Today we had a call from A. Waller's friend R. H. J. Ashton ("Richard Ashton" he calls himself). Now at the Br. Embassy in Athens. Doing a copy of Rhodian coin 408-188. He did not at first find a striking II but the stamp and then coins; but gradually rather did.

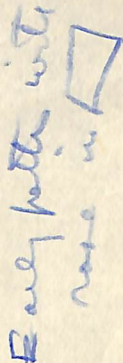
