΟΣ.

13. ΚΛΕΩΝΙΔΑΣ. Skorpil's reading is ΚΛΕΩ ΝΙΔΟΥ He has drawn a square around it, perhaps to indicate a frame in relief. It is the same kind of thing as ours ~~from~~ from Alexandria, although probably not the same die. If Rhodian, it would be early.

- ΗΙΠΠΟΝΙΚΟΣ. Fraser, Funerary Monuments, p. 136, note 234. Cf. Nilsson, p.157. Reference there is to a publication pf 1873 by Dumont ("Ra73", with readings taken from Colonna Ceccaldi's facsimiles of stamps found mostly in Cyprus), also to a publication by Neroutsos in 1875 of the Demetriou collection, which includes some of the same material as in Dumont-Colonna Ceccaldi. Dumont's no. 63bis is the basis for Nilsson's listing (p.157). It reads ΗΙΠΠΟΝΙΚΟΣ with dolphin. This is evidently one of the variant types of APIETONEΙΚΟΣ with cornucopia, now well known to us. For a published photo, see E. I. Levi in Olbia, Temenos and Agora, Moscow and Leningrad 1964 (in Russian), pl. XV, no. 220. ΗΙΠΠΟΝΙΚΟΣ is not known in Rhodian stamps.
